

Karnvir Garcha, Victim Of **Coquitlam Shooting, Was Subject Of Rare Public Safety Warning**

COQUITLAM, BC: A shooting in Coquitlam left 25-year-old Karnvir Singh Garcha dead on July 2, 2023. Garcha, along with one more person, was the subject of a public safety warning issued by Surrey RCMP in late December of 2022, due to his involvement in gang activity and the violence associated with it.

The police believed that anyone connected to or in proximity to him may be putting themselves at risk. Garcha was also informed about credible threats to his safety but according to police he had "shown little regard for public safety,"

On Sunday, July 2. Garcha died in a fatal shooting near Foster Avenue and North Road in Coquitlam at 9:20 p.m.

According to the police, frontline officers attended and located Garcha suffering from a gunshot wound. In spite of life-saving measures, Garcha succumbed to his injuries. The Integrated Homicide Investigation Team (IHIT) took conduct of the incident and identified the victim as Karnvir Singh Garcha "in hopes of advancing its investigation."

IHIT identified a suspect vehicle, described as a white Kia Niro, arriving in the area at 8:31 p.m.

The investigators learned that Garcha was dropped off at the scene minutes before the homicide.

"We are looking to speak with anyone who had contact with Mr. Garcha in the days leading up to the shooting, including the driver of the vehicle that dropped him off," said Sergeant Timothy Pierotti

A suspect vehicle has now been identified. On June 5, 2023, at 9:52 p.m. the Port Moody Police Department (PMPD) were notified of a vehicle fire in a parking lot located in the 3000-block of Murray Street.



Visit The Incredible Story Of Historic Paldi Town Through New Museum And Books



VFS Global Plans To Expand In Canada To Manage Increasing Visa And Passport Demands

The vital part of traveling to a different L country is having the right travel document in the form of a passport or visa. The thought of waiting in long lines, traveling to a far location for an appointment, or arranging tedious documentation, hits a stress button in a lot of travelers. With summer travel picking up after the pandemic, the application process might appear a monstrous task.

But Amit Kumar Sharma, head of VFS Global America operation, believes it is easier than it appears. He says planning ahead and adhering to the document checklist can make the visa or passport application process simple and smooth.

Three Vehicles Involved In A Shooting Spree In Surrey

Surrey RCMP informed about a shooting between up to three vehicles in Surrey that left an 18-year-old man with non-life-threatening injuries.

The prolice reponded to shooting that occurred in the parking area of Fleetwood Park at 5:50 p.m. on July 5, 2023, and are appealing for public assistance in locating one of the suspect vehicles believed to be involved.

Surrey Detachment Frontline officers with assistance from the Surrey Gang Enforcement Team, (SGET), Surrey Drug Enforcement Team and the Lower Mainland Integrated Police Dog Services (PDS), responded to a report of shots fired between up to three vehicles that had fled the Fleetwood Park area of 158 Street and 80 Avenue upon police attendance.

Officers located one of the suspect vehicles with four occupants inside, a black Nissan Altima, at Fraser Highway and 148 Street. Three of the occupants were detained, and the fourth, an 18-year-old man, was transported to hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

As the investigation unfolded, officers tracked down a second suspect vehicle, a white Tesla and a 16-year-old male was detained. The investigation is continuing and no charges have currently been laid. Investigators continue to search for a third suspect vehicle believed to be involved in the incident, a black Honda Civic that was seen fleeing the Fleetwood Park area at the time of the shooting.

The investigation is being led by the Surrey RCMP General Investigation Unit (GIU) with assistance from the Surrey RCMP Forensic Identification Section (FIS). The individuals involved in this incident are believed to be known to each other and are linked to drug activity.

"This shooting between vehicles occurred early on a summer evening right near a busy park in our community," stated Surrey RCMP Media Relations Officer, Sergeant Tammy Lobb. "Those involved in this type of violence show a complete disregard for others, and our investigators are working hard to piece together the events that unfolded on our streets through a thorough review of all the evidence."


Charges in relation to this investigation have now been sworn. 31-year-old Tarndeep Uppal, of North Delta, has been charged with:



Newly Expanded Climate Action Tax Credit Coming Soon

7ICTORIA - More than two million individuals and families will see the first quarterly payment of the newly expanded and enhanced climate action tax credit in their bank accounts this week.

