Strawberry Hill plaza, a place that once boasted of be-

ing a cherished plaza by many Surrey families featuring different shops, cineplex and restaurants has now become

a hotspot of confrontations, arguments and altercations. A recent brawl between a bunch of youth and a police officer at the Strawberry Hill Plaza located at 72nd avenue and Scott Road, has again hit the nerve of the Surrey community. This week, a video of the incident started circulating on social media where an RCMP officer is seen refusing to give his badge number and then seen leaving in his vehicle. The use of extreme foul language by those arguing with the officer can be heard loud and clear in the video. Then some people from the group are seen obstructing the police vehicle when it was leaving the area.

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Close to 200 People Die in BC in July 2022 Due To Toxic Drugs

VICTORIA - The illicit drug supply in British Columbia continues to devastate communities throughout the province, with at least 192 lives lost to toxic substances in July, according to preliminary reporting released by the BC Coroners Service.

"As they have for the past seven years, these numbers reflect the ever-present threat that illicit drugs pose to substance users across B.C.," said Lisa Lapointe, chief coroner. "The unregulated drug market continues to be volatile and toxic, and anyone using drugs purchased from illicit suppliers is at high risk for serious harm or death. We continue to urge those using illicit drugs to access drug-checking services, where available, or visit overdose-prevention sites, where

available."

The 192 lives lost in July represent a 31% increase over the number of deaths recorded in June 2022 (147), and equates to approximately 6.2 deaths per day. Nearly 1,300 deaths due to toxic drugs have been reported to the BC Coroners Service between January and July, which is a record number for the first seven months of a calendar year.

The largest numbers of illicit drug toxicity deaths in 2022 have been recorded in the Fraser and Vancouver Coastal Health Authorities (404 and 360 deaths, respectively), with these two health authorities accounting for 59% of all such deaths during 2022. The highest rates of death in 2022 continue to be reported in Northern Health (53 deaths

per 100,000 individuals) and Vancouver Coastal Health (49 per 100,000). Overall, the rate

of death in B.C. in 2022 is 42 per 100,000 individuals, more than twice the death rate in 2016 when the public-health emergency was declared.

Illicit drug toxicity is the leading cause of unnatural death in British Columbia and is second only to cancers in terms of years of life lost. At least 10,158 British Columbians have been lost to the illicit drug supply since the public-health emergency of substance-related harms was first declared in April 2016.

"Families and communities across the province are continuing to suffer the sudden and tragic deaths of loved ones due to toxic drugs," said Lapointe. "Whether they are chronically substance-dependent or using only occasionally, all of those

who access the illicit drug market are vulnerable to serious harms. The subject-matter experts on the recent death review panel urgently recommended significant expansion of safer supply in communities throughout the province in order to reduce the devastation caused by this public-health crisis."

Additional key preliminary findings are below. Data is subject to change as additional

In 2022, 84% of illicit drug toxicity deaths have occurred inside (57% in private residences and 27% in other inside residences, such as social and supportive housing, single-room occupancies, shelters, hotels and other indoor locations) and 15% occurred outside in vehicles, parks, on sidewalks, streets, etc.

Indian High Commission Relaxes Requirement to submit old/canceled passport

In view of difficulties faced by aged persons of Indian origin who arrived in Canada long ago and are unable to trace their old Indian passports, the High Commission has decided to relax the requirement of providing Surrender Certificate/ old cancelled Indian Passport.

Person of Indian origin who acquired Canadian citizenship before June, 2010 and are unable to provide copy of Surrender Certificate / old Indian Passport may provide a duly notarized Affidavit with regard to unavailability of Surrender

Certificate / old cancelled Indian Passport. The format of Affidavit can be seen on the Mission's website at the link below:

All Indian Passport holders, after obtaining foreign nationality, are compulsorily required by law to surrender their Indian Passports at the nearest Indian Mission/Post. Those Indian Origin Canadian/foreign nationals who are yet to surrender their Indian

Passports are advised do so immediately and obtain a Surrender Certificate.

Persons of Indian Origin having the Surrender Certificate/ old cancelled Indian Passport may continue to submit a copy of Surrender Certificate/ old cancelled Indian Passport with their visa application.

