David Eby Launches Campaign For Leadership Of The B.C. NDP

Eby has earned a reputation as a Minister who gets things done, building unorthodox coalitions of diverse groups to take on some of the most complex files in government, from putting out the dumpster fire at ICBC, to tackling money laundering

VANCOUVER: Hundreds of supporters across the province and 48 MLA colleagues joined David Eby virtually and in-person at an event in his Vancouver-Point Grey constituency as he put his name forward as a candidate for leader of the BC NDP, in a race that will determine the next premier of the prov-

Political Pundits were already betting on Eby, once current Premier announced that he will not step down before next provincial election. Various high profile



NDP ministers have already announced that they would not be running for the top job. Eby is now supported by a diverse group of MLAs from across the province, including his campaign cochairs, Ravi Kahlon, MLA for Delta North and Minister of Jobs, Economic Recovery and Innovation, and Katrina Chen, MLA for Burnaby-Lougheed and Minister of State for Childcare.

First elected in 2013, in opposition Eby served as the critic for housing and later gaming critic. After the BC NDP formed government in 2017, he was appointed Attorney General and minister responsible for ICBC, BCLC and gaming. Most recently, he held the position of Attorney General and minister responsible for Housing.

Surrey Mayoral race intensifies with Liberal MP Sukh Dhaliwal and Former White Rock Mayor Gordie Hogg announcing their names for the post

They may have shared common side of the ideology in federal politics, but when it comes to municipal battleground. two Liberal MPs a current and a former, are up against each other to win the race for the post of Surrey Mayor.

Liberal MP from Surrey Newton Sukh Dhaliwal announced his slate United Surrey for the upcoming municipal elections. With Dhaliwal as mayoral candidate, United Surrey was launched on July 18 with City Council candidates including former NDP Member of Parliament Jasbir Sandhu, Julie Tapley, Jeff Bridge and Becky Zhou. Dhaliwal, a well-known face in the South Asian community and a long-standing MP from Surrey-Newton, said that his slate was composed of people from different backgrounds. Jeff Bridge, is a small business owner, Becky Zhou is an educationist and Julie Tapley is real estate professional. When asked about how Jasbir Sandhu, who was an NDP MP. Dhaliwal said, "Our slate represents diverse experiences and distinct political backgrounds and belief systems, yet we are unified by our shared commitment to ending division."

The next day, Surrey First launched its municipal election campaign by naming former Surrey MLA and MP Gordie Hogg as its mayoral candidate, and introducing the first three of its slate of eight council nominees, including current city councilor Linda Annis, Bilal Cheema and Mary-Em Waddington.

Hogg, who began his career as a youth probation officer in Whalley, before being elected as a Surrey MLA and MP, was introduced at the campaign launch by current Councillor Linda Annis. Hogg introduced

other two candidates. Cheema has been an advisor to several federal ministers, including Health, Fisheries and Oceans, and Immigration, Mary-Em is Executive Director of the BC Technology for Learning Society.

When it comes to election agenda's Dhaliwal has promised some concrete actions with a four-point action plan, including: an immediate one-year tax freeze, an incremental rollback of the Land Parcel Tax to Pre-2018 Levels (\$100), expansion of fields and parks and shortest development permit approval times in Metro Vancouver within two years, with an initial focus on

Hogg, on the other hand, sees three "big opportunities" for a new Surrey council, some specific like giving Surrey voters the final say on police transition, more and better access to city hall, and some general

tunity city" that provides prosperity and livability for residents, families and businesses.

When asked about police transition, one of the biggest contested issue, Brenda Locke is promising to overturn the transition and Sims has promised to study the details before making a decision, Dhaliwal said the move is too far underway to reverse now and had no intention of reversing it. Hogg wants to give Surrey voters the final say on police transition.

Dhaliwal and Hogg have different election promises, however, when it comes to decision to jump into municipal election, all mayoral candidates seem to have a same reason. Dhaliwal and Hogg join NDP MLA Jinny Sims and Brenda Locke, who are up against each other but all for one cause "to fix the broken City Hall" and bring down

current Surrey's Mayor Doug McCallum who wants to be re-elected.

