Eligible employers can expect a simplified application process for future LMIA applications for positions on the COPS list.



#### Pressure Builds On **CEBA Loan Deadline** berals

PENTICTON, BC: Political parties, small businesses, and many Canadian Chambers of Commerce are calling on the federal government to extend the deadline for the Canada Emergency Business Account (CEBA) loan.

Only five months are left until the CEBA repayment deadline on Dec. 31, 2023. If the CEBA loan is not repaid by then, small business owners will lose the up to \$20,000 forgivable portion and pay the entire amount at a 5% interest rate.

In a letter sent by over 250 Canadian chambers of commerce, they noted that 49 per cent of businesses are still making below-normal revenues and 50 per cent of Canadian food services are currently operating at a loss or breaking even, compared to 12 per cent pre-pandemic.

The joint letter was sent to Deputy Prime Minister Chrystia Freeland calling for more time to repay CEBA loans while keeping the forgivable portion.

The letter mentions that almost 900,000 CEBA loans were approved across Canada. Many businesses had no choice but to take on this loan due to circumstances beyond their control. This includes businesses in some of the hardest-hit industries such as the retail industry and tourism sector.

Mandatory business closures and oth-

er government health restrictions left businesses with severe income losses and cash flow issues. Despite their best efforts, high-interest rates, inflation and increased labour costs are making it difficult for small-and-medium size businesses to keep their heads above water, let alone make any dent in the debt many had to take on to survive pandemic restrictions.

A recent analysis of over 15,000 Canadian businesses found that inflation, input costs, and interest/debt costs are the three most acute obstacles faced by business (at 56%, 40% and 38%, respectively), and the smaller the firm, the more constrained they are by debt, the letter mentions.

Corinne Pohlmann, Executive Vice-President at CFIB said, "We're not asking for total loan forgiveness-just more time. If businesses are forced to close because of their pandemic debt, government will not be able to recoup that money. It's a winwin situation if businesses are allowed more time to repay."

"The pressure is growing for the Liberals to act and help small businesses get through these tough times," said NDP critic for small business and tourism, MP Richard Cannings (South Okanagan-West Kootenay). Continued on page 12



in Gurdwara Sahib. Three villages were attached to the Gurdwara as its property; Paibhug, Mattan and Mace Gaam. The three villages later were annexed by the Dogra rulers During the reign of Maharaja Partap Singh Dogra these Gurdwaras were removed .On the ruined platform around the spring pond Maharaja Hari Singh Dogra constructed a temple in 1944 AD. According to the Census Report of 1943 by R. C. Ratard, "There

is evidence to show that there were Sikhs in the country (J & K) as early as the 16th century. The Gurdawara at Mattan commemorates his (Guru Nanak's) visit."

According to eyewitness Sewa Ram Singh District and Session Judge Rawalpindi, "The remnants of a Platform in the center of the lower tank of the Twin Springs at Matten indicate the spot where the Master had sat,

while some ruins of the pillars of the causeway leading up to the platform from the left side of the Spring are also visible. In 1908, when the present writer first visited Kashmir, he saw one of the seven Gurdwaras, which had been built on three sides of the twin Springs, still standing and he read a sermon from the Granth Sahib to the assembled audience in that Gurdwara, That Gurdwara, however, has also gone in ruins, and a new one seems to have recently been constructed, not on that after but along the south-western corner of the lower Spring. It is difficult to say who is responsible for this act of vandalism." (The Divine Master, 1989, P 144) According to Dr GMD Suf, "The Gurdwara of Mattan,

Baramulla and outside Kathi Darwaza, Srinagar were built by Nalwa (Kashir)

The family is being supported by RCMP Victim Services and arrangements are being made to assist them in returning to Alberta. Penticton RCMP frontline officers have taken lead on the investigation with the assistance of RCMP West Coast Marine Services. No criminality is suspected and alcohol is not believed to be a factor in this tragic incident.

#### **Surrey Resident Jose Kaze Identified As Granville Street Homicide Victim**

V ancouver - vancouver ronce have identified the man who was killed in a homicide on August 4 on Granville Street, and are renewing appeals for anyone with information to contact police.