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Prime Minister Trudeau Announces \$4.5 Billion Inflation Relief Package

Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau announced \$4.5 billion in measures on Tuesday to provide relief from high inflation to low-income families. The Prime Minister announced that the government's first pieces of legislation introduced in the upcoming Parliamentary sitting would make life more affordable for Canadians who need it most. The measures in these bills would: Double the Goods and Services Tax Credit (GSTC) for six months, delivering support to

roughly 11 million individuals and families who receive the tax credit, including about half of Canadian families with children, and more than half of Canadian seniors. Single Canadians without children would receive up to an extra \$234 and couples with two children would receive up to an extra \$467 in their pockets this year. Seniors would receive an extra \$225 on average. Provide a Canada Dental Benefit to children under 12 who do not have access to dental insurance, starting this year. Direct payments totalling up to \$1,300 per child over the next two years (up to \$650 per year) would be provided for dental care services. This is the first stage of the government's plan to deliver dental coverage for families with income under

\$90,000, and will allow children under 12 to get the dental care they need while we develop a comprehensive national dental care program. Provide a one-time top-up to the Canada Housing Benefit to deliver \$500 to 1.8 million Canadian renters who are struggling with the cost of housing. This more than doubles our Budget 2022 commitment, reaching twice as many Canadians as initially promised. This new one-time federal benefit will be in addition to the Canada Housing Benefit currently co-funded and delivered by provinces and territories. The federal benefit will be available to applicants with an adjusted net income below \$35,000 for families, or below \$20,000 for individuals, who pay at least 30 per cent of

their income on rent. "From helping families pay rent to making sure people can afford the dental care they need and putting hundreds of dollars back in the pockets of Canadians, this suite of new measures will support families who need it the most, when they need it the most. As we head into a new Parliamentary sitting, we are working hard to continue delivering results for the middle class and those working hard to join it," he said. In addition to this announcement, according to the federal government, the following measures will support Canadians this year: Enhancing the Canada Workers Benefit at a cost of \$1.7 billion in new support for an estimated three million low-income workers this year, with a couple receiving

up to \$2,400 more this year, and single workers receiving up to \$1,200 more. Most recipients first received this additional support through their 2021 tax refund. Cutting regulated child care fees in half on average for families in Canada by the end of this year. A 10 per cent increase to the Old Age Security (OAS) pension for seniors 75 years and older, which began in July 2022, and will provide more than \$800 in new support to full pensioners over the first year, and increase the number of beneficiaries by more than three million seniors. Providing more support for students by doubling the Canada Student Grant amount until July 2023 and by waiving interest on Canada Student Loans through to March 2023.

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Fourteen More Recruit Constables Join Surrey Police Service

SURREY: Surrey Police Service (SPS) has hired its second class of recruit police officers. This group of fourteen will now begin their training at the Justice Institute of British Columbia (JIBC) to become certified municipal police officers, following a swearing in ceremony that was held by SPS on September 9th.

Like the first SPS recruit class, this group of recruits embodies diversity, exceptional academic and work histories, and a commitment to community. The eight female and six male recruit officers have an average age of 27.5 years and collectively speak seven different languages – English, Punjabi, Hindi, Urdu, French, Spanish and Gujarati. The group not only reflects Sur-

rey's cultural diversity with ten of the fourteen individuals identifying as visible minorities, but they also have deep connections to Surrey with the majority being raised, educated, and residing in the community.

"Commitment to the community we serve is what Surrey Police Service is about and this quality is clearly demonstrated by our newest recruits," says Chief Constable Norm Lipinski. "This is an impressive and exceptional group, and I know they look forward to engaging with the citizens of Surrey through their policing careers with SPS."

The recruits bring a wide range of work experiences ranging from trades, to teaching, to social and health services. Volun-



teerism is also a predominant theme with this group with contributions to crime prevention, women's support services, youth sports and elder support. Many in the group also have impressive athletic backgrounds that include soccer, Brazilian Jiu-jitsu, national level wrestling, the Canadian Football League, and international martial arts.

Surrey Police Service now has

a total of 328 employees, comprised of 274 sworn police officers/recruits and 54 civilian staff. 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Multijurisdictional Homicides, Shooting in Toronto leave Police officer and local business owner dead, 3 injured

Suspect Sean Petrie had an extensive criminal record dating back 20 years

REGION OF PEEL, ON: Officers from the Homicide and Missing Persons Bureau are investigating the murders of Constable Andrew Hong and Mr. Shakeel Ashraf and further shooting incidents that injured three other people in both Peel and Halton Regions. On Monday, September 12, 2022, at approximately 2:15 p.m., police responded to reports of a shooting at the Tim Hortons restaurant located at 3110 Argentinia Road in Mississauga. The 48-year-old Toronto Police Constable Andrew Hong of Traffic Services, was found deceased

inside the restaurant. Constable Hong was instructing at a Police Motorcycle Operations Course sponsored by Peel Regional Police. Constable Hong was on his lunch break when the suspect ambushed and shot him at close range. Shortly after this incident, the suspect fled to a nearby parking lot and, while carjacking a Black SUV, shot the male driver before fleeing the scene. That male was transported to a trauma centre, where he underwent surgery for his injuries. He remains in stable condition and has life-altering injuries.