Apart from working to fix the city hall or police transition, no mayoral candidate has yet promised anything big and concrete to fix other problems that a city like Surrey is currently struggling with for example, housing, transit, health care, drug overdose or even gang violence. Although Dhaliwal said that his slate will continue to introduce components of its vision for the future of Surrey over the coming months, with a costed full platform to be released during the official campaign period. Hogg on the other hand has then plan to have candidate like Bilal, who according to him, will bring a strong understanding of government decision making to city hall and who knows how important federal and provincial partnerships are to a growing city like Surrey.

BC Corrections announced that it is ending its arrangement with the Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) on the management of individuals held under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act.

BC committed to a review of BC Corrections' arrangement with the CBSA on holding immigration detainees in provincial correctional centres. This review examined all aspects of the ar-

BC Corrections not to hold immigration detainees in provincial correctional centres anymore

According to CBSA data, 94 per cent of immigration detainees are held for administrative reasons and pose no risk to the public

rangement, including its effect on public safety and whether it aligns with the United Nations Standard Minimum Rules for the Treatment of Prisoners and expectations set by Canadian courts.

As part of the review, BC Corrections engaged with multiple external stakeholders and advocacy groups, including Amnesty International and Human Rights Watch, and incorporated their

The review brought to light that aspects of the arrangement do not align with our government's commitment to upholding human-rights standards or our dedication to pursuing social justice and equity for everyone.

In light of these findings, the

Province is ending its arrangement with the CBSA, BC Corrections will provide the CBSA with 12 months' written notice required under the cur-

rent arrangement.

"BC Corrections committed to working with the **CBSA** to develop a safe and efficient transition plan that achieves our common commitment to public safety while ensuring the rights of individuals are preserved and protected," said Mike Farnworth, Minister of Public Safety and Solicitor General,

BC Introduces 3-Day Homebuyer **Protection Period**

The homebuyer protec-I tion period will come into effect on Jan. 1, 2023, includes a cancellation fee of 0.25% of the purchase price, or \$250 for every \$100,000

The real estate market sales will witness another bump in the form of cool off period. BC has introduced a 3 day homebuyer

protection period to protect people from being pressured into high-risk sales.

The period is the first of its kind in Canada and marks the first key action the Province is taking based on the B.C. Financial Services Authority's (BCFSA) report on ways to offer homebuyers better consumer protection in the real estate market.

The mandatory three-day period will give homebuyers an opportunity to take important steps, such as securing financing or arranging home inspections, as they prepare to make one of their biggest financial decisions

"Too many people have been faced with giving up an inspection in order to buy a home," said Selina Robinson, Minister of Finance. "This is a major step toward providing homebuvers with the peace of mind they deserve while protecting the interests of people selling their homes - for today's market and in the future.'

The homebuyer protection period will come into effect on Jan. 1, 2023. It includes a recission (cancellation) fee of 0.25% of the purchase price, or \$250 for every \$100,000,

for those who choose to back out of a deal. For example, if the purchaser exercises the right of rescission on a \$1-million home, they would be required to pay \$2,500 to the seller.

Buyers still may make offers conditional on home inspections or financing at any time. The protection period will offer homebuyers the opportunity for due diligence at times when conditions are not in place. With this B.C. becomes the first province to implement a homebuyer protection period for resale property and newly constructed homes. Cooling-off periods for pre-construction sales of multi-unit development properties, like condominiums, are in place under the Real Estate Development and Marketing Act.

B.C. Court of Appeal Decision Against Dr. Day in Private Health Care Case is Great News For All of

British Columbia's Court of Appeal ruled last week that a medicare law that prohibits patients from paying for faster access to health care does not violate their constitutional rights, even if they must endure longer waits in the public system. The decision is good news for all of us who want to see public healthcare strengthened.

The decision, released on July 15, upholds the law aimed at ensuring access to medical care in the

public system is based on need, not a patient's ability to pay. Cambie Surgery Centre CEO Brian Day launched this constitutional challenge to public health care in BC in 2009 after he learned his private for-profit surgical clinics were going to be audited by the BC Government. The audit was triggered by patients who complained that they had been illegally over-billed at Cambie Surgeries clinics. An audit later revealed that Day's clinics had overcharged patients by almost half a million dollars in just 30 days. At that point he challenged that ruling and filed a Charter challenge. He alleged that the Canada Health Act and provincial health legislation violate his freedom by restricting private, for-profit health care.