"We are still working to determine what the motive was for this murder." says Constable Tania Visintin. "Granville Street has a lot of vehicle, bike, and pedestrian traffic at all hours of the day. We believe there may be witnesses or people with video who have important information mat could help us solve uns crime."

Jose Kaze, a 32-year-old Surrey resident, was stabbed near Granville and Smithe streets just before 3:30 a.m. on August 4. He was taken to hospital, but succumbed to his injuries. No arrests have been made and VPD's Homicide detectives continue to investigate.

#### 'Unexpected' Visa Approvals From Canada Pushes One Ontario College To **Cancel Admissions Of Many International Students**

College that their admission offers for this coming school year have been revoked.

According to a CBC news article, "some 500 international students recently received an email informing them that their admission offers for this coming school year had been revoked, according to Northern College. Some were already in Canada when they were informed their offers had been withdrawn."

The email from the college was shared by a student in Punjab to CBC. The email states, "Due to overwhelming demand and higher than anticipated visa approval rates, we must take the unfortunate step of withdrawing and refunding your offer of admission to the Fall 2023 intake of Northern College at Pures College. Your full refund will be processed immediately."In a statement to CBC Toronto, Northern College said the problem was caused by Canada approving more visas for international students than expected.

David Francis, director of strategic initiatives for Northern College, said it's the

Hundreds of international students have responsibility of Northern College to es-timate how many visas will be approved ahead of each semester. That means the school gives out more acceptance letters than it can accommodate under the assumption that some of the applicants will have their visas denied.

> "As we look at program capacities, they are moving targets," Francis said.

> Additionally, Francis said many students apply to multiple schools. As part of its estimations ahead of each semester. Northern College assumes some of the students they accepted will choose to enrol in different institutions, CBC reported.

> The isn't the first time international students have been left in limbo by a Toronto school. Last May, hundreds of students said their enrolment was unilaterally suspended by Alpha College of Business and Technology, an affiliate of St. Lawrence College.

> Tejinder Singh Sidhu, President, of World Sikh Organization of Canada has written a letter to President of Northern College. The letter states, "It has come to our atten-

> tion that hundreds of international students

have been informed by your college that their admission has been withdrawn for the September semester. As a result, these students, including a large number of Sikh students from Punjab have had their lives thrown into chaos.'

For students living in India, a withdrawal of admission means students can no longer legally enter Canada, as their student visas have been issued on the basis of their admission to your college. Students in India end up also losing thousands of dollars in airfare. Many families have had to sell property or take out large loans to pay for all the costs associated with attending school abroad. The withdrawal of admission results in the risk of losing the validity of required certifications, such as medical examinations and IELTS, as these documents also carry an expiry date, WSO president said.


'We understand that students who are currently in Canada have been told that their courses will be delivered online. This is of course less than optimal, given that students pay for the experience of in-person learning and online alternatives are not



equivalent.

The impact of Northern College issuing and then withdrawing admission is nothing short of catastrophic for the impacted students. The options currently being offered by the college to address the situation are inadequate. We understand that students are being offered courses that are not PGWP-eligible. This will not be acceptable to the vast majority of students. Students in such desperate circumstances are also vulnerable to exploitation by predatory private colleges and agents.

We are writing to ask that Northern College recognize the impact on affected international students and find a way to accommodate these students without cancelling their admission. The decisions made by the College have weighed heavily on the mental, physical, and financial health of the students.

ESDC during the pilot due to simplified LMIA forms that enable employers to hire additional Temporary Foreign Workers for genuine job offers during REP.

REP is a three-year initiative that aims to address labour shortages and reduce the administrative burden for repeat employers participating in the program who demonstrate a history of complying with program requirements.

"The Recognized Employer Pilot will cut red tape for eligible employers-those who demonstrate the highest level of protection for workers-and make it easier for them to access the labour they need to fill jobs that are essential to Canada's economy and food security," Boissonnault said while announcing the program at Mirch Masala restaurant located in Delta, BC.

Alongside a commitment of \$29.3 million over three years, REP was first announced in Budget 2022 as the "trusted employer model.