responded to multiple reports of a shooting at an auto shop in Mil-

ton which resulted in the tragic death of 38-year-old father and business owner Shakeel Ashraf. Two other victims were transported to hospital. They remain in critical and serious conditions and police are not releasing their names at this time. The suspect was later located in Hamilton and was later pronounced deceased as a result of an interaction with police while attempting to take him into custody. The Special Investigations Unit is now investigating. The suspect has been identified as 40-year-old Sean Petrie,

Burnaby's Ahmed Tahir sentenced to life for 2021 homicide

BURNABY: A 21-year old man has been sentenced to life in jail for a 2021 day-time shooting in Burnaby. On May 8, 2021, at approximately 6:00 p.m., Burnaby RCMP received a report of a shooting in the 7700-block of 6th Street, Burnaby. First responders arrived on scene and found 19-year old, Blerton Dalipi, suffering fatal gun shot injuries. As a result of the quick action of Coquitlam RCMP investigators who were in Burnaby on a separate matter, the sus-

pect, later identified as 21-year old Ahmed Tahir, was quickly apprehended. A second victim, who had suffered non life-threatening injuries was later identified. The Integrated Homicide Investigation Team (IHIT) took conduct of the investigation and worked closely in partnership with the Burnaby RCMP, the Coquitlam RCMP and the Integrated Forensic Identification Section (IFIS). On May 9, 2021, the BC Prosecution Service (BCPS) laid a first degree murder charge against Ta-

hir in relation to the homicide of Mr. Dalipi. On June 1, 2022, Tahir entered a guilty plea and was subsequently convicted of second degree murder. On September 9, 2022, Tahir was sentenced to life in jail, without eligibility for parole for 17 years. "Though incredibly young, both Blerton Dalipi and Ahmed Tahir were well known to police," says Sergeant Timothy Pierotti of IHIT. "We're happy with the outcome of this investigation."

Muhammad Mehran Ali of Delta charged in connection with stolen vehicle investigation

Surrey RCMP is advising the public that 22-year-old Muhammad Mehran Ali of Delta has been charged after allegedly stealing a vehicle that was for sale by owner. On August 31, 2022, Surrey RCMP received the report that a vehicle was stolen while being shown to a potential buyer in the 9000-block of 148A Street in Surrey. On September 1, 2022, at ap-

proximately 11:15 p.m. Surrey RCMP Gang Enforcement Team (SGET) was conducting proactive patrols and located the stolen vehicle in the 7600-block of 124 Street. Police attempted to conduct a traffic stop, however, the vehicle fled at a high rate of speed and drove in a manner that was a risk to public safety.

The identity of those involved in the incident with the officer is yet to be determined while the investigations are on but Constable Sarbjit Sangha, Surrey RCMP Media Relations, said, "I cannot speak for every single person depicted in that video, but the person that our officer dealt with was an international student."

Constable Sangha has some strong message for those involved in the incident. She said, "Surrey RCMP is aware of the video circulating on social media, which shows a group of young men surrounding a police vehicle in the Strawberry Hill complex on Sunday September 11, 2022."

According to her, the officer in the video was responding to a complaint received from on-site security that a vehicle with an extremely loud and disruptive exhaust system had been unnecessarily driving around the parking lot and causing a disturbance for the preceding three hours.

While talking to the Link newspaper, Constable Sangha, said, "The officer conducted a traffic stop of that vehicle in the parking area, when inspected he noticed that there were changes made to the muffler of this vehicle and found a device that would make louder sounds."

One person was served a ticket, as well as a notice and order for a vehicle inspection. "Our officer issued a violation ticket to the owner of the vehicle as well as notice in order that the deficiency in the vehicle needed to be fixed with in 30 days and they were supposed to take the vehicle

to an authorized place to make the deficiencies correct. A police officer would inspect the vehicle after changes and the box too should be removed from the vehicle."

Sangha informed that while this interaction was going on between the officer and the driver, "there were other people in the area that joined the driver and became uncooperative with our police officer."

"It came to a point that our officer did not feel safe at the position he was in, he got into his vehicle and decided to leave. Our officer had his lights and signs activated as he was trying to leave the area. The behaviour of the group escalated as the officer re-entered his police vehicle and attempted to leave. Persons involved blocked the police vehicle, attempted to open the driver's door and could

be heard swearing and name calling while filming the incident."

Sangha said that the officer did not know what the situation had escalated into, "if he had not left the area."

It is not the first time the Strawberry Hill complex has become a hotpot of violent incidents or nuisance created by a bunch of youth. When asked if the police have been receiving frequent complaints, she said, "Surrey RCMP continues to work closely with the complex owners and on-site security to address ongoing nuisance behaviours which have caused residents, businesses and families in our community to express that they feel unsafe attending the location. Some of the ongoing concerns expressed include large gatherings, fights, vehicle stunting and other nuisance behaviour."