The Cambie Surgery Centre openly flouts the province's medicare law by allowing patients to pay out-of-pocket for surgical procedures. He argues that patients have the right to pay out-of-pocket for necessary procedures if wait times in the public system are too long. The Cambie Surgery Centre sought to overturn provisions of B.C.'s Medicare Protection Act, including bans on extra-billing and private insurance, by invoking Section 7 of the Charter of Rights and Freedoms.

The B.C. Supreme Court had dismissed the constitutional challenge in September 2020. Justice John Steeves ruled that provisions in B.C.'s Medicare Protection Act did not violate patients' charter rights. He found no evidence that anyone died from long waits, but that some patients were deprived of their right to security because of harms caused by excessive waits. However, his ruling was this deprivation was in accordance with "fundamental justice" because it was not grossly disproportionate, over-broad or arbitrary.

A three-judge panel with the B.C. Court of Appeal dismissed the challenge in a 142-page decision. Chief Justice Robert Bauman and Justice David Harris said that although the provisions do deprive some patients of their rights to life and security of the person, they do so in accordance with principles of fundamental justice because they ensure public health care is sustainable.

Man with significant concern to public safety charged

in murder of Maple Ridge's Cashmere Ali

The Integrated Homicide In-I vestigation Team informed that Justin Michael Wareing, of Maple Ridge was arrested and charges of second degree murder were laid, relating to the homicide of 35-year-old Cashmere Ali who was shot at her resident on July 15. Wareing is known to police and is believed to be a significant concern to public safety in the Maple Ridge area.

"Maple Ridge is safer today with Mr. Wareing in custody," says Ser"The investigation still remains active, as we continue to build a complete image of what led to this event. We continue to urge those with information or those who had interactions with Mr. Wareing or Ms. Ali to come forward.'

On July 15, 2022 at 8:40 a.m., the Ridge Meadows RCMP responded to a report of a woman and man suffering from gunshot wounds at a residence in the 22600 block of 119 Avenue, Maple Ridge, BC.

geant Timothy Pierotti, of IHIT. Officers on scene provided emergency first aid to the woman, identified as Ms. Ali, who later succumbed to her injuries in hospital. The man suffered non-life threatening injuries.

> IHIT took conduct of the investigation and after relentless work in partnership with Ridge Meadows RCMP, the BC Integrated Forensic Identification Section (IFIS), the Integrated Emergency Response Team (IERT), the Combined Forces Special Enforcement Unit of

British Columbia (CFSEU-BC) and the BC Coroners Service, investigators identified the shooter as Justin Michael Wareing, of Maple Ridge, BC.

IHIT identified the deceased woman as 35-year-old Cashmere Ali, in hopes of advancing the investigation.

IHIT did not release the name of the male victim, out of respect for his privacy.

No further details will be released as the matter is now before the



court, IHIT informed.

Surrey's Brandon Nandan found guilty and sentenced to 15 years for drug trafficking, conspiracy to commit murder

Brandon Nandan, a 28-year-old male from Surrey, has been convicted and sentenced to 15 years in prison after being charged with 17 criminal offences following a Combined Forces Special Enforcement Unit of British Columbia (CFSEU-BC)-led investigation that proactively targeted an alleged drug trafficking network and involved a conspiracy to commit murder.

In late 2020, CFSEU-BC worked with the Surrey and Burnaby RCMP in response to information learned of an alleged conspiracy to commit murder. The investigation identified one suspect who was believed to be plotting to commit the murder. Due to an increased risk to

the public because of the potentially lethal drugs being produced and distributed in the lower mainland. CFSEU-BC worked with the Surrey RCMP, who released public safety bulletins warning of these potentially lethal batches of drugs being distributed.

In December 2020 CFSEU-BC, with assistance from Burnaby RCMP, Surrey RCMP, and Lower Mainland District Integrated Emergency Response Team (LMD IERT), executed search warrants in multiple jurisdictions around the lower mainland. The suspect was found at one of the search locations and was arrested.

The following was seized as a result of the search warrants: • 1 kg of fentanyl • 1 kg of methamphetamine • 1kg of cocaine • several firearms • 2 firearms suppressors • Various prohibited and non-prohibited weapons.

On March 18th, 2021 Brandon Nandan, a 28-year-old male from Surrey, was charged with Criminal Code and Drug Offences.

