



Fourth Man Arrested in Hardeep Nijjar Murder Case Was **Already Facing Firearm Charges**

SURREY: On May 11, BC investigators arrested one more individual, 22-yearold Amandeep Singh, for his role in the shooting death of Hardeep Singh Nijjar. The police informed that Amandeep was already in custody for unrelated firearms charges out of Peel Region in Ontario.

Amandeep's arrest marks the fourth arrest of an Indian national living in connection to Nijjar's killing, with three others arrested in Edmonton earlier this month.

According to CBC News, "Amandeep Singh had been arrested in Surrey, B.C. on a warrant after fleeing from police in March 2023. He was charged with flight from police and dangerous operation of a motor vehicle and made a first court appearance on June 16, 2023. Nijjar was

At the first meeting on May 10, the action table talked about serious issues like online sexual exploitation and sharing private images without permission. They also discussed the importance of broadscale co-operation because online





Mayor Brenda Locke says Surrey cannot afford to pay for two overlapping police services

On April 25, 2024, the Province amended the Police Act to include a new section (Section 27, subsection 3.1), requiring any municipality to notify a municipal police board and the Director of Police Services by May 15 to object to any aspect of a budget proposed by a municipal police board.

The City of Surrey on May 13 informed the Director of Police Services and the provincially appointed Administrator of the Surrey Police Board that it is upholding its approved budget and that Surrey taxpayers will not be on the hook for additional policing costs related to having two overlapping forces. "Otherwise, if City Council were to

approve SPS and RCMP's proposed budgets, we would be looking at an additional cost of more than \$37M. This would double the approved 2024 property tax increase of 7% to more than 14%," Mayor Locke said in a statement.

On May 6, 2024, the City of Surrey approved a policing operations budget of \$221.6 million, which will fund in excess of a combined sworn member strength of 785 members.

"Our goal has always been to protect taxpayers and public safety, and our approach ensures that Surrey taxpayers will not be responsible for covering the out-of-control costs of the NDP's imposed police transition. In 2023, Surrey Police Service dramatically overspent their budget, going 45% over what they were approved to spend. The City cannot afford to pay for two overlapping police services just because the NDP continue to have no plan for this transition," she said.

She explained that the extraordinary step that the City of Surrey has taken was done to comply with a rushed amendment by the Province to the Police Act passed just days before our recent court proceedings. "These changes were made without any consultation with the City, weeks before the new imposed deadline, and have serious implications for municipal budgets throughout BC."



One more Indo-Canadian Man Arrested in Over 20 Million Dollar Gold Heist

REGION OF PEEL, ON:
Ontario police arrested one
more suspect in connection with
over 20 million gold robbery at
Toronto's Pearson International
Airport last year.

In a news release on Thursday, police said Archit Grover, a 36-year-old man from Brampton, was arrested on May 6. He was taken into custody after flying into Toronto from India and arrested for theft over \$5000 and conspiracy to commit an indictable offence.

He was held for a bail hearing and attended the Ontario Court of Justice in Brampton. He is also being indicted in the United States for firearm-related charges, the police said.

Police have charged and issued Canada-wide warrants against other men involved in this multi-million-dollar heist, where the suspects stole the entire cargo full of gold.

On April 17, 2023, at 3:56 p.m.

a flight landed at Pearson International Airport from Zurich, Switzerland, with a cargo containing 6600 bars of .9999% pure gold, weighing 400 kilograms, valued at over 20 million dollars and CAD 2.5 million worth in foreign currency. Shortly after landing, it was offloaded and transported to a separate location on Airport property.

On April 18 the cargo was reported missing to Peel Regional Police.

Peel Regional Police immediately started the investigation, which has crossed borders, and we have been working collaboratively with the Philadelphia Field Division of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives (ATF). ATF arrested one individual in the United States who had 65 illegal firearms in his possession, two of which had been modified to have fully automatic capabilities. Five

of the 65 handguns are known as

'ghost guns,' meaning that they

were not serialized and, therefore, are untraceable.

Peel Regional Police investigators also seized one kilogram of gold worth approximately \$89,000.00, believed to be from the theft, smelting equipment, and approximately \$434,000 Canadian currency.