Everyone has the right to feel safe going anywhere in our city, especially a large business complex with a movie theater that caters to families. Surrey RCMP will continue with enforcement efforts to curb nuisance behaviour in that complex, she added.

Her message to those involved in the incident and also who are part of the problem is clear, "Canada has laws, and regulations for a reason so we can all enjoy the common properties in peace. No one has the right to disobey the law and if you disobey the laws, there are consequences. By doing the burn outs and the loud vehicles you are disturbing people around you."

COVID-19 vaccination requirements for health-care system workers remain in place

VICTORIA – The Hospital and Community (Health Care and other Services) COVID-19 Vaccination Status Information and Preventive Measures and Residential Care COVID-19 Vaccination Status Information and Preventive Measures Provincial Health Officer Orders were updated on Sept. 12.

Consistent with current provincial health officer orders, health-care system workers will continue to be required to be vaccinated with a primary COVID-19 vaccine series, unless they have obtained an exemption from the provincial health officer (PHO).

The scope of these orders has not changed. They continue to apply to people who work for health authorities, agencies funded by health authorities and long-term care and assisted-living facilities.

They do not, however, apply to regulated health professionals who do not work in these settings, such as dentists, naturopathic doctors and opti-

cians.

As per the Health Professionals COVID-19 Vaccination Status Information and Preventive Measures order, issued March 7, 2022, and updated June 10, 2022, regulated health professionals were required to report their vaccination status to their regulatory colleges. This information was aggregated by each health profession and then made publicly available so that patients and clients could make informed decisions when seeking care. Vaccination status information about individual health professionals will not be made public.

Given the high rates of vaccination in these professions, and the current state of the pandemic, the PHO has decided to not require private, regulated health professionals to be vaccinated at this time.

The PHO and the ministry continue to work with these groups and their regulatory colleges on a process for informed decision-making for patients and clients.

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Indian Ex-Servicemen Society of BC commemorates Epic Battle of "Saragarhi"



The Indian Ex-Servicemen Society of BC commemorated the highest gallantry battle of "SARAGARHI" on 12th September at The Riverside Banquet Hall.

The Battle of Saragarhi is one of the greatest last stands in history that was fought on September 12, 1897, by 21 Sikh soldiers of the British India Army against Afghans in the Samana Valley of Pakistan's Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province, which was then part of India. During this battle, all the 21 soldiers of 36 Sikh Regiment fought till their last breath against the Afghan hordes with unprecedented courage and unparalleled valour and went down as superheroes. Here's the story of the Saragarhi's legendary battle.

Saragarhi was a small village in the Kohat district along with the Samana range (modern-day Pakistan). The British succeeded in gaining control over the Khyber Pakhtunwa region, although they were prone to attacks from rebellious Pashtuns. Saragarhi served as a communication post between Fort Lockhart and Fort Gullistan which served as headquarters for the British Indian army in the North-Western region, as these two forts were not visible to each other despite being a few miles apart.

Khalsa Bahadur is an epic poem written by Chuhar Singh describing the chivalry and sacrifice of Sikh soldiers at the Battle of Saragarhi. The poem is 55 pages long in the Punjabi language.

In remembrance of these 21 warriors, the British built two Gurudwaras, one in Amritsar near the Golden Temple and another in Ferozpur Cantonment, which was in the district where these men hailed from.

Bollywood also paid tribute to the chivalry of these Sikh soldiers by releasing movie name Kesari.

Even today, 12th September is celebrated as the Saragarhi Day in honour of the sacrifices made by those 21 brave

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Assault & Battery Claims Explained

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Physical assaults happen in all kinds of situations. An attack at a sporting event, domestic violence, bar fights, and use of excessive force by a security guard or police officer are common examples. A victim of assault can suffer serious harm including concussion/brain injury, broken bones, permanent scarring, and lasting emotional trauma. If you have been the victim of assault and battery, you can bring a lawsuit against

the wrongdoer to get compensation for physical and psychological injuries you suffered.

Is Assault And Battery A Criminal Or Tort Claim?

Many people think of assault and battery as criminal offences. But they are also "torts" which give rise to civil claims for damages (i.e., a personal injury lawsuit). So, there can be both criminal and civil consequences for a wrongdoer. That been said, these two types of court proceedings are independent from each other. You can bring an assault and battery claim for personal injury damages even if the person who assaulted you is not charged or convicted of a crime in relation to the incident, and your personal injury lawsuit can succeed even if the wrongdoer is found innocent following a criminal trial.

What Are Assault And Battery

Claims In The Personal Injury Context?

