


Dhillon was attending the NDP Rally in Surrey

They Can Break My Eye Not My Resolve For Unbiased Journalism: Says South Asian Radio Host Attacked In Calgary

Rishi Nagar, a longtime host with RED FM Calgary, was assaulted last week by two men in a parking lot in the 2800 block of Hopewell Place N.E., striking him repeatedly and forcing him to the pavement.

Red FM shared the news, On Sept 29th at 3 pm, our Host and News Director Rishi Nagar was attacked by 2 people. The complaint has been filed with the Calgary Police."

A surveillance video captured the assault after Nagar had left a political event at the Rio Banquet Hall. The attack was halted when other men intervened and shielded a sitting Nagar, after which his assailants left.

Calgary police confirmed they attended the banquet hall around 3 p.m. on Sunday after reports of an assault. When officers arrived, they found one person with injuries consistent with a



physical assault. He was not transported to hospital by EMS.

Nagar held a press conference in which he gave the details of the events that led to his attack. He believes he was attacked as a result of previous reporting he did connected to ongoing extortion. He said, "Many of you are aware I have spent a significant portion of my career reporting on the growing

issues of extortions and criminal activities affecting the South Asian communities because the hardworking and the successful members of our community are living under constant fear and threat. It is important for the media to play its role and provide unbiased journalism."

Nagar informed CBC that the attackers told him they were upset with recent reporting his outlet did. He said the coverage in question revolved around two weapons-related arrests last Wednesday at the Dashmesh Culture Centre.

Nagar, who was bandaged across the left eye, said the attack left him with painful eye injuries and have left him at risk of "retinal detachment." But he said that he will not be silenced and continue to do unbiased reporting. "The physical injuries that I sustained

including an injury to my eye the retina is under a risk of severe damage and these injuries are for sure painful but what wounds me more deeply is the intent behind this assault. It is a clear attack on journalism and on the free press. This was not a personal attack on me alone this was an assault on the very principles that bind us as a free and democratic Society."

He further added, "I will not be silenced these cowardly actions will not deter me or my colleagues from continuing our work nor will they dissuade the Press from reporting on matters of public interest. They can break my eye not the resolve."

Nagar is a one-time University of Calgary senator and a former member of the Calgary Police Service's antiracism committee.

BC's Chief Electoral Officer issues formal order for 43rd Provincial General Election

There are 93 electoral districts
New technology will be used this
time to help voters with sight loss and
other forms of disability

B.C.'s Chief Electoral Officer has issued the writs of election for the 43rd Provincial General Election. Final Voting Day will take place on Saturday, October 19 in 93 electoral districts.

The writ of election is a formal order signed by the Chief Electoral Officer and the Lieutenant Governor that directs a District Electoral Officer to conduct an election. An election is called when the writ of election has been issued. In a general election, a writ is issued for each of the province's 93 electoral districts.

When they are returned, the election period is officially over.

There are lots of ways to vote from now until Final Voting Day on October 19. Eligible voters can vote at any district electoral office during office hours, by mail, at advance voting from October 10-13, and October 15-16, or on Final Voting Day, Saturday, October 19, 2024. New voting processes are being used to administer this election. This includes using networked laptops instead of paper lists to look up voters and cross them off the voters list.

Networked laptops will be used to look up voters and cross them off the voters list, instead of paper lists. This reduces



line-ups, makes the voting process more efficient and helps voters vote at any voting place.

Electronic tabulators will be used to count paper ballots. Tabulators are accurate, secure and efficient. They help us report results quickly on election night.

These changes mean that almost all

ballots in the election will be counted on election night. In past BC elections, absentee and mail-in ballots could not be counted until final count, which took place about two weeks after election day. This delay was necessary to complete the manual, paper-based checks that were required to verify that the voters who cast these ballots were eligible to vote and that they had only voted once. The new voting process and the networked laptops allow us to perform these integrity checks much faster—almost in real-time. This means that around 98% of all ballots, including absentee and mail-in ballots, will be counted on election night.

Political parties urged to expand Punjabi Language programs in BC schools

British Columbia's election is in full swing. The three main political parties- NDP, Conservative and Green are very active in presenting their respective programs and policies to the electorate. On behalf of Punjabi Language Education Association (PLEA), I would like to bring to the attention of these parties, their candidates and their leaders some issues relating to Punjabi language in this province.