A Job Bank designation that shows their recognized status to improve interest from

This will help employers better plan for their staffing needs and reduce the number of different LMIAs they need to submit over three years. Recognized employers will also benefit from a Job Bank designation that shows their recognized status to prospective workers.

Most employers need a Labour Market Impact Assessment (LMIA) before they can submit a work permit application to hire a temporary foreign worker. An LMIA confirms that there is a need for a temporary foreign worker and that no Canadians or permanent residents are available to do the job. It also ensures that the employer's job offer is legitimate, and that the employer has complied with Program requirements to protect workers.

To participate in REP, employers must have a minimum of three positive LMIAs for the same occupation over the past five years from a list of occupations that have been designated as in-shortage based on Canadian Occupational Projection Sys-

tem data. These employers will be subject to a more rigorous upfront assessment process based on their history and track record with the program, ensuring that REP targets employers with the best recruitment practices.


REP will be rolled out in two stages. Stage

one begins in September 2023, when employers in the Primary Agriculture stream will be able to apply in time for the 2024 season. Stage two begins in January 2024 and opens intake to all other industry sectors.

Applications for both streams will be accepted until September 2024.

Employers who are expected to meet REP eligibility criteria will

be proactively invited to apply using a dual-purpose LMIA application which differs from the regular LMIA. Employers can request that the application be used to apply for recognized status under REP and for the LMIA at the same time.

get credentialled to pursue his desired career as a pharmacist and needed financial assistance to support his family.

A Canadian friend helped him secure employment as a tile layer, which allowed him to learn about the construction industry. 





# US Mayor Comes In Support Of Sikh Owner Of 7-Eleven Store Who Beat Up Robber

Avideo of the robber being knocked to the ground by a Sikh owner of a 7-Eleven store in California went viral online.

The clip showed the robber walking behind the billing counter and grabbing tobacco products — including cigarettes, cigars and vapes.

He then tossed them into a waste bin. "Just let him go. There ain't nothing you can do. They're not going to do nothing," the bystander who took the video can be heard saying.

Stockton police started investigating the assault of a 7-Eleven robbery suspect. The police later identified the suspect and arrested him later. He was also found to be connected to other robberies in the area, according to the Stockton Police Department.

While the Sikh owner and his employee came under attack by many social media users for the assault of the robber,



Stockton Mayor Kevin Lincoln took to social media share District Attorney's

statement that the 7/11 store clerks seen attacking a suspected shoplifter "are not

and never have been suspects."

Lincoln wrote, "The events surrounding the viral video from 7-11 on Centre St are under active investigation by Stockton PD. Once completed, SPD will forward the case to San Joaquin Country District Attorney's Office."

He further added, "In a statement released by the District's Attorney's Office, DA Freitas expressed that "the store clerks are not and have never been suspects" of the DA's office and "Any investigation going forward is to hold accountable the individual who threatened and attempted to rob the store clerks."

At the end of the post, Lincoln states that Proposition 47, which changed certain theft offenses from felonies to misdemeanors, has only increased the frequency of shoplifting and decreased law enforcement's "ability to hold accountable those responsible for such acts."



### The legend of Kashmir...

The Sikh Granthis of this place have been given Pattas of Gurdwara Nanaksar by Maharaja Ranjit Singh which was also taken away by Bhai Kanhiya Singh Baramulla on the instructions of Dogra rulers. During Sikh rule, there were 84 rooms associated with these Gurdwaras. When Sikh historian Sewa Ram Singh first visited Mattan Sahib in 1908 AD. At this place, he saw only one Gurdwara. Nowadays only one Gurdwara is seen on the right side of the spring, near Surva Mandir. Although this Gurdwara is constructed later on, away from the spring. Deodar and kail wood is utilized in their construction. On the right side, near Surya Mandir, Kesri Nishan Sahib is hoisted, 35 feet high and 3 feet in circumference. Its basement is about 8 feet in square. A Khanda Chakra is also seen on its top. One of the copies of Guru Granth Sahib is about sixteen centuries old. Its first two pages are believed to be written with Gold ink, by S. Hari Singh Nalwa.

On one side of the Gurdwara, a board is placed on which the following Urdu couplet is written as mentioned by Kashir En-





cyclopaedia. "Gurdwara Pehli Patshahi Nanaksar Matan Sahib Kashmir Yahan Guru Ji Brahm Das Pandit Se Gosht Ki."