The legal definition of assault is different in criminal and civil proceedings, which can cause some confusion. The tort of battery is what is commonly referred to as the crime of assault. "Assault" and "battery" are also distinguishable from each other in the personal injury context:

- "Assault" is the threat of immediate harm or unwanted physical contact. The tort of assault can occur without actual touching or physical harm to the victim. It is the creation of the reasonable apprehension of imminent harmful or offensive contact.

- "Battery" is actual, intentional physical contact inflicted by one person on another person. The tort of battery includes any unwanted (i.e., non-consensual) physical contact. Punching, kicking, stabbing, shooting,



pushing, and hitting with a stick or rock can give rise to a civil claim in battery. Because this tort includes any non-consensual contact, unwanted sexual contact and medical procedures performed without consent constitute battery. Common defences to the tort of battery include consent and self-defence.

When it comes to personal injury claims, assault can occur without battery, and battery can occur without an assault. But in the majority of cases, both assault and battery happen, usually in quick succession. If a battery has occurred, the assault tends to be less important in the context of an assault and battery claim since the quantum of damages for the assault will be relatively small.

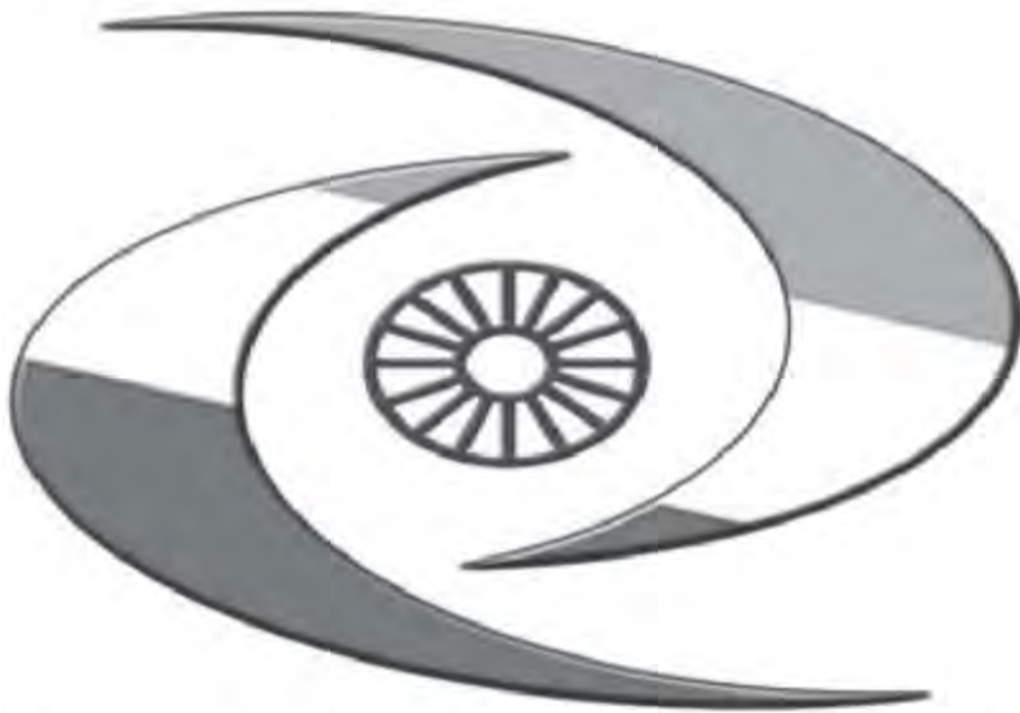

The team will continue to play at Langley Events Centre (LEC), where the Bandits played the 2022 season following three seasons in Abbotsford. Following its most successful season at the box office to date, the club is currently on sale with season ticket deposits for its 2023 campaign at LEC. "The CEBL is pleased to welcome Bryan Slusarchuk and Kevin Dhaliwal, two passionate supporters of the Fraser Valley Bandits since their inception, into our league as co-owners of the Bandits," said CEBL Commissioner and Co-Founder Mike Morreale. "Kevin and Bryan have long been strong supporters of basketball in British Columbia. They

share our vision for developing Canadian talent and for being community-based where everyone can engage in basketball as a player, coach, fan, or community or business partner. With the CEBL's Championship Weekend scheduled to be held at Langley Events Centre in August of 2023, the future for the Bandits is tremendously exciting." The Bandits are the founding brand under the umbrella of Bandits Sports & Entertainment (BSE), which is an ownership group jointly led by Dhaliwal, Founder and President of Essence Properties, and Slusarchuk, Co-Founder of K92 Mining Inc. and Principal of SluzCap. Through their shared passion for sport, the two co-owners launched the partnership with a goal of supporting the community through year-round collaborations with partners in the entertainment and sports sectors. BSE is fuelled by Dhaliwal and Slusarchuk's involvement in lo-