On July 20th, 2022 Brandon Nandan pleaded guilty to various charges related to drug trafficking, possession of fentanyl for the purpose of trafficking and possession of firearm. Brandon Nandan was sentenced to a total of 15 years imprisonment with a mix of consecutive and concurrent sentences for the offences he pleaded guilty to.



isting rubberized walking track, it brings the total rubber walking loop size for the park to over 900 meters. The surface is a sandwich system of two layers of rubber on top of an asphalt base with a concrete border. The rubberized surface minimizes the impact on the body.

The new artificial turf field is the City of Surrey's 17th full-sized FIFA regulation artificial turf field. It includes covered and well-sheltered player, official and spectator seating. The spectator seating has 72 seats and two wheelchair spots. The field also includes tournament level LED field lighting and lines and markings for soccer, mini soccer, and lacrosse. The irrigation also makes it safer and more comfortable play during heat waves.

Newton Athletic Park is a 22-hectare premiere sport and recreation destination with amenities including artificial turf and grass sports fields, cricket pitches, tennis, volleyball, and basketball courts, and a spray park. This is the sixth artificial turf field and second rubber walking track for the park, that will be complemented with a new fieldhouse containing washrooms and changerooms in 2023 for the enjoyment of families and sports enthusiasts alike. It is one of more than 200 parks that have active amenities such as sports fields, sport courts, playgrounds, community gardens or picnic areas. Racism Exited, Continues To Exist In Every Corner Of The World

(This article is continuation of the article on Racism and Discrimination)

he following are just a few examples of Skin tone based racism found impacting coloured human beings. Let us start from the country where thousands of South Asians have chosen to live their lives feeling settled. Though the examples of Canadian racism are few and far in between, they are strongly significant. Start from the 1914 incident of the Koma-gata-maru Japanese ship that entered the Vancouver Harbor with 376 Indians passengers on board, but only 24 of them were allowed to disembark, the remaining 352

of Sir Richard McBride, the then Premier of B.C., who did not want coloured people to enter his province, because, "to admit Orientals in large numbers would mean the extinction of the white people. And we always have in mind the necessity of keeping this a white man's country.'

Then, unlike the Koma-gata-maru, 907 Jewish refugees came aboard the MS St. Louis, seeking shelter in 1939. They too were denied entry to Canada. The ship returned its passengers to assumed safe harbours in four European countries. However, sadly, 254 of them later perished in the Holocaust. But the Canadian discriminatory policy did not end there; it continued. In 1942, Japanese Canadian citizens were forced out of their homes into internment started from 1957, when Prime Minister John Diefenbaker appointed Ellen Fairclough as Secretary of State, who liberalized immigration policies. However, nothing changed substantially until Prime Minister Pear Elliot Trudeau took the control of this country. He changed the face of immigration policies, reinforcing the existing Bill of Rights (1968) by enshrining the Charter of Rights and Freedoms (1982) in the Canadian constitution.

Let us talk about 1945 Europe and Adolf Hitler, the God Father of racists. He loved and propagated racial purity and slaughtered six million innocent Jews to make his point, "... It is, in any case, undesirable that one race should mix with other races. Except for a few gratuitous successes, which I am prepared to admit, systematduced good results. The desire to remain racially pure is a proof of the vitality and good health of a race." -- The Political Testament of Adolf Hitler; 13th February

I opine, racism and discrimination are still alive and breathing in certain European cities. For example, Vienna and Bruges were the two cities we experienced blatant intolerance and rudeness towards the people of colour. Immigration officers were determined to make us miss our flight. They put us in a room where there was no exit except stairs to go to the upper floor, but happened to be locked from the other side. Fortunately, we heard the sound of a couple coming down. They opened that door which we grabbed to escape. Let us talk about our southern neighbours; their 1950 film, "No Way Out;" clearly describes the racist behaviour of a white mother, who ordered Dr. Sydney Poitier to "Keep your black hands off my son," whereas, all he was trying to do was to treat the bleeding wounds of her son. Then, what about Harper Lee's 1960 film "To Kill a Mockingbird;" depicting white and black prejudice!

My memory of the 1970 racial riots of Los Angeles, burning of businesses and images of savagely being beaten Rodney King, a black man by white Police Officers are still alive in my mind. They are followed by the 1976, Alex Haley's "Roots," a lively portrayal of skin based racism... I bet you remember May 25, 2020 brutality against George Floyd; a black man! One of the four arresting Police Officers had pinned him down with his knee on his neck for almost nine minutes and killed him, while Mr. Floyd continued to say, "I can't breathe."