PRP identified and charged or issued warrants for nine individuals with over 19 charges in April. Police also seized one kilogram of gold worth approximately

\$89,000.00, believed to be from the theft, smelting equipment, and approximately \$434,000 Canadian currency.

Canada-wide warrants are still issued for Simran Preet Panesar, a 31-year-old man from Brampton, a former Air Canada employee, who was employed at the time of the theft and Arsalan Chaudhary, a 42-year-old man of no fixed address.

Investigators urge these individuals to seek legal counsel and turn themselves into the police.

A Warrant in the 1st has been issued for Durante King-Mclean, a 25-year-old man from Brampton. King-Mclean is currently in custody in the United States on firearms trafficking-related charges, and investigators have been in touch with him and his legal counsel.

Investigators are urging anyone with information about this incident to call Peel Regional Police.

Immigration Minister Miller Must Explain Criminal Record Check Claim for Student Visa

Canada's Immigration Minister, Marc Miller, responded to criticisms from India's External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar regarding the recent arrests of three individuals allegedly linked to the killing

of Hardeep Singh Nijjar.

Many media organizations reported that the suspects in Nijjar murder arrived in Canada on student visa. Jaishankar said he had seen news of the arrests and said the

suspects "apparently are Indians of some kind of gang background... we'll have to wait for the police to tell us."

Slamming the Canadian government for welcoming people with links to organised crime, despite warnings by New Delhi, the Minister of External Affairs said, "Somebody may have been arrested; the police may have done some investigation. But the fact is (a) number of gangland people, (a) number of people with organized crime links from Punjab, have been made welcome in Canada," he said.

"These are wanted criminals from India, you have given them visas ... and yet you allow them to live there."

Miller rejected Jaishankar's remark that Ottawa is "lax" about admitting criminals into the country, saying authorities conduct a thorough record check on people entering Canada on student visas. Responding to a question on Monday about Jaishankar's remarks, Miller said, "We're not lax, and the Indian Foreign Minister is entitled to his opinion," reported the Cable Public Affairs Channel -- a Canadian speciality television channel.

"We are not lax," he said, seeking to dismiss Jaishankar's claim that Canada harbours individuals with ties to organized crime. In response to Miller's claims, Conservative Party Leader Pierre Poilievre issued a statement saying that police certificates and criminal background checks from the country of origin are not mandatory for all international students entering Canada on a government issued permit.

"Last week, Minister Marc Miller lied about this. When asked if there were criminal record checks for those on a student visa, he gave a definitive yes and then said "you check them and if they have a criminal record, they don't come in." This is false. Police certificates and criminal



background checks from the country of origin are not mandatory for all international students entering Canada on a government issued permit," Poilievre said.

"After nine years of Justin Trudeau, over 3.6 million international students have been awarded student visas and entered Canada, including a record number of over 683,000 international student visas issued in 2023 alone. But under Justin Trudeau, international students entering Canada on study permits are not automatically required to provide a criminal record check or a police certificate," Poilievre said.

"This outright lie comes from the Minister responsible for granting these visas, despite his previous acknowledgement that the integrity of Canada's immigration system is at risk. The Minister either lied to Canadians, or is not aware of the policies of his own Ministry. It is comments like these that are casting further doubt on the integrity of Canada's immigration system and the Liberal Government's ability to protect the safety of Canadians," added Poilievre.





The little boy who stole hearts at historic Diljit Dosanjh concert

AGrade 1 student from Sullivan Elementary is still walking on air after sharing the stage with Punjabi popstar Diljit Dosanjh at his historic Vancouver concert two weeks ago.

Six-year-old Aanakh Bhuller was at the sold-out concert with his family when the singer spotted him in the crowd. After being called onstage, the Surrey student was introduced to the crowd of more than 50,000 and invited to dance along to the performance.

Breaking into a bhangra routine, Aanakh danced to Dosanjh's hit song, "Vibe," with the crowd roaring in the background.

"It felt good, I do bhangra practice, so it wasn't hard," said Aanakh. "And he's my favourite singer."

The show, which took place April 27 at BC Place, was the first time a Punjabi performer has headlined the venue. For the next few days, Aanakh's performance was the talk of the school, having been featured on Global BC and CBC News.

"They all said they watched me on the news," said Aanakh.