cal sports as former high school athletes and today as community partners of various events, tournaments and more. The Bandits join Scarborough as the second league franchise operated by outside ownership and become the first of the original six founding members to be purchased by new owners. The CEBL was founded in 2018 as a single entity owned league with six franchises. Today, the CEBL has 10 franchises located in six provinces stretching from British Columbia to Newfoundland and Labrador. "Bryan and I are thrilled to align to create more opportunities to bring youth and families closer to a sport that has captured the hearts and minds of Canadians. The CEBL is uniting local communities through the power of basketball and we are committed to ensuring that families and friends feel connected and energized by the world-class experience of Bandits games," Dhaliwal

said. "Growing up in the Lower Mainland, I was fortunate to be coached by mentors who taught me the importance of teamwork and collaboration. We are keen to continue deepening our roots in the community and to inspire local youth by giving them an opportunity to be supported by and to be part of one of the best pro sports leagues in Canada." Along with the sale and purchase of the Bandits, the announcement also included unveiling new branding for the team, now known as the Vancouver Bandits. As part of their acquisition, Dhaliwal and Slusarchuk purchased territorial exclusivity for the rights to own and operate a CEBL franchise in Metro Vancouver and the Fraser Valley Regional District. Metro Vancouver consists of 21 municipalities and the Fraser Valley is home to six. After moving to Langley Events Centre, the Bandits saw an increased percentage of its fans hail from



Burnaby, Coquitlam, Richmond, Surrey and Vancouver. This in conjunction with the territorial acquisition informed the club's decision to incorporate "Vancouver" in its name as a means of better representing the broader scope of cities across the two regions that Bandits fans come from. Following the purchase of the Bandits, Vancouver Island and the Okanagan region will continue as strong prospects for potential CEBL expansion due to their corporate communities and notable basketball histories.

GoFundMe page created to raise money for Afghan youth who was victim of stabbing while delivering food in Chinatown

A young food delivery worker became victim of unprovoked and random stabbing in the city's Chinatown neighbourhood. Police informed that the victim was a 22-year-old newcomer to Canada who was working for a meal-delivery service and was locking his bike to a street pole in Chinatown around 6 p.m. on September 11, when he was approached from behind and attacked by someone he didn't

know. Dennis Amanand Prasad, 43, was arrested and charged Monday with aggravated assault. "The victim suffered a number of stab wounds, including injuries to his chest and throat," said Sergeant Steve Addison of the attack, which occurred near Gore Avenue and East Pender Street. "Despite grave injuries, he was able to call 9-1-1 for help, and several witnesses provided first aid until police arrived. His inju-

ries were life-threatening, but we now expect him to pull through." Vancouver Police are crediting a number of bystanders who not only came to the victim's aid, but also called 9-1-1 and provided police officers with key information that led to the quick arrest of the suspect, who was taken into custody in Crab Park shortly after the attack. "Public safety is a shared responsibility, and we always encourage people to call police immediately

if they see a crime in progress or a person in danger," adds Sergeant Addison. "We commend the bystanders who comforted the injured victim after the attack, and others who provided eyewitness information that led to the quick arrest of a violent offender." Vancouver Police have asked the courts to remand the 43-year-old suspect due to the violent nature of the offence. While the youth is recovering from his injuries, one of the by-

standers who provided first aid to the victim has now created a GoFundMe page. A student at Sprott Shaw College, the bystander addressed the victim as HH and stated that "I'm happy to say that he (H.H.) has been discharged and is recovering. Through staying in touch." The page mentions that the victim has 3 children and his food delivery job is everything to him. The bystander is appealing public to help the victim.

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Vandalism at Toronto's Swaminarayan Mandir strongly condemn

Toronto police is investigating after reports of India hatred graffiti on the gates of BAPS Shri Swaminarayan Mandir were filed.

This is not the first time a Hindu place of worship has been vandalized with hate graffiti. Few weeks ago, statue of Mahatma Gandhi was also vandalized in Vishnu Temple in Toronto.

Several videos surfaced on social media showing phrases like "Hindustan Murdabad," and "Khalistan" sprayed on the temple's gates.

In a statement, officials at the temple said, "We are shocked and saddened by the anti-India graffiti at the gates of the BAPS Shri Swaminarayan Mandir in Toronto, Canada by anti-social elements."

The temple management appealed for peace saying, "The BAPS temple in Toronto, like all temples of BAPS worldwide, is an abode of peace, harmony, equality, selfless service, and universal Hindu values."

Patrick Brown, Toronto's mayor also took to Twitter to express his disappointment. "Very disappointed to hear of the vandalism that occurred at the BAPS Swaminarayan Mandir in Toronto. This type of hate has no place in the GTA or Canada. Let's hope those criminals responsible are brought to justice quickly."