Currently in B.C., close to 2 million Punjabi speakers

call Canada their home. Punjabi language is now the third most spoken language both in Canada, in cities like Brampton, Edmonton, Calgary and Metro Vancouver. Punjabi was recognized as one of several second languages to be available in BC's public schools. As things stand now, students in B.C.'s public schools are required to take one of six recognized second languages from grades 5 to 8 . It is optional from grades 9 to 12. Punjabi is one of these recognized languages.

PLEA would like to request that the second language requirement for our students should be changed from the existing requirement of grades 5 to 8 as compulsory requirement to grades 4 to 7 as compulsory and grades 8 to 12 as optional. For Middle schools, it should be compulsory from grades 6 to 8 and optional from grades 9 to 12. Our reason for this is that in our current school system there is a natural break from Primary to Intermediate grades-Kindergarten to grade to 3 being Primary and grades 4 to 7 being Intermediate. As such, it should be made compulsory from grades 4 to 7 and optional from grades 8 to 12. However, for the Middle Schools, it will make sense to have it compulsory from grades 6 to 8 and optional from grades 9 to 12.

Furthermore, PLEA requests that as Punjabi is the third most spoken language, the provincial government and the local school districts




should have appropriate messaging and information available to parents about the availability of Punjabi as second language in our public schools.

Also, the province should ask the post secondary institutions to include teaching of Punjabi as a second language in B.C.'s public schools as part of the teacher training programs in their universities. In addition to that, the school districts and the province should assist with professional development opportunities for teachers of Punjabi language.

In certain schools/school districts, it may be difficult to have enough students or qualified teachers. As such, providing online Punjabi classes throughout the province should be given careful consideration and support. In some of the Metro Vancouver schools/ school districts where there is a large number of students who may be interested in taking Punjabi, the process of determining their interests should start early in the calendar year so that the schools/School Districts get enough time to hire teachers, provide classrooms and other support structure to ensure the success of the Punjabi classes. At the secondary school level, it should be included at the time of course selection early in the new year that Punjabi is available as an option from grade 9 onwards.

Incidentally, Punjabi is the tenth most spoken language in the world with more than 150 million speakers worldwide. In Canada and many other countries, it has now become an asset in employment opportunities. PLEA urges all political parties to give serious consideration to these recommendations.





British Columbia campaign officially began more than ten days ago and both major political parties are making promises to improve the healthcare system.

John Rustad is promising significant changes to the healthcare system on behalf of the Conservative Party. These include sending people outside the province for care and expanding private clinics. Their website states they will "allow choice and competition in the delivery of health care services..."

We have had significant debate over the public vs. private healthcare system in British Columbia over the last few years. In April 2023, Canada's highest court refused to hear an appeal from a Vancouver-based physician who had been challenging the health-care system

BC Election: Rustad's proposals for changes in healthcare will produce a two-tier system

over access to private care. The Supreme Court of Canada's decision ended Dr. Brian Day's 14-year legal battle to allow patients access to private care even when the public system may not be able to offer timely care.

In 2007, BC's Medical Services Commission (MSC) advised Dr. Brian Day of its intention to audit his for-profit medical clinics in response to patient complaints. Dr. Day responded with a Charter challenge to strike down key sections of the BC Medicare Protection Act. This law protects BC's public health care system by banning extra-billing by doctors or clinics covered by the public

Despite Dr. Day's efforts to block the audit, the MSC proceeded with the audit in 2011 and found unlawful billings by Dr. Day's clinics.

During the Supreme Court of BC trial, many physicians, health administrators and academics provided expert testimony about the problems of the private healthcare system.

Contrary to what advocates of private health care say, privately paying for health care is not banned in Canada. However, most provinces disincentivize healthcare professionals from working in the public and private systems at the same time to prevent taxpayers from subsidizing a private system that does not provide equitable patient access.

Had Dr. Day succeeded, the Canada Health Act and its focus on equitable access would have been undermined. Forprofit clinics would have had unrestricted ability to charge patients and the public purse while creating a private insurance market for health care.