Proud father Barinder Bhuller said Aanakh has been a fan of Dosanjh since 2022 when the family saw him perform at Rogers Arena.

"After that concert, Aanakh asked my parents to tie a turban on him because he wanted to be just like Diljit," said Barinder. "I tweeted that out at the time and Diljit retweeted it. Ever since then, Aanakh had been manifesting this moment."

For Barinder, seeing his son be a part of the historic show was an emotional experience.

"As a first-generation Canadian, we never got to see our cultural icons and performers in mainstream stadiums," he said. "To see how Aanakh idolizes Diljit and then to see him become a part of this show has been overwhelming."

As a thank you, Dosanjh gave Aanakh the unique skeleton jacket he had been wearing on stage – a treasure Aanakh said he will wear to his future bhangra lessons.

"It's my favourite," he said.

NDP fails British Columbians with flawed **Anti-Racism Act**

7ICTORIA, BC: Teresa Wat, BC United Shadow Minister for Multiculturalism, Anti-Racism Initiatives, Arts and Culture, criticized the NDP government for rejecting vital amendments to Bill 23, the Anti-Racism Act.

"These amendments, derived from extensive community input, were designed to significantly strengthen this deeply flawed bill and enhance its effectiveness in tackling racism," said Wat. "It is deeply troubling that Premier David Eby and the NDP have chosen to ignore these common-sense proposals, opting instead to prioritize politics and the appearance of action over the necessary improvements needed to effectively address the very real racism and hate affecting countless British Columbians."

According to BC United, the critical amendments rejected by the NDP included defining 'antisemitism' and 'Islamophobia' to ensure these discrimination forms are



explicitly addressed; substituting 'racialized 'ethnocultural communities' with communities' for more inclusive and representative language; and ensuring public service appointments are meritbased, taking into account qualifications and experience.

"By voting down these amendments, the NDP has demonstrated a clear reluctance to collaborate on establishing a comprehensive and inclusive framework for combating all forms of discrimination in British Columbia," added Wat. "This refusal not only impedes progress towards true equity but also reveals the NDP's willingness to prioritize empty virtue signalling over making life better for all British Columbians."

"BC United will swiftly fix this legislation upon forming government, ensuring it truly meets the needs of all British Columbians and comprehensively addresses racism in every form," Wat said.





Fourth Man Arrested in Hardeep Nijjar Murder case was already facing...

Bhupinder Singh Hothi, of Surrey's Guru Nanak Sikh Gurdwara, who was outside the court with other members informed that the next court hearing is set up on May 21 at 9.30. He said he along with other members intended to attend every court appearance.

IHIT with the assistance of members from the BC and Alberta RCMP and the Edmonton Police Service arrested three other men on May 3rd after 10 months of investigation for the murder of Hardeep Singh Nijjar who was shot to death in the parking lot of Guru Nanak Sikh Gurdwara in Surrey in June 2023.

Three individuals were charged

with first degree murder and conspiracy to commit murder in relation to the homicide: 22-yearold Karan Brar of Edmonton; 22-year-old Kamalpreet Singh of Edmonton; and 28-year-old Karanpreet Singh of Edmonton. Mandeep Superintendent Mooker, the Officer in Charge of IHIT said that the efforts and support of its partners, specifically the Abbotsford Police Department and the Central Region RCMP, assisted IHIT in mitigating a significant public safety risk related to Singh. "This arrest shows the nature of our ongoing investigation to hold responsible those that played a role in the homicide of Hardeep

Mooker had emphasized earlier too that the arrest of the suspects in this high-profile case does not mean the investigation has ended. He said it remains an ongoing investigation.

Singh Nijjar."

IHIT released photos of the accused men in hopes of



furthering its investigation.