Mr. Floyd suffocated and died. What about May 15, 2022 episode, when a white gunman, named Gendron sought out Black victims. The offender had been fixated on the "great replacement" theory, which posits that there is a plot to supplant white Americans with supposedly more tractable minorities. "That world view, in this Trump-distorted era, is not rare... There is a group of people in this country (the USA) who are trying to replace native born Americans with immigrants who agree with their views....Thirty-two political per cent either 'somewhat" or "strongly" agreed." -- The New Yorker; May 30, 2022; page: 13. However, despite how I feel about these racist incidents, I am fortunate to be born in India and living in Canada. My karma must have a big hand in bringing me over here, or I could have been born in Haiti to be forced to sexually assault my own mother (2010), or born in Bosnia to be killed and thrown in the river (1992) during their ethnic cleansing, or living in Rwanda to be killed as a Tutsi (1994).

Draupadi Murmu, India's First Tribal President, Overcame Great Personal Tragedies

al community born in a remote part of eastern India has been elected our President!" Prime Minister Narendra Modi said on Twitter.

This appointment, although is largely symbolic and ceremonial, will send a strong message of equality and opportunity for all.

Over 4,500 lawmakers from both the national and state parliaments voted in the presidential election, Murmu managed to secure victory with the backing of her Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) which is currently in power. "Elated by all of the support from my all political colleagues Ministers, MP's and MLA's from all around India for choosing me to serve as the 15th President in the world's largest democratic country Mother India," Murmu wrote on her Twitter.

Murmu belongs to the Santhal tribe of Odisha which is spread over several states in eastern India.

She had worked as a teacher before entering the political arena. Murmu has been a legislator twice, on a BJP ticket, in 2000 and 2009.

In 2015, Murmu was appointed as the first female governor of the eastern state of Jharkhand and held the position until July 2021.

Some see Murmu's presidential election as a triumph of tribal political aspirations and a breakthrough moment for the community, which has long been neglected and exploited under several governments.

Having been born into a tribal family that was battling with poverty in one of the country's most remote and underdeveloped districts, her childhood had been full of challenges.

Overcoming all odds, she earned her Bachelor's degree in Arts from Ramadevi Women's College in Bhubaneswar and served as a junior assistant in the irrigation and power department in the Odisha government.

She began her political career as the vice-chairman of the Rairangpur NAC. In addition, the Odisha the Odisha Legislative Assembly honoured her with its Best MLA of the Year 2007 award.

She has diverse administrative experience having handled ministries such as transport, commerce, fisheries and animal husbandry in the Odisha government.

Murmu has come a long way to reach where she is today. India's new President overcame several personal tragedies in her life. In just six years between 2009-2015, Murmu lost her husband, two sons, mother and brother. According to reports, it was then the tribal leader became a keen practitioner of the meditation techniques of the Brahma Kumaris, a movement she embraced after her personal losses.

Murmu had three children - two sons and a daughter - with her husband Shyam Charan Murmu. According to news reports, one of her sons died under mysterious circumstances in 2009 while her second son passed away in a road accident three years later. She had lost her husband earlier because of cardiac arrest. Murmu's daughter Itishree works in a bank in Odisha.

British Columbians Urged To Prepare For Potential Heat

Warnings

VICTORIA - British Columbians can expect higher temperatures as a high-pressure ridge is moving into B.C. and may result in heat warnings this weekend or early next week.

Hot and dry weather for many parts of British Columbia is predicted by Environment and Climate Change Canada. While the current forecast suggests a dip in daytime high temperatures late

this week, there is potential for the high-pressure ridge to ramp up this weekend and into next week, which may lead to higher temperatures.

However, B.C. is not currently anticipating an extreme heat emergency. People are encouraged to monitor Environment and Climate Change Canada for temperature forecasts in their region.

A higher risk of heat-related illness is associated with increasing temperatures and it is critical people have a heat plan to keep safe. A heat plan should identify cool zones inside and outside of homes (such as community centres and libraries), ways to cool down (such as taking cool baths or showers and drinking plenty of water), and identify vulnerable family members and neighbours who are susceptible to heat and should be checked on.

Although heat is expected, bodies of water remain cool for this time of year and may pose a risk of hypothermia to people exposed to cold water for a prolonged period. People



should also be cautious when near high or fast rivers and lakes.