The Indian High Commission in Ottawa said, "We strongly condemn defacing of BAPS Swaminarayan Mandir Toronto with anti-India graffiti. Have requested Canadian authorities to investigate

the incident and take prompt action on perpetrators."

Canada's minister of Transport and MP for Mississauga Centre, said, "This kind of vandalism and intimidation directed towards the BAPS Swaminarayan Mandir in Toronto is

reprehensible. I hope the perpetrators are found quickly and brought to justice."

Expressing his disappointment Peel Region police chief Nishan Duraiappah, said, "I'm very saddened to hear of the vandalism that occurred at the BAPS Swaminarayan Mandir in Toronto. Hate has no place in our community. Places of worship should be a safe place for all. We have activated our reassurance protocol with our places of wor[ship] in the Peel

Region."

Infact Sikh organizations too joined hands to express their deep regret at the hate message. Ontario's Sikh and Gurdwara Council wrote, "We are shocked to learn about the graffiti found on walls of Shri Swaminarayan Mandir in Toronto, Canada. We, at OSGC strongly condemned such an act inflicted on the religious place of worship. we condemn any forces or elements who attempt to create divisions when there is none."

Punjab ex-CM Capt Amarinder Singh to join BJP

Former Punjab chief minister and Punjab Lok Congress chief Capt Amarinder Singh will join the BJP next week, a party spokesperson said.

Singh will also merge his newly formed party with the BJP.

Singh, 80, had floated the Punjab Lok Congress (PLC) last year after quitting the Congress following his unceremoni-

ous exit as chief minister. He will join the BJP in the presence of party president JP Nadda in New Delhi.

He had been holding meetings with Union Home Minister Amit Shah and JP Nadda. He had resigned from the Congress on November 2 last year, ending his over 40 years of association with the grand old party.

Blood chilling video of shooting of US Convenience store worker Paramvir Singh appears

Approximately 1:30 minutes security camera footage shows that in spite of cooperating with robber and giving him everything he asked, Singh was shot. An armed robbery suspect walked up behind a compliant convenience store clerk and shot him in the back of the head.

Chris Copeland, 26, of Moore Avenue, Tupelo, was formally charged with capital murder, in Tupelo Municipal Court. During his initial appearance, Judge Jay Weir ordered him held without bond. Tupelo Police detective Wes Kloac said the security video from inside the Chevron Food Mart at the corner of Cliff Gookin

Boulevard and South Thomas Street showed a man wearing distinctive clothing walking into the store around 9:30 a.m. on Sept. 11. Kloac said the suspect can be seen pulling a handgun out of his waistband and pointing it at clerk Parmvir Singh.

"The clerk is very gracious and even gave him a stack of money he didn't ask for," Kloac testified. "He opened the safe for him and gave him a bank bag."

The video shows the suspect ordering Singh to the floor. He complied, sitting on the floor. The suspect can then be seen jumping over the counter.

"(The suspect) then walked up behind Mr. Singh and, at point blank range, executed him," Kloac said.

According to the detective, the video shows the suspect standing over Singh's body to retrieve the spent shell casing. He then looked at the security camera, ripped out what he thought was the DVD recorder box and fled the store, the detective said.

Copeland, who said he has been living on the streets since last December, has prior felony convictions for burglary of an inhabited dwelling and two counts of burglary of an auto.

In calling for Copeland to be held without bond, Tupelo city prosecutor Richard Babb said the crime was "outrageous, cold and monstrously barbaric. He is surely a danger to the community."

Singh, 33, was carried to the North Mississippi Medical Center emergency room in grave condition. He was pronounced dead about six hours after he was shot.

Police did not pursue the vehicle, instead utilized Air 1 to track the vehicle from the sky.

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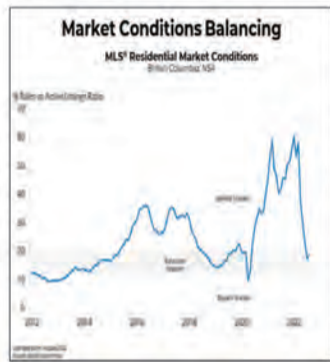


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BC Housing Market Showing Signs of Stabilizing Despite Decreased Activity



Vancouver, BC – September 13, 2022. The British Columbia Real Estate Association (BCREA) reports that a total of 5,645 residential unit sales were recorded by the Multiple Listing Service® (MLS®) in August 2022, a decrease of 40.8 per cent from August 2021. The average MLS® residential price in BC was \$918,378, a 2.1 per cent increase from \$899,428 recorded

in August 2021. Total sales dollar volume was \$5.2 billion, a 39.6 per cent decline from the same time last year.