IHIT also released photographs of a Toyota Corolla, believed to have been used by the suspects in the time leading up to the homicide, in and around the Surrey area. Superintendent Mooker said that investigation does not end here. "We are aware that there could be others out there that played a role in this homicide and we remain dedicated to identifying and arresting each one of them. I would like to thank the Nijjar family, the citizens of Surrey and the members of the Guru Nanak Gurdwara Executive, for your patience and support throughout this investigation. I appreciate that the community still has questions, many of which we will not be able to answer at this time, as this investigation now proceeds through the courts

Assistant Commissioner David Teboul in a statement said, that the police cannot comment about the nature of the evidence collected by police nor can we speak about the motive behind the murder of Mr. Nijjar. "However, understanding this situation has attracted considerable and very broad public interest, I will say this matter is still very much under active investigation. I will underscore that today's announcements are not a complete account of the investigative work currently underway. There are separate and distinct investigations ongoing into these matters, certainly not limited to the involvement of the people arrested today, and these efforts include investigating connections to the Government

police confirmed the arrested suspects were Indian nationals meaning they were not on PR or Canadian citizens. The Canadian officials including the immigration minister have not commented on the visa status of the killers, but according to many media reports they came to Canada on a student visa and had connections with India's notorious Lawrence Bishnoi

According to Global News, one of the suspects entered Canada using a study permit that he said took only days to obtain. In a video posted online in 2019, Karan Brar said he applied for a student visa through **EthicWorks** Immigration Services in Bathinda, in India's Punjab state.

The three suspects arrested before had already made their first court appearance in a BC court. The killers were not physically present but made the appearance by video.

Friends and family of slain Nijjar and supporters Khalistan gathered outside Surrey's provincial court house last Tuesday as the three men made their first court appearance. The Canadian government has suggested the Indian government is complicit in Nijjar's assassination.

Raja Warring called it an irreparable loss for Punjabi literature. Former Punjab chief minister and BJP leader Amarinder Singh on X said, "End of an era, as famous Punjabi writer and poet Padma Shri Surjit Patar Sahib has passed away today. My heartfelt condolences to his family and millions of fans worldwide. Punjab has lost an icon today."


er Trucking Act.

A newly conceived plan to eliminate unregulated activity by the Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner ("OB-CCTC") is not only long overdue but will also be groundbreaking for the entire drayage sector, according to UTA spokesperson Gagan Singh.

"Our organization has spent the past decade pushing the OBCCTC and BC govpenalize small and medium-sized companies. The UTA contends that this narrative is false and entirely unrepresentative of the current environment which has crushed the earnings of over one thousand legitimate independent operators and company drivers the organization represents.

"The contracting of unlicensed companies has taken food off the tables of our members who work within the rule of law, and so any measures to eliminate this element from our industry is what is desperately needed," added Singh. 

This historic city can be roughly divided into two parts -- Old Lahore and the New Lahore. The Old Lahore boasts of a rich history with Shahi (Royal) Fort, old railway station, Anarkali Bazar and various Sikh places of worship such as Guru Ram Das Ji's birthplace in Choona Mandi, Gurdwara Dehra Sahib etc.

Lahore played an important role during struggle for independence from the British Raj. It was this city where freedom fighters like Shaheed Bhagat Singh and many other dedicated freedom fighters sacrificed their lives.

Also, community leaders like Dial Singh Majithia laid the foundations of a bank and a prominent English newspaper like The Tribune, which has been a very popular newspaper in northern India.

The generosity, hospitality, and kindness of Punjabis whether they were West Punjab, East Punjab or NRI Punjabis scattered around the globe, is very impressive. BC to introduce child care options in three school districts

Three school districts have been selected for fully integrated before- and after-school care on school grounds: Chilliwack, Nanaimo-Ladysmith and Nechako Lakes. Early childhood educators and support staff in these school districts will provide learning and care for children in classrooms and school spaces the kids are familiar with. This means busy parents will have greater flexibility for school dropoff and pickup times, while also saving time spent commuting or juggling kids across multiple locations.

Each district will create a model of care that meets provincial guidelines and local needs. The initiative will be evaluated and lessons will support ongoing expansion in other districts.

These spaces will be affordable for parents as they will meet regional affordability benchmarks set by the ministry. Families may

also be eligible for fee reductions of as much as \$115 per month, per child. Families that need additional support with the cost of child care may also be eligible for the Affordable Child Care Benefit.

ChildCareBC, Through government has funded the creation of more than 10,175 child care spaces on school grounds since 2018, with almost 3,600 of those open and providing care for children. In 2018, there were two school districts in the province providing licensed child care on school grounds. Licensed child care on school grounds is available in more than 900 facilities throughout the province, with more than 70 of these operated by school districts.