"As global inflation continues to impact the costs of everyday life, we're making sure more people will receive more money to help with their bills," said Katrine Conroy, Minister of Finance. "B.C.'s price on carbon pollution continues to be one of the strongest and most comprehensive in Canada. Boosting the climate action tax credit is just one of the ways we are putting money in people's pockets as we work toward a low-carbon future."

A single person can now receive as much as \$447 per year, an increase of more than \$250 from 2022, or more than double what they received last year. A family of four can now receive as much as \$893.50, which is \$390 more than last year.

The increases to the income threshold mean individuals with a net income below \$61,465 will receive a full or partial credit. A single parent with two children with a net income below \$89,270 will receive a full or partial credit. The increased thresholds mean more people will be eligible for the money this year. An estimated 70% of individuals eligible can expect the maximum amounts.

The credit was created to help offset costs for people and families with low and middle incomes, while ensuring B.C.'s carbon tax can continue to help



pay for programs, services and infrastructure throughout the province. The income ceiling for the credit will increase annually, with a goal to reach 80% of households in B.C. by 2030.

B.C.'s climate action tax credit is paid through Canada Revenue Agency, along with the federal GST/HST credit, and can take as long as 10 days to be delivered. Despite being a payment from the province, it will appear on bank statements as a payment from the Government of Canada.

The carbon tax will increase every year until it reaches \$170 per tonne in 2030, as required by the federal gov-

Street Racing Leads To Multiple Vehicle Impoundments In Surrey

Six vehicles were impounded by Surrey RCMP Traffic Unit during enforcement in Campbell Heights, an area known for street racing and stunting.

On May 12, 2023, during a large gathering in the 2700-block of 192 Street, a 1937 Chevrolet was stunting when the driver lost control and collided with a Semi-truck. The collision was captured on video and widely shared on social media. Fortunately, the driver was not seriously injured. The Surrey RCMP Traffic Unit investigated the collision and have submitted a report to BC Prosecution Service recommending criminal charges against the driver.

On June 16, 2023, Surrey RCMP Traffic Unit conducted proactive enforcement in the same area along 192 Street, as it is a known location where people gather to street race.

In total, 21 violation tickets were served for speed, excessive speed, vehicle defects and



other traffic infractions. Five of the tickets were for excessive speed which is accompanied by an automatic 7-day vehicle impoundment. One driver was found to be under the influence and received a 3-day Immediate Roadside Prohibition with vehicle impoundment.

The Motor Vehicle Act defines excessive speeding as driving at a speed greater than 40 km an hour over the speed limit.

We want to make it clear that Surrey RCMP has zero tolerance for street racing and/or dangerous driving behaviours that places members of our community at risk, says, Surrey RCMP Traffic Unit Sergeant Jason Barrett. Individuals who participate in these activities pose risks to everyone on the road, as well as all the spectators who attend. We will continue to target the drivers and encourage you to do your part by not attending these events, and reporting dangerous driving behaviour to police.

To date in 2023, fourteen lives have been taken tragically in motor vehicle collisions in Surrey. Dangerous driving behaviours and in particular, speed, have been contributing factors in the majority of these fatal collisions.

Charges Declined in Election Case Involving New West School Board Trustee Gurveen Dhaliwal

ecutor has declined to approve a charge against Gurveen Dhaliwal, a New Westminster School Board Trustee.

Dhaliwal was being investigated for possibly breaking election rules by being present at a voting place as a scrutineer, which the Local Government Act prohibits, as candidates are only allowed at polling stations to vote on election day.

The allegation is that, after casting her ballot, Ms. Dhaliwal remained at the voting place for approximately 20 minutes acting as a scrutineer for another candidate from the same electoral organization. A scrutineer is appointed to represent a candidate at a voting place according to the terms of the LGA. The scrutineer observes the conduct of the voting and counting proceedings at the voting station to ensure it is operating fairly.

John M. Gordon KC was appointed as the Special Prosecutor in relation to the investigation of Dhaliwal's case.