### **Punjab Demands Increase In Compensation Amount For Flood Loss**



The Punjab government has sought from an inter-ministerial Central team relaxation in the norms for increasing disaster relief for victims as it worked out losses of over Rs 1,300 crore due the recent floods in the state.

Several parts of Punjab were affected by a downpour in the state between July 9 and July 11, flooding vast expanse of agricultural fields and other areas besides paralysing normal life.

During the meeting, the Chief Secretary requested the Central team to allow a relaxation in the norms for financial assistance to the flood-affected people, according to an official release.

Punjab Chief Secretary Anurag Verma pointed out that Chief Minister Bhag-

want Mann has already written to Union Home Minister Amit Shah, saying there is no shortfall in the state disaster response fund (SDRF) and only a change in the norms for compensating the damage is required so that loss of the people can be fully compensated.

In the letter written to Shah, the chief minister urged that the amount of compensation for the loss of life be doubled from Rs 4 lakh to Rs 8 lakh, Rs 17,000 to Rs 34,000 for crop damage, Rs 37,500

to Rs 75,000 for milch animals and Rs 1.20 lakh to Rs 2.40 lakh for damaged houses, Verma said.

Giving details of the overall damages, the Chief Secretary said the agriculture sector suffered the damage of Rs 605.38 crore followed by roads and buildings at Rs 173.10 crore, water resources at Rs 159.36 crore, urban infrastructure and local government offices at Rs 44.38 crore, rural development and panchayats at Rs 43.66 crore, school education at Rs 26.85 crore, power at Rs 17.50 crore, fisheries at Rs 9.98 crore, water supply at Rs 5.66 crore, health at Rs 4.45 crore and miscellaneous at Rs 230.26 crore.

A total loss of Rs 1,320.59 crore has been incurred, he added.

#### Canada 'Falling Behind' In Efforts To Lessen Teen Vaping, UBCO Researcher Says



AUBC Okanagan researcher says Canada is falling behind in developing intervention programs to stop young people from beginning to vape.

Dr. Laura Struik, an Assistant Professor with UB-CO's School of Nursing and a Canadian Cancer Society Emerging Scholar, researches nicotine dependence, cancer prevention and behaviour change using digital technologies.

Dr. Struik is disheartened by the results from the recent Health Canada's Canadian Student Tobacco, Alcohol and Drugs Survey, which states that 29 per cent of Canadian students from Grades 7 to 12 have tried an e-cigarette, and 17 per cent have vaped in the past month, revealing that the number of Canadian teens using e-cigarettes are among highest in the world.

Dr. Struik says, "Youth and young adults are disproportionately at risk for the harmful effects of vaping because exposure at this age alters natural brain development and impacts lung health early on. As a result, there has been a long-standing urgency to intervene over the last few years, and we wanted to know what has been done across our nation."

She led a recent study published last month in the American Journal of Preventive Medicine that examined campaigns directed at young people to prevent vaping uptake. For this study, a team of young trainees in Dr. Struik's lab examined government-funded vaping prevention campaigns in Canada and the United States.

A key aspect of public health measures is to develop prevention campaigns to motivate people to make lifestyle choices that benefit themselves or society. The researchers analyzed 46 different campaigns to determine what kind of messaging was being used to influence the behavioural decisions of young people. They found that many spoke about the potentially harmful effects of vaping on the lungs. Struik says there is room to incorporate more meaningful and comprehensive approaches in prevention efforts.

"We know from previous research that vaping uptake is influenced by various intersecting factors, including, but not limited to, mental health, self-efficacy, social norms, environmental factors, knowledge and so forth," she says. "So, relying almost solely on telling teens about the potential physical health harms of vaping as a reason to not vape is likely going to fall flat, and recent youth-driven evidence confirms this." In her latest study, published this month in Addictive Behaviors Reports, Dr. Struik found that Canadian youth who vaped reported a variety of factors that supported their decision to take up vaping, including the belief that vaping was cool, and helped them cope with stress, the normalization of vaping among their peers, the lack of school policies to address vaping, and the fact that there is vague information on the harms of vaping (e.g., "could be harmful")

She also notes that Canada lacks intervention campaigns compared to the United States. Of the 46 unique vaping prevention campaigns in her study, only two were identified in Canada—one at the federal level and one at the provincial level.