The Province released an Extreme Heat Preparedness Guide in June to help people prepare for extreme heat with tips about how to stay safe when temperatures rise. The guide is available in French,

Punjabi, traditional Chinese and simplified Chinese.

Heat illnesses include heat stroke, heat exhaustion, heat fainting, heat edema (swelling of hands, feet and ankles), heat rash and heat cramps (muscle cramps).

People should watch for symptoms such as dizziness or fainting, nausea or vomiting, confusion, headache, rapid breathing and heartbeat, extreme thirst, and decreased urination with unusually dark yellow urine.

If someone experiences any of these symptoms during extreme heat, they should immediately move to a cool place, start cooling down and drink liquids. If symptoms are not mild, last longer than one hour, change, worsen or cause concern, immediately contact a health-care provider.

B.C. Pumps More Funding In Digital Marketing Bootcamp To Encourage Small Businesses Hone Digital Skills

RICHMOND – Small businesses are at the heart of BC's economy. In order for more BC businesses, to hone their skills in digital marketing, the BC government is extending its Digital Marketing Bootcamp program.

The Province has provided Alacrity Canada with an additional \$1.5 million to run the program and support more than 2,000 B.C. businesses and their employees to acquire the digital marketing skills they need to shift through economic recovery and beyond. In total, the Province has provided \$6 million to the online program.

Through this program and our StrongerBC Economic Plan, B.C. business owners are empowered with knowledge, tools and skills that will help them pivot their businesses to match the needs of the changing digital world.

"Launched in late 2019 and extended in the summer of 2021, the Digital Marketing Bootcamp program has helped more than 6,000 participants get their business online, adapt to changing business models, respond to changing customer demands and spur business growth," said Ravi Kahlon, Minister of Jobs, Economic Recovery and Innovation.

According to BC government, 98% of B.C. businesses are small businesses and they employ more than one million British Columbians, account for 36% of B.C.'s exports and 34% of B.C.'s gross domestic product.

The Digital Marketing Bootcamp has benefited all kinds of small businesses, such as hobby shops, restaurants and content creators. For example, after taking the course, Sharaz Kassam of Shamin Jewellery, which operates three stores in Metro Vancouver, noticed an increase in online sales within 30 days of completing the bootcamp.

"Taking the Digital Marketing Bootcamp helped me pivot my business to take advantage



of growing online interest," said Kassam. "I am now using my new skills to fine-tune my website and social media presence, and sales have continued to rise. As a small business owner, I found the bootcamp very helpful."

As part of the program, 30% of the participant seats are reserved for people from rural communities (outside the Capital Regional District and Lower Mainland) or people who identify as Indigenous, Black or people of colour (IB-POC).

In addition to extending the Digital Marketing Bootcamp, the Province has begun the next steps in developing the Small Business Diversity and Inclusion Action Plan, which aims to support under-represented entrepreneurs in British Columbia.

Consultation with the business community, specifically with representatives of IB-POC, women, persons with disabilities, 2SLGBTQ+, newcomers and youth entrepreneurs, is underway to discuss further actions to reduce barriers and provide comprehensive support.

26 year old Pardeep Brar fatally shot in Toronto Night Club

TORONTO: Toronto police informed on Sunday, July 17, 2022, at 3:33 a.m., officers responded to 647 King Street West for reports of a shooting.

The victim was identified the victim was 26 year old Pardeep Brar, a resident of Brampton in the greater Toronto area.

According to police, officers located two people who had been shot inside a night-club, 24-year-old woman was transported to hospital with non life-threating injuries, a 26-year-old man was transported to hospital with life-threatening injuries, the man was pronounced deceased at the hospital, the woman was treated at the hospital and has since been released. There is no suspect information at this time, the police said.

Brar succumbed to the gunshot wound and was pronounced dead on Monday.

Toronto police's homicide unit is investigating the shooting, but no suspects have been named as yet or any motive attributed for the crime.

Police have requested the public's assistance in identifying potential suspects

in this case. Investigators have sought information from those who may have witnessed the shooting in the nightclub. They also asked anyone with a video of the shooting to contact investigators. They also released an image of the victim.

One of the relatives of Brar spoke out in public and in various media interviews about gun violence. In an interview to Toronto Sun Ramandeep Brar said, ""The common question everyone is asking is why not control the guns. We need harder sentences for these guys, but they get out on bail in a few months.

Brar said on the night Pardeep was killed, he didn't even want to go out.