According to a media statement by BC

MANCOUVER, BC: A Special Pros- Prosecution Service (BCPS), the Special Prosecutor concluded that the public interest does not require a prosecution in this case. The Special Prosecutor identified a number of public interest factors set out in the charge assessment policy that weighed against a prosecution. These included that the offence was committed as a result of a genuine mistake or misunderstanding of fact. The loss or harm was the result of a single incident and was minor in nature. "Ms. Dhaliwal did not serve as a scrutineer at the community centre for long. CCTV from the community centre showed Ms. Dhaliwal arriving at 12:19 p.m. and departing at 12:39 p.m. Nothing remarkable occurred while Ms. Dhaliwal was present as a scrutineer. It was estimated that a small number of voters, perhaps a half-dozen, used the ballot box at which Ms. Dhaliwal was scrutineering over this period of time," mentioned the media statement.

In all the circumstances the Special Prosecutor concluded that the public interest did not require the prosecution of Ms. Dhaliwal for an offence under the LGA and accordingly no charge was approved. Joven Narwal of Narwal Litigation LLP, issued a statement on behalg of Dhaliwal. Narwal said, "We are pleased to announce that the independent Special Prosecutor has decided not to approve criminal charges against our client, Gurveen Dhaliwal, following a comprehensive investigation in which our client fully cooperated. The independent nature of the charge assessment serves as a testament to the integrity of our legal system which strives to ensure fairness and impartiality. We would like to extend our client's appreciation for unwavering support and encouragement from friends, family and members of the community who maintained their belief in her integ-

Vindicated by this decision, our client looks forward to continuing to serve New Westminster as well as the province of British Columbia and will not be grant-



ing any interviews or providing additional statements at this time."

Karnvir Garcha, victim of Coquitlam shooting, was subject of rare public...

The vehicle was identified as a white Kia Niro. IHIT is now working with PMPD to forensically process the scene.

Through extensive video canvass, IHIT identified a suspect vehicle, described as a white Kia Niro, arriving in the area at 8:31 p.m. The Kia Niro parked in a loading area at the top of the ramp leading to the underground parkade of 525 Foster Avenue, with its fog lights on, until 9:19 p.m. when Garcha was dropped off at the scene by a ride sharing company. Following the shooting, the suspect returned to the Kia Niro and fled the scene eastbound in the Alley toward Emerson Street.

"We are releasing this photo and video, in hopes that someone will remember seeing this vehicle parked in the loading area," said Sergeant Timothy Pierotti of IHIT. "If you were in the 500-block of Foster Avenue on July 2 or in the 3000-block of Murray Street on July 5 and observed this vehicle and you have yet to speak with police, please contact IHIT immediately.'

Surrey RCMP in partnership with the Combined Forces Special Enforcement Unit of British Columbia (CFSEU-BC) issued a

lic safety posed by Garcha and 22-years-old Harkirat Jhutty of Surrey because of the involvement in gang activity and the violence associated with it.

Due to a significant threat to the public posed by these individuals through their connection to criminal activity and high levels of violence, police believe that anyone connected to or in proximity to them may be putting themselves at risk, the police said.

"The individuals identified have been informed by police of credible threats to their safety, but the threat doesn't just place them at risk, it poses a risk to anyone who associates with them or anyone who is in proximity to them," said Surrey RCMP's Major Crime Team Lead, Inspector Bal Hansra in December. "Due to their association with gang activity, the drug trade, and violent acts such as shootings, these individuals have put themselves, their families, and the community at risk."

"Despite the threats to their lives and the safety of others around them, these individuals have shown little regard for public safety in our communities," said S/Sgt Lindsay Houghton of CF-SEU-BC at that time.

North Surrey Secondary Student Wins \$120,000 Schulich Leader Scholarship


ohammad Awwad of North Surrey Secondary is one of this year's recipients of the Schulich Leader Scholarships, a highly coveted six-figure scholarship for students who demonstrate a passion for science, technology, engineering and math (STEM).

The Grade 12 student is among only 100 students from across the country selected for a scholarship from Schulich Leaders, receiving \$120,000 to pursue engineering in university. More than 300,000 students applied and 1,500 were nominated, with Awwad being a very fitting recipient for his lifelong interest in STEM.

"I love STEM, I'm involved in all sorts of extracurricular STEM activities," he said. "I'm on the school robotics team, I compete in online hackathons - I love programming, so it seemed like the perfect scholarship where I could tick off all the boxes that they wanted.