"In the end, the evidence reveals that Canada needs to step it up when it comes to vaping prevention programs aimed at our youth," Dr. Struik adds. "And these prevention programs must be informed and driven by Canadian youth themselves to truly tackle this issue."

### *Paramore* cancels North American tour due to Hayley Williams' health

Paramore fans who were looking forward to seeing the band live in Portland and Salt Lake City will have to wait a little longer, as the group has announced the cancellation of the remaining dates of their North American "This Is Why" tour. The reason behind this decision is the health condition of lead singer Hayley Williams, who has been suffering from a lung infection that has worsened over time. The 34-year-old shared the news with her followers on social media, explaining that she had hoped to recover after postponing four shows in late July, but her body did not heal enough to continue performing. She said that she had been doing everything in her power to fight the infection and deliver a good show for her fans, but she realized that it was "past the point of wanting to push through". She also revealed that she was at risk of causing "long-term damage" to her lungs if she did not take care of herself.

"I physically can not go on. I know this isn't great news for anyone. Thank you so much for your continued support," Williams wrote in a statement posted on Paramore's official accounts.

The "All I wanted" star also apologized to the fans who had already made travel plans to attend the concerts, especially those who were camping in Portland. She said that she really tried to "kick this shit", but it got "a little scary" during their last show in Seattle on Aug. 9.

The "This Is Why' tour started in May and featured over 30 shows across the US and Canada. It was supposed to end on Aug. 13 in Salt Lake City, but now the band will have to reschedule the affected dates. Fans who bought tickets for the canceled shows will be able to get refunds at point of purchase.

Paramore is expected to resume their tour later this fall, with several dates planned in Europe, Asia, and Australia. The band has not announced any changes to their international schedule yet, but they will likely update their fans on their website and social media accounts.

We wish Hayley Williams a speedy recovery and hope to see Paramore back on stage soon!



### Gadar 2 Review: Sunny Deol's Chest-Thumping Actioner Is Stale, Could Have Been Avoided

Gadar 2, a sequel to Gadar: Ek Prem Katha (2001), is a classic case of old wine in old bottle and offers very little freshness in terms of its character arcs, settings and the premise. Yet, it qual-



As Charanjit Singh aka Jeete (Utkarsh Sharma) takes it upon himself to find his papaji, he ends up in Pakistan and tries everything to reunite with his father. Things take an ugly turn when Jeete himself gets captured and waits for Tara to come to his rescue. Amid all this, there's a whole chunk in the film when Deol just vanishes from the

the first half shows him as an innocent young guy aspiring to be an actor, the second half projects him as the ultimate action hero — bearded, brooding, rough and tough just like his onscreen father.

Sunny Deol brings back the innocence of his character and his scenes light up the screen. If you look close, Tara is a peace-loving man who resorts to extremely violence only when needed. That's evident from the scenes where he punches a Pakistani cop in the face and doesn't even bother to pick the rifle that could have been of help later. Ameesha is just average and doesn't even try to do anything different than what she did in the first film. In fact, I found her rather bland and soulless. However, Tara and Sakeena's chemistry remains as sweet and pure as you'd expect. Wadhwa, as the antagonist, looks evil and has a strong screen presence.

At 2 hours 50 minutes, Gadar 2 is a tad long and could have been easily shortened by 30 minutes Shaktimaan Talwar's writing is not clever. There's nothing in the dialogues that makes you go wow, and the ones that draw maximum cheer — Hindustan zindabad - we've already heard that before. What I truly enjoyed and loved was the recreated versions of the songs - Main Nikla Gadi leke and Udd Ja Kale Kaavan. They are the soul of the film and take you back in time. And the additional couple of songs are also a breath of fresh air that don't disappoint. As for valour and patriotic fervour, be assured there is no dearth of chest-thumping patriotism and they do give some whistle-worthy moments. Gadar 2 gives ample scope to both Tara and