"A friend called and said he was having a bad day and wanted Pardeep to join him at a party. He never came home," said Ramandeep Brar, a former Conservative Party of Canada MP candidate for Brampton South in the 2019 federal election.

"He shouldn't have been shot. He was trying to help a waitress who had been shot when he was shot in the liver," Ramandeep said, adding he believes it was a stray bullet that killed Pardeep.

BC Corrections not to hold immigration detainees in provincial...

"Migrants will no longer be put in B.C. jails simply for administrative reasons like missing documentation once this change takes effect. CBSA may still hold migrants in a detention centre, but this a significant first step towards affirming the human rights of detainees," said the Commissioner

"According to CBSA data, 94 per cent of immigration detainees are held for administrative reasons and pose no risk to the public. Detaining innocent migrants in jails is cruel, unjust and violates human rights commitments," said Commissioner Goven-

der. "Now, it is up to the federal government to abolish all migrant detention and expand the use of community-based alternatives that support individuals." Almost nine thousand people across Canada, including 138 children, were forced into detention in the year prior to the pandemic. (Human Rights Watch and Amnesty International report. 1) Migrants report being handcuffed, shackled, searched, subjected to solitary confinement, restricted to small spaces with rigid routines, and placed under constant surveillance with severely limited access to the outside world.

Two Gangsters Allegedly Involved Sidhu Moosewala Murder Killed In Police Encounter

CHANDIGARH: Two gangsters allegedly involved in the murder of singer Sidhu Moosewala were killed in a nearly four-hour-long encounter with the Punjab Police at an Amritsar village on Wednesday, an officer said.

Three policemen and a journalist were also injured, said police.

Jagroop Singh Rupa and Manpreet Singh, alias Manu Kusa, were killed in the operation that lasted for around five hours and ended around 4 pm, Additional Director General of Police Pramod Ban told reporters in Amritsar.

"Both died in a heavy exchange of fire," he added.

Punjab police said in a Tweet, "Sidhu-Moosewala murder: AGTF ADGP Promod Ban confirms the operation concluded successfully as both Manpreet Mannu & Jagroop Roopa, who killed #Moosewala were neutralized in a heavy exchange of



fire. Police also recovered an AK-47 along with heavy ammunition from the spot." Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann congratulated the Punjab Police for its operation.

"Congratulations to the Punjab Police and the Anti-gangster Task Force for their big success in a campaign started by my government against the gangster culture and anti-social elements," said Mann in a tweet

He said peace and brotherhood in Punjab will be maintained at all costs.

Shubhdeep Singh Sidhu, popularly known as Sidhu Moosewala, was shot dead in Punjab's Mansa district on May 29.

Roopa and Kusa hid themselves in a building at Bhakna village near the India-Pakistan border in Amritsar. Both the gangsters were at large after the killing of the singer. The area was cordoned off and the locals told to stay indoors, said police.

Gunshots were heard from the site where the accused were thought to be hiding. A heavy police force was deployed at the village.

Later addressing a press conference, Ban said the Punjab Police teams have been following these two gangsters.

"We were getting their footprints at various places, we had the latest information about their movement which was noted in this area," said Ban while sharing details of the operation.

"Since morning, our teams had been conducting their recce and they were sighted in that area. They ran and went inside a house," said Ban.

The AGTF chief said the Punjab Police warned them to surrender but they opened fire at the police teams.

Replying to a question, Ban said the gangsters will be finished from the state. "We are going for a crackdown against the gangsters. The Punjab Police will ensure this gangster culture is finished from the state," he said.

Ban said it is a message to all criminals who are operating in the state. "Either you surrender or law will take its own course," he said.







Watch Out For Rental Scams This Summer

Vancouver: With rising costs, low vacancy rates, and high demands for both short and long-term rentals, BBB anticipates that rental scams will be on the rise this summer.

"Students are looking to find their first homes after graduating from school, add that on to the pressure of families looking for vacation rentals, and this is the perfect storm for a scam artist looking to cash in on," explained Simone Lis, President and CEO of BBB Serving Mainland BC.

Scammers will advertise online fake rental listings luring consumers into making bookings and sending money. Once the renters send payment to secure the listing, they often find out that the property doesn't exist, is unavailable for rent, or isn't the scammer's property to list in the first place.