Canadian evidence demonstrates that private, for-profit delivery of surgical and diagnostic services are more expensive than non-profit delivery, risks lower quality care and patient safety and destabilizes the public system by drawing


professionals. Many studies have shown that the expansion of for-profit facilities diverted resources away from public hospitals and, in turn, reduced provincial surgical volumes and increased wait times.

Health experts have long argued against private health care in Canada, citing concerns that a two-tier system would favour patients who are wealthy enough to pay for "queue-jumping" private insurance, as well as doctors who could bill both the public and private systems. Rustad is advocating for private health clinics so that those with money can jump the line and get priority treatments while others wait their turn in the public system. Rustad's offer of allowing choice and competition in the delivery of health care services is not much of a choice as it will lead to a two-tier healthcare system.

BC's Chief Electoral Officer issues.

The technology provides new services for voters with sight loss and other forms of disability. An Accessible Voting System will be available in every district electoral office as soon as possible after the close of candidate nominations on September 28. Voters will have the option to listen to an audio recording of the candidate list for their district and cast their vote by using a hand-held selector device, sip-and-puff straws or

paddles. Voters using the system will be able to mark their ballot independently, and be confident that their choice will be counted accurately.

Election BC is urging voters to stay away from disinformation and misinformation. It is vital that British Columbians have accurate, factual information about the electoral process, especially information about where and when they can vote in a provincial election.

Canada, Yukon Sign Work Permits **Deal For Temporary Workers**

Marc Miller, Immigration, arc Miller, Minister of Refugees and Citizenship, announced that the federal government has reached an agreement with the Government of Yukon to help temporary workers crucial to economic development in the territory eventually become permanent residents.

This temporary measure will give new work permits to up to 215 temporary workers identified and supported by the Government of Yukon to continue working while they process their permanent residence applications under the Yukon Nominee Program.

"This agreement is a critical development that will allow foreign nationals to remain in the Yukon and continue to provide valuable contributions to our labour market until they are able to apply to the Yukon Nominee Program. I want to thank the Government of Canada for its support in implementing this collaborative approach to immigration in the territory. This temporary measure will help provide greater certainty for foreign nationals who call the Yukon home as we work to support their transition to permanent residency," said Ranj Pillai, Yukon Premier.

Eligible individuals have to demonstrate that they meet the criteria and are expected to transition to permanent residence in 2025 and 2026. These skilled workers are filling key job vacancies in Yukon and are actively contributing to Canada's

economy and social diversity.

To date, IRCC has worked with Alberta, Manitoba and Yukon to implement this measure in those jurisdictions. IRCC remains open to exploring options with all provinces and territories to transition a greater portion of current temporary residents to permanent residence while addressing their labour market

IRCC will continue to collaborate with provinces and territories to achieve our shared economic immigration objectives. "By giving new work permits for skilled workers in Yukon, we are not only supporting local labour market needs in critical sectors, but also giving more temporary residents a clear pathway to permanent

Making Surrey First Class: John Rustad unveils plan to invest in infrastructure in Surrey

ohn Rustad, Leader of the Conservative Party of British Columbia, announced a transformative infrastructure and transportation plan under the banner "Get BC Moving." Rustad criticized the NDP for neglecting vital infrastructure projects and imposing delays that have worsened bottlenecks, congestion, and inefficiencies across the province.

infrastructure and inadequate public transit are dragging down daily life and our economy," said Rustad. "While demand for all types of infrastructure continues to grow, the NDP has failed to fix the bottlenecks that exist today—let alone build what's needed for tomorrow." Taking Transit Seriously - Extending

Rustad also addressed the public transit crisis in BC, where service gaps, unreliable routes, and safety concerns have left commuters stranded and vulnerable. He called out the NDP for neglecting transit development while demand soared.

"A growing population needs a growing transit network. We will extend SkyTrain to Newton in Surrey, fund key projects in the Transport 2050 plan, and ensure reliable and safe transit for all British Columbians," said Rustad.

Conservatives will also prioritize regional transit, including Fraser Valley regional rail and expanded transit service in the Sea-to-Sky corridor, as well as enhanced safety measures on public transit.