“Housing activity across the province remains well below normal but is showing signs of stabilizing,” said BCREA Chief Economist Brendon Ogmundson. “While inventory is up over last year, active listings have somewhat stalled at relatively low lev-

els in most major markets and as a result we are seeing a healthier balance compared to last year.”

Year-to-date, BC residential sales dollar volume was down 22.1 per cent from the same period in 2021 to \$63.8 billion. Residential unit sales were down 30.5 per cent to 62,502 units, while the average MLS® residential price was up 12 per cent to \$1.02 million.

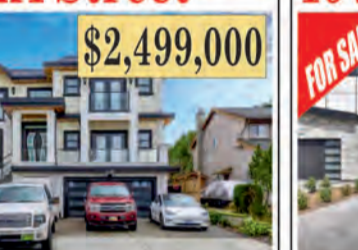

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The future of housing discussed at Union of BC Municipalities convention

WHISTLER: The 119th Union of British Columbia Municipalities (UBCM) Convention was held at the Whistler Conference Centre (WCC) and that ran from September 12-16. Delegates from 189 local governments and eight First Nations from around the province attended the week-long convention which included nearly 50 workshops, clinics, forums and plenary sessions. A session on continuing crisis in housing affordability was held to explore critical housing issues facing communities and point towards effective solutions. Local government leaders from across the province shared experiences in addressing housing shortages. Mayor Mike Hurley

of the City of Burnaby told delegates that supply alone will not solve everything and that it is "the wrong idea that everything wrong with housing is the fault of local governments." Hurley stated that local governments cannot control the housing market, but they can control zoning, OCPs, and how development approvals are granted to meet local demand - which local governments understand - to build strong communities. Hurley said supply must be added to increase affordability, but dismissed the idea that supply alone would solve the problem. "If supply alone is the answer, Metrotown would have the cheapest supply in Canada," he said.

Councillor Craig Hodge of the City of Coquitlam built upon Mayor Hurley's comments by providing delegates with an overview of how Coquitlam has actively chosen to become a leader in planning and development with an open and consultative planning process. Hodge reaffirmed the principle that "growth should pay for growth," in order to pay for the infrastructure necessary to support greater density.

Summerland's Mayor Toni Boot and Mayor Ed Mayne from the City of Parksville both touched on how housing shortages in their communities have impacted their economies, and sparked reviews of their respective development and permitting processes. Boot proposed updating co-op legislation to make it easier for such housing options to become established.

After the local government representatives offered the case studies of their experiences, delegates heard from panels including representatives from the Independent Contractors and Businesses Association, the Greater Victoria Housing Society, as well as the Aboriginal Housing Management Association.

Marc Lee, Senior Economist for the Canadian Centre for Policy Alternatives, told delegates that success in creating greater affordability "will require lots of new rental housing, and in particular non-market housing."

The 'NBC' sketch series is reportedly banning the actor permanently following the Oscars slap, reports [aceshowbiz.com](#).

According to Radar Online, the 'King Richard' star will never be invited back to 'SNL' after what he did to Chris Rock at the March event. The comedian is a former important part of the show, having starred in it from 1990 to 1993.

"Smith will never ever be invited back to 'SNL' after what he did to Chris," a source told the site. "The show is a temple comedian, and no one wants him around anymore."

"Forget hosting, Will won't even be able to get a ticket to sit in the audience anymore. He's not welcome."

The show's producers are allegedly also worried that if Smith comes to the show again, other big celebrities will refuse to join in the future.

"If Will Smith was invited back, 'SNL' would never get another big celebrity ever again," the source explains.

"Stars would rightly boycott the show if he was welcomed inside Studio 8H."

Will slapped Chris at the 2022 Academy Awards in March over the latter's joke about Jada Pinkett Smith's shaved head. He then shouted at the comedian, who was presenting onstage, twice to "keep my wife's name out of your f**king

mouth!"

Will has apologised several times for his behaviour at the live event.

In a video posted in July, the actor said, "It's all fuzzy. I will say to you, Chris, I apologize to you. My behaviour was unacceptable and I'm here whenever you're ready to talk. I hate when I let people down. So it hurts, it hurts me psycholog-



ically and emotionally to know I didn't live up to people's image and impression of me."

"And the work I'm trying to do is, I am deeply remorseful and I'm trying to be remorseful without being ashamed of myself," he added. "I'm human and I made a mistake, and I'm trying not to think of myself as a piece of s**t."

However, Rock seemingly didn't accept the apology as he said earlier this month, "F**k your hostage video," during his stand-up show at London's O2 Arena. He went on calling out the Oscar-winning actor saying that Will had managed to do an impersonation of a "perfect man for 30 years" before showing he is "just as ugly as the rest of us."



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