Young adults at risk of homelessness move into 30 affordable homes in Surrey

SURREY, BC: Young adults experiencing or at risk of homelessness now have access to 30 affordable homes with supports as they move into a new transitional-housing building.

The building at 11228 131 St., named by youth as 1.1.2. for the first three digits of its address, provides 24/7 support services for young adults between 19 and 24, many of whom are transitioning from government care. The building is operated by the Pacific Community Resources Society.

Supports at 1.1.2. include daily meals, health and wellness services, cultural programming and recreational events, as well as connections to substance-use services, education, training and other employment opportunities. Residents will stay for two years or until age 25, and partner with a housing worker to prepare to move into permanent housing.

British Columbians could receive rebate upto \$16,000 to switch to high-efficiency heat pumps in homes

VICTORIA, BC: The federal government has announced an investment up to \$103.7 million to support climate action in B.C. and help people with low or middle incomes reduce their energy costs. An investment up to \$151 million from the Province of British Columbia toward this initiative was also announced.

With the support of the OHPA program, income-qualified applicants could receive a rebate of as much as \$16,000 to switch to high-efficiency heat pumps in homes currently heated with oil. With the support of the Low Carbon Economy fund, these changes will also apply to homes heated with natural gas and propane. This is an increase in support of approximately 70% from B.C.'s existing rebate program.

Participants will not need to pay up



front for heat-pump installations and other efficiency upgrades. Applicants pre-register for the program to verify their eligibility. Once upgrades are completed by a program-approved contractor, the contractor submits the final rebate application and deducts the rebate amount from the final cost of the upgrade.

British Columbians will be able to apply to the new Better Home Energy Savings Program starting on June 18, 2024.

Honoring the Eternal Bond: The story behind Mother's Day

Tay 12th was Mother's Day – a cel-Lebration of the eternal bond of love and affection between a mother and a child. Bringing up a child through giving birth and helping him or her grow up into an adult is considered to be the essence of motherhood.

The modern holiday of Mother's Day was first celebrated in 1908 when Anna Jarvis held a memorial for her mother, Maria Reeves Jarvis at St Andrew's Methodist Church in Grafton, West Virginia. St. Andrew's Methodist Church now holds the International Mother's Day Shrine. Designated as the second Sunday in May by President Woodrow Wilson of the USA in 1914 has now spread overseas. Franklin Delano Roosevelt personally designed in 1934 a postage stamp to commemorate the day. Anna Jarvis's mother was an anti-war activist. Thus, the day was a way to promote global unity after the horrors of the American Civil War and Europe's Franco-Prussian War.

The white carnation, the favourite flower of Anna Jarvis' mother, was the original flower for Mother's Day. "The carnation does not drop its petals, but hugs them to its heart as it dies, and so, too, mothers hug their children to their hearts, their mother loves never dying" Jarvis explained in an interview in 1927. Anna Jarvis was against raising charities on this day. "To have Mother's Day, the burdensome, waste-



ful, expensive gift day that Christmas and other special days have become, is not our pleasure." Objections to charity fundraising and rampant commercialism have come to absolutely nothing.

According to the World Vision Development Foundation, "The pivotal role of being a mother is still the divine mission assigned to the women alone. From a classical poem written by William Ross Wallace entitled "What Rules the World?" He said, "The hand that rocks the cradle is the hand that rules the world." It illustrates the influence a mother plays to her child and eventually to society, that as a mother strives to nurture and tutor a child, she explicitly makes the world a much better place. God gives women an opportunity and privilege to be His partner in giving a life to another human being. "God could not be everywhere, therefore, he made mothers"- Rudyard Kipling.

In Hindu religion 'Mother Worship' is very ancient. They equate mother with God. They salute even the earth as mother-earth and their country as Bharat Mata or Mother India. Sri Ramakrishna Paramahamsa, one of the greatest sages of modern times, worshipped the Divine Mother Kali during his entire life.

2024 Honda Civic Sport Touring Review: All you Need!

The Honda Civic has been the best-selling car in Canada for almost a century. And now the 2024 Civic returns as a five-passenger, five-door 10th generation model.

The Civic has a more mature understated design that will not polarize buyers with its neat inoffensive shape. The lines are cleaner with a larger greenhouse for a more spacious interior feeling.