"I'd say my interest started in elementary school with the weekly ADST classes where we'd bring in small robots and we'd program them. I always found those really fun to work with, and as I got into high school, things got more serious with clubs to join and more things to do.'

Half of the Schulich Leader scholarships are valued at \$120,000 to study engineering and the other half are valued at \$100,000 to study science and math. Aw-



wad jumped on the application process early, spending three weeks revising his write-up before submitting it to his school to seek the nomination.

In his essay, he wrote about being the lead programmer and team captain of North Surrey's robotics team, his third-place finish in an Amazon-hosted hackathon and his mentorship work in the community to pass down programming knowledge to the next generation.

"They really targeted their questions about your accomplishments and what you've done in STEM, your top goals, what makes you stand out most," said Awwad. "I mentioned that I helped start a STEM outreach club where we go to a local elementary school and give students an opportunity to explore STEM with weekly projects. I also led a Surrey library STEM workshop and taught students how to start programming from scratch.'

After several months, Awwad received an email informing him of his scholarship win - but initially, seeing wasn't believing. "At first, I didn't think it was real, I thought surely this is one of those advertisements with the fake name at the title of the email." he recalled. "But then it had the red exclamation mark and I was like. 'This is labelled important, I have to open

"I opened it right away and my jaw dropped. My parents were around me and they saw me in shock - I showed them the phone and they read the email, I couldn't even tell them."

Awwad will attend the University of Victoria in the fall, where he plans to study software engineering and pursue a career in the tech industry, either with startups or big companies, before forging his own

"I really want to diversify my skills and hopefully eventually start my own company," he said. "I'm not sure what type of company. I'm identifying problems that I'm noticing through this whole journey and I want to solve one of those problems - I'm not sure how or when yet, but one

Anyone can join it who has attained the age of 65. Any topic under the sun, without hurting anybody's personal sentiments is the area of discussion every Thursday from 12.00 noon to 2.30 p.m.

Members of the society include farmers, teachers, preachers, businessmen, civil servants, ex-servicemen, lawyers, bankers doctors, and even a retired diplomat. The members of its Executive Committee are elected unanimously every two-year. Its General Body meeting was held on June 22, 2023. The income and expenditure statements were passed en masse.

It has proved to be a useful platform for politicians of different hues at city, provincial and federal levels. In the recent past,



A19-year old man was victim of an early morning altercation at a Burnaby residence.

Low Supply Continues To Impact Home Pricing In The Fraser Valley: Sales Increasing Despite Rate Hikes

SURREY: The Fraser Valley real estate market saw strong sales activity in June with levels on par with the 10-year average for the month, amid on-going challenges with supply. In June, the Fraser Valley Real Estate Board (FVREB) processed 1,935 sales on its Multiple Listing Service (MLS), an increase of 51.1 per cent compared to June 2022 and a 13.1 per cent increase compared to May.

"As seen in recent months, prices continue to trend upward, with lack of supply and high demand for housing," said Narinder Bains, Chair of the Fraser Valley Real Estate Board.

"What we're seeing is sales increasing, with buyers entering the market despite current financial implications of anticipated rate

The Board received 3,424 new listings in June, an increase of 2.8 per cent compared to last year, and a decrease of 3.1 per cent compared to May 2023. The month ended with a total active inventory of 5,944, a 6.9 per cent increase compared to May, and 8.2 per cent less than June of last year.

"A number of factors are at play in the Fraser Valley market, from low supply to unprecedented interest rates - the highest in more than 20 years," said Board CEO, Baldev Gill. "For those seeking to enter the market, whether buying or selling, only a professional REALTOR® can provide the expert guidance and advice to fully evaluate each clients' needs, and to protect their interests."

Across Fraser Valley in June, the average number of days to sell a single-family detached home was 21 and a townhome was 16 days. Apartments took, on average, 22 days to sell. MLS HPI Benchmark Price Activity Single Family Detached: At \$1,526,200, the

Benchmark price for an FVREB single-family detached home increased 2.3 per cent compared to May 2023 and decreased 7.4 per cent compared to June 2022.