BBB has also noticed a significant increase in the average consumer losses from rental scams this year. Since January 2022, Canadian reports to the BBB had an average loss of \$1,230, which is a 160%

increase compared to the same period last

One BC student shared her experience with BBB last summer, stating, "I found a two-bedroom apartment on Craigslist for \$1,475 a month. It seemed to be a great deal, so I contacted the landlord. He told me that he had moved to Spain due to work reasons. Therefore, the apartment was vacant, and I could move in anytime. He added that he had never rented this apartment before and wanted to find a responsible tenant to take good care of it. He told me he was using a global rental company to find the tenant and provided me with a link to the company. Since the company's policy required me to transfer a deposit before seeing the house, I sent them \$3,000 using the link he provided. At first, I could talk with the customer service on the website. But now, I can't reach them anymore. I tried to find the legitimate founder of the company, only to learn the company had been closed and it was probably a scam."

Some BBB tips to keep in mind when looking for a rental property:

Be wary of deals that sound too good to be true. Scammers lure you in by promising low rents, extra amenities, and a great location. Spend some time finding out how much other rental properties in the area cost before signing a lease. If it seems too good to be true, it just might be.

Search online for similar properties. Do a quick search for the listing, listed email address, or phone number. If you find the same ad listed in other cities, that's a huge red flag.

See the property in person. Don't send money to someone you've never met for an apartment you haven't seen. If you can't visit an apartment or house yourself, ask someone you trust to go and confirm that it is what was advertised.

Never pay with cash, wire transfer or hard-to-trace equivalents such as Moneygram or Bitcoin. These forms of payment are impossible to track. Instead, use bank cheques or money orders, or email FOR RENT

money transfers, but only when you are certain of the legitimacy of your rental arrangement. Always ask for a rent receipt once payment is made.

Don't provide confidential info that can be used for identity theft. Avoid handing over confidential information such as your Social Insurance Number (SIN) or bank information to the wrong hands. A landlord can check your credit history with just your full name, current address and birth date.

A written lease helps prevent fraud and lays out the rights and responsibilities

of both parties. Landlords are legally required to use the provincial standard lease form. Ensure the price and any amenities that should be included as part of your monthly payment are listed in the lease.

Ensure you are dealing with an authorized representative. The written lease is also required to include the names and contact information of the landlord (owner or management company). Ensure that it indicates the person you are dealing with. Ask them to show a picture ID as proof that they are who is named in the document if you have any doubt. You could also ask to see previous utility bills for the residence to confirm they are indeed the landlord.

Ask for a second opinion. Don't be embarrassed to consult with friends, family members or your local BBB, who may be more knowledgeable on the subject if there are doubts or questions.



Amber Files Notice of Appeal Against \$10 Mn Defamation Suit



os Angeles: Hollywood actress Amber Heard filed a notice of appeal on Thursday of the \$10 million defamation verdict that a Virginia jury awarded to her ex-husband and Hollywood star Johnny Depp.

Heard's lawyers had announced that they would appeal immediately after the jury found on June 1 that she had defamed Depp by publishing an op-ed in the Washington Post in which she described herself as a "public figure representing domestic abuse, reports Variety.

The jury held that the statement was false and was made with "actual malice." "We believe the court made errors that prevented a just and fair verdict consistent with the First Amendment," Heard's spokesperson said on Thursday.

"We are therefore appealing the verdict. While we realise today's filing will ignite the Twitter bonfires, there are steps we need to take to ensure both fairness and justice." In response, Depp's representative said that his team remains confident the verdict will be upheld. "The jury listened to the extensive evidence presented during the sixweek trial and came to a clear and unanimous verdict that the defendant herself defamed Mr. Depp, in multiple instanchis spokesperson

"We remain confident in our case and that this verdict will stand."

The jury found that three statements in the oped were defamatory, and

awarded \$10 million in compensatory damages and \$5 million in punitive damages. The punitive damages award was then lowered to \$350,000 to comply with Virginia's statutory cap.

The jury also found Depp liable for a statement made by his attorney, Adam Waldman, in which he accused Heard of fabricating a "hoax".

The jury ordered Depp to pay \$2 million for that statement.

According to Variety, Heard's lawyers had previously asked Judge Penney Azcarate to set aside the verdict for several reasons, including the allegation that one of the jurors showed up to the trial despite never receiving a summons. Azcarate denied Heard's request, finding that she had waited too long to raise her objection and had not shown she was denied a fair trial.