Two engines are offered in the Civic: a 2.0-litre four-cylinder (158 hp / 138 lb-ft.) and a 1.5-litre turbocharged four-cylinder (180 hp / 177 lb-ft). Both engines drive the front wheels and are paired with either a six-speed manual or continuously variable transmission (CVT).

The topline Touring arrives with additional power courtesy of a 180-hp, 1.5L turbocharged four-cylinder engine and a CVT. The four trim levels of Civic start with the -LX (\$30,130), EX, Sport (\$30,250) and Sport Touring (\$37,170.)

There is a fully digital gauge cluster on Touring models, and there is a new 7-inch and optional 9-inch center touchscreen that integrates Apple CarPlay and Android Auto. Top trims are also equipped with a 12-speaker premium Bose sound system, wireless phone charging, GPS navigation, and leather-trimmed seating surfac-

es. We tested the Sport Touring model with a standard equipment list including LED headlights, taillights, and fog lights, 18-inch aluminum alloy wheels, 10.25-inch digital instrument cluster, 9-inch infotainment touchscreen with embedded navigation, heated front, and rear seats, plus a heated leather-wrapped steering wheel and a lot more.

Safety is also high with newly designed front airbags, rear side airbags, and an updated suite of driver assistance features including a wide-angle front view camera and an all -around blind-spot monitoring system.

The new cabin design for the 2024 Civic is wonderful, ergonomically perfect with comfortable supportive seats and plenty of occupant room both front and rear. There is an easy-to-use infotainment system, bright clear digital displays, and instrument cluster unit. The cabin design is clean and ergonomically sound. Switchgear, dials, and control knobs are all impeccably designed for form and function. A standout feature is the exquisite metal honeycomb vent covers that stretch across the dashboard, and the elegant controls that operate them. All the materials and design would make a German premium auto maker proud!

Moving to the rear, you gain roomy comfortable seats and there is adequate legroom for at least three passengers at a push. The rear hatch door is now also



lower and wider for easier access and maximum cargo volume is rated at 693 litres.

We tested an automatic CVT equipped Sport Touring model with the 1.5-litre turbo engine. Note, the Sport comes with either the CVT or a six-speed manual transmission for the same price. The turbo is a refined, smooth unit offering plenty of acceleration and a linear power delivery.


The new Civic Hatchback is stiffer than before with a lower centre of gravity and a wider track for more stable on-road composure. It is certainly an improvement over the old Civic, being quieter and smoother. The suspension irons out rough surfaces, while handling is nicely bal-Drive anced.

feel of the tested Sport Touring was refined, smooth, and the turbo engine is a gem of motor. Handling, cornering, and agility are impressive. The Civic is wholesome fun to drive. Acceleration is good for everyday driving with delivered reassuring reflexes and solid stopping power on all road conditions. The new engineering upgrades also make for a responsive and agile car with good

steering feedback. Fuel economy is rated at: a combined fuel consumption figure of 7.1L/100 km on 87 octane fuel.

Overall, the 2024 Civic Hatchback impresses. The core values of this perennial Canadian 24 -Year best-seller remain intact: value, versatility, comfort, a classy interior, and solid build quality. Highly recommended as top in its sector. I recommend the Sport or Sport Touring model with slick six-sped manual transmission for more entertaining driving if that's your thing. Still, whatever model you choose, you know you are getting the best compact car money can buy.





Five-year-old Spencer Oulton, from Surrey, was only 17 months old when he was faced with a life-altering accident that left him with severe burns all over his face and chest.

In February 2020, Spencer was reaching for a cup on the counter, which he thought had a smoothie in it. It was a disposable cup from takeout the night before. Spencer's father repurposed it to dispose of the grease and water from the meat he was cooking. He thought he had pushed it far enough back that it would be out of reach, but unfortunately Spencer was able to reach it when his dad's back was



third-degree burns to his face and chest. As Spencer recovered, he underwent a strict regimen of burn baths and treatments. Despite the community's support,

just a month after Spencer's accident added an additional layer of difficulty to their