Apartments: At \$552,200, the Benchmark price for an FVREB apartment/condo increased 1.8 per cent compared to May 2023 and decreased 2.5 per cent compared to June



Punjab-Origin Girl 'Buried Alive' By Ex-Boyfriend In Australia In 'Act Of Revenge', Court Hears

In a horrific act of vengeance, La 21-year-old Indian nursing student in Australia was abducted by her jilted ex-boyfriend from India, driven nearly 650 km and buried alive in South Australia state's remote Flinders Ranges, a court has heard, PTI

Jasmeen Kaur from Adelaide City was killed by Tarikjot Singh in March 2021, a month after reporting him to the police for stalking.

According to media reports, Kaur was abducted from her workplace on March 5, 2021, and driven more than 400 miles

(644 km) while bound with cable ties in the boot of a car Singh had borrowed from his flatmate, news.com.au portal and other websites reported on.

He buried Kaur in a shallow grave after making "superficial" cuts to her throat which were not enough to kill her and she was aware of her surroundings when she died at some point on March

Singh pleaded guilty to the murder but the horrific details of his crime came to light during sentencing submissions at the Supreme Court this week.

Prosecutor Carmen Matteo said

the murder was "not efficient" and Kaur was "made to suffer".

"She had to have been consciously suffering what could only be described as the absolute terror of breathing in and swallowing soil and dying in that way," Matteo said.

Kaur's family, including her mother, was in the court to hear the sentencing submissions.

The court heard Singh planned the killing because he was unable to get over the breakdown of their relationship.

"The way in which Kaur was killed involved, really, an uncommon level of cruelty," Mat-



teo said.

his injuries. The woman driver fled the scene after the accident. She was later arrested and her vehicle was seized by the police. Media reports quoted the victim's wife, Indu Sekar, as saving that she was against the idea of moving to Canada but he convinced her by promising a better life.

When the shattered wife was brought to see the body of her husband, she broke down, saying: "This is what you came here

A family friend told the media,

"She didn't want to travel to Canada, he only convinced her to travel here to get a better life. And yesterday when she saw his body, she broke down, saying, 'I told you, we need not come here'. They came to this country with a lot of dreams, but everything is shattered now."

'GoFundMe' has been launched by the local community to raise money to fly the body back to India.

"My Friend Prakash has came to Canada just towards the end of 2022. He was living with his

wife and an 18 months old boy in Brampton. Unfortunately he has passed away by a fatal accident done by a impaired driving lady on 3rd July 2023 in Brampton. We have just begun this fund raising activity to support the family (his wife Indumathi and kid) and get his body transported to Tamilnadu, India. Even a penny from your pocket will help the family in some ways, atlast this is the least thing we could do to stand by his family during this tough times," wrote the fund or-

Surrey's Local Developers Invited To Donate Properties Slated For Development To Temporarily House Ukrainian Families

SURREY: Matt Ilich and his business partner Sasha Faris at First Track Investment are calling on fellow real estate developers to join a new program on housing.

The program is arranging short-term housing for Ukrainian families arriving in the Lower Mainland under the Canadian-Ukraine Authorization for Emergency Travel (CUAET) program by utilizing unoccupied houses sitting on properties awaiting redevelopment. The program gives them somewhere to live until they can find their feet

"Operation Welcome Home" - with the emphasis on "home" - began late last year in Vancouver and has expanded to Richmond, and now Surrey.

The program matches arriving families from Ukraine with local, vacated homes that developers have bought for eventual tear down. Thousands of homes are purchased and demolished annually for new development in the Lower Mainland. They often sit empty for months but remain in liveable condition until replacement developments are ready to start. Opening the doors short-term and letting these displaced families live in those homes temporarily is most often preferable to living in a hotel room for weeks on end after arriving.

To date, 13 families have been accommodated. The developers do not charge anything to provide the homes. "We're looking forward to expanding



this to Surrey and make use of some of the homes slated for removal," Ilich said. "Some of them aren't even that old, they're just waiting to be demolished in several months or a year to make way for new developments as Surrey grows. A lot of developers are in the same situation as us, with an inventory of homes just sitting empty that could help these people." "Operation Welcome Home" is operated with placement assistance and wraparound services from the social

erated with placement assistance and wraparound services from the social services agency S.U.C.C.E.S.S. (the United Chinese Community Enrichment Services Society) and rennie foundation, and Maple Hope Foundation, which helps families seeking refuge here from the conflict in Ukraine.