However, a beacon of hope emerged in the form of the Little Lionhearts Family



Camp in 2023, where Spencer and his family found solace with others who had gone through similar experiences. The experience not only lifted their spirits, but also provided Spencer with the opportunity to familiarize himself with the camp before attending Burn Camp in the future. Individuals participating in the Hometown Heroes Lottery support essential services and survivor programs, directly impacting individuals like Spencer. Every ticket purchased contributes directly to supporting funds for essential services at VGH and UBC Hospital, GF Strong Rehab Centre, and Vancouver Community Health Services, while also backing Burn Fund initiatives aiding burn and trauma survivors province-wide. These initiatives include the Home Away program, mental health support services, and the annual Burn Camp for young survivors, all making a profound impact on the lives of those in need across British Columbia. Despite the challenges he encountered, Spencer's journey is a testament to the ability to overcome adversity and find healing and hope in unexpected places.

Expelled Akali Dal leader Ravikaran Kahlon joins BJP



Shiromani Akali Dal leader Ravikaran Singh Kahlon has joined BJP, a day after he was expelled by the Sukhbir Singh Badal-led party.

Badal expelled Kahlon from the primary membership

of the SAD for "antiparty" activities and "backstabbing" the party. Kahlon was welcomed into the party fold by Punjab BJP chief Sunil Jakhar and party leader Manjinder Singh Sirsa. Kahlon is the son of former Punjab Assembly speaker and rural development and panchayat minister Nirmal Singh Kahlon.

Kahlon had unsuccessfully contested the 2022 Punjab Assembly polls from the Dera Baba Nanak seat.

Amritpal's nomination accepted at DC office

The Election Commission of India (ECI) has accepted the nomination of pro-Khalistani separatist and Waris Punjab De Chief Amritpal Singh to contest from Punjab's Khadoor Sahib Lok Sabha constituency as an independent candidate.

As per the ECI data, the nomination was filed on May 10. Amritpal Singh is currently lodged in Dibrugarh jail, Assam. Earlier in April this year, Singh's mother claimed that the pro-Khalistani leader had "pressure" to contest the polls.

The pro-Khalistani leader was arrested by Punjab police in April last year, weeks after



evading police for over a month and the stringent National Security Act was invoked against him. He and nine of his associates are currently lodged in Assam's Dibrugarh jail.

The Khadoor Sahib seat was won by the Congress' Jasbir Singh Gill in 2019.

Voting for 13 Lok Sabha seats in Punjab is scheduled to be held on June 1 in the seventh phase of the Lok Sabha elections.

If you press broom symbol, I will not need to go back to jail: Arvind Kejriwal in Amritsar

Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal urged people to vote for AAP if they don't want him to return to jail. Holding a roadshow in Punjab's Amritsar for the party's candidate Kuldeep Singh Dhaliwal, the AAP supremo also claimed that the BJP will end reservation for SC, ST and OBC if it gets a majority in the Lok Sabha. Referring to the BJP, Kejriwal said saffron party leaders are saying he will have to go to jail after 20 days. "Whether I go (back) to jail or not depends upon you. If you press the 'jhadoo' (AAP's election symbol) button, I will not need to go to jail," Kejriwal

"Whether I go (back) to jail or not depends upon you. If you press the 'jhadoo' (AAP's election symbol) button, I will not need to go to jail," Kejriwal said. "While pressing the button, remember if you are pressing the button for Kejriwal's freedom or for sending Kejriwal to jail," the AAP chief said.

A bench of Justice Sanjiv Khanna and Justice Dipankar Datta on Thursday refused to consider claims and



counter claims by advocates for the Enforcement Directorate (ED) and Kejriwal on statements related to the grant of interim bail to the AAP chief.

Appearing for the ED, Solicitor General Tushar Mehta objected to Kejriwal's speeches in poll rallies that if people vote for AAP, he will not have to go back to prison on June 2. On May 10, the apex court granted Kejriwal interim bail till June 1, the last day of the seven-phase Lok Sabha elections, and directed him to surrender and go back to jail on June 2. The Delhi chief minister was arrested on March 21.

Earlier, Kejriwal offered prayers at the Golden Temple in Amritsar, during his first visit to the state since being granted interim bail. He also paid obeisance at the Durgiana Temple.

To honour his memory, the City has placed commemorative street signs for "Will Senger Way" at key intersections: the corner of 62 Avenue and 177B Street, on 62A Avenue and 177B Street, and on 64 Avenue and 177B Street.