"We're excited to be among the first to provide families with a temporary home in Surrey. Having a proper 'landing pad' with a solid local address puts them in a better position to find work and get their new lives in order," says Nathan Hildebrand,

vice president of Qualico which is planning to offer some vacant properties in south Surrey for "Operation Welcome Home". "With the stress of escaping the war and moving to a strange new land, a home environment helps them cope better than being in a hotel. We're able to provide a perfectly liveable place for a few weeks or months, until they ultimately decide to stay in the Lower Mainland or move elsewhere in Canada." "With leadership from S.U.C.C.E.S.S. we are now able to provide housing as part of a continuum of services that ensure those arriving are given what they need to establish themselves here," said Queenie Choo, CEO of S.U.C.C.E.S.S. and S.U.C.C.E.S.S. Foundation.

"This may include finding employment, integrating children into schools and the community and eventually helping to secure more permanent housing."

KPU Receives Funding To Support Internationally-Educated Nurses

SURREY: A Kwantlen Polytechnic University (KPU) course that assists internationally-educated nurses to access health care jobs in Canada is receiving new support from the B.C. government.

The Ministry of Post-Secondary Education and Future Skills is providing \$183,911 to KPU, allowing the university to offer three sections of the course Introduction to Professional Communication for Internationally Educated Nurses (IPCIEN).

IPCIEN is designed to assist internationally-educated nurses improve communication for entry into professional practice, expand health and idiomatic vocabulary, and increase understanding of culturally expected behaviours of the Canadian health care system.

Aimee Begalka, dean of KPU's Faculty of Academic and Career Preparation, says the tuition-free course is a great option for students new to the country who are ready to grow their careers to support their families and contribute to their communities.

"There is a real demand

for nurses in B.C. We have many trained professionals coming from other countries who have skills and knowledge, but face challenges joining the workforce. This is a course that meets their needs by providing language training and hands-on experience, while educating students about the expectations of the workplace in Canada." The IPCIEN course is funded by the B.C. government's Adult Basic Education and English Language Learning Pathways program, which is providing \$3.8 million to public post-secondary institutions for programs allow ing students to acquire new or upgraded skills or knowledge in English, math, and science.

KPU's first IPCIEN course of 2023 runs Sept. 26 to Dec. 7 at KPU Surrey. Students must be permanent residents (five years or less), living in B.C., and have an occupational certification as a registered nurse (RN), Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN), or Registered Psychiatric Nurse (RPN) from their source country.

Online information sessions are scheduled for July 26 and Aug. 24.

Volunteer Cancer Drivers Society Campaign Succeeds In Attracting "100 New Drivers Region-Wide In 100 Days"

Jing its "100 drivers in 100 days" recruitment campaign in late March, the Volunteer Cancer Drivers Society is pleased to announce it has attracted enough new driver candidates to push them over the goal line.

"We're still processing applications, but as of July 4th, day 100, we have 38 new drivers now in operation serving cancer patients, another 23 who are finishing training and will soon be ready to start, and 48 applicants who will hopefully be ready to join us shortly,"

CURREY: After announc- says Bob Smith, president of VCDS. "That's potentially 109 new drivers, but we're not stopping there. Finding new drivers has been an ongoing undertaking since the day we started. We're constantly looking for more drivers, especially in the City of Vancouver, to meet the growing need for patient rides."

VCDS forecasts it will receive over 29,000 ride requests this year. Having enough drivers to meet that number prompted the society to set the lofty goal this spring of attracting 100 new

drivers in just a matter of weeks.

At the start of the campaign, VCDS had about 370 member drivers who use their own vehicles and volunteer whatever time they can spare. Many cancer patients can't get to their appointments on their own due to any number of factors including age, medical condition, having no family members nearby or an inability to drive themselves.

"We continue to welcome all drivers interested, but we especially need drivers in the City of Vancouver," Smith adds. "Only a fifth of our drivers live there, but the larger clinics in Vancouver like the Vancouver Cancer outpatient centre and nearby VGH Blackmore Pavilion account for almost half the rides VCDS provides. All the patients we serve appreciate the personal attention they get, and most of our drivers will tell you they get as much out of the experience as the people they're driving. It's truly rewarding."