Connecting Communities - Expanding the New Pattullo Bridge

John Rustad also unveiled ambitious plans for the Pattullo Bridge, a critical connection between Surrey and New Westminster. Under the NDP government, the replacement bridge has been limited to four lanes, which fails to meet the growing demands of these two rapidly expanding communities.

"The Pattullo Bridge is a key artery for our region, and the current four-lane design is simply not enough," said Rustad. 

Sluggish Sales And Rising **Inventories See Fraser Valley Moving Toward** A Buyer's Market

With active inventories hitting levels not seen in 10 years and sales 30 per cent below the 10-year average, Fraser Valley real estate is building towards a buyer's market if sales continue to lag. The Fraser Valley Real Estate Board recorded 982 sales in September, down by eight per cent over August and by more than 10 per cent over September 2023. Harliv Singh Cheema And Masood Mohammad Charged With Orchestrating A 2023 Shooting In Calgary

Yalgary Police has charged ∠Harliv Singh Cheema and Masood Mohammad with conspiracy to commit murder in relation to a brazen shooting that occurred last year. At approximately 2:45 p.m., on Saturday, Sept. 30, 2023, a driver called police to report a shooting involving two vehicles that occurred on westbound Glenmore Trail, near 37 Street S.W. Both vehicles fled the scene prior to police arrival and no injuries were reported.

Approximately 30 minutes later, police were called to a residence located in the 100 block of Seton Passage S.E., for reports a man had been shot while parking his vehicle. Upon arrival, officers located one man suffering from gunshot wounds. He was transported to

hospital in serious condition. It is believed the suspect fired multiple rounds during the shooting in Seton, with stray bullets striking four surrounding residences, before fleeing the scene in a stolen vehicle.

Both shootings had targeted the same victim and were believed to be connected to organized crime conflict in Calgary. On Wednesday, Oct. 18, 2023, one man was arrested and charged. Despite these charges, our investigators remained committed to determining if anyone else was involved in the shootings. Due to the level of violence displayed, multiple investigative strategies were used, and a significant number of resources were dedicated to this investigation.

As a result, two men are now facing charges for their involvement in the shooting that occurred on Glenmore Trail, as well as their involvement in planning the shooting that occurred in Seton.

Masood MOHAMMAD, 30, of Calgary, has been charged with attempted murder and conspiracy to commit murder. MOHAMMAD will next appear in court on Monday, Oct. 7, 2024.

Harliv Singh CHEEMA, 20, of Calgary, has been charged with conspiracy to commit murder and accessory after the fact to an indictable offence. CHEEMA will next appear in court on Monday, Oct. 7, 2024. "Our job is to hold everyone responsible for violence in

Calgary accountable, and our efforts do not stop at the individual who pulls the trigger," said Acting Insp. Roland Stewart of the OCOM Section. "This investigation is a direct example of the dedication and tenacity of our organized crime investigators, who spend months collecting evidence to progress an investigation despite unco-operative victims and attempts to evade police." "We continue to target organized-crime-related violence in Calgary through the use of intelligence, investigation, enforcement and suppression. Investigating

evidence, active efforts to evade police detection and historically unco-operative victims and witnesses. Despite these complexities, our Service continues to target anyone involved in organized crime, no matter how much time has passed, and will dedicate resources to hold individuals especially accountable, in situations that have put members of the public at risk," Stewart said

Overall inventory increased five per cent from August to September to 9,045, up 39 per cent over last year. The combination of declining sales and rising inventories has helped to create balanced, and in some cases, buyers', market conditions in the Fraser Valley.

"We know the demand is there among Fraser Valley buyers," said Baldev Gill, CEO of the Fraser Valley Real Estate Board. "After months on the sidelines, buyers want to get into the market but many also need to sell before they can buy. When you factor in affordability challenges and the anticipation of more interest rate cuts, we are seeing persistent weakness in the market. In conditions like these, we encourage buyers and sellers alike to talk to their REALTOR® to assess the risks and opportunities before making a decision."

Across the Fraser Valley in September, the average number of days to sell a single-family detached home was 35, while for a condo it was 37. Townhomes took, on average, 30 days to sell. Benchmark prices in the Fraser Valley dipped again in September, with the composite Benchmark price down 1.4 per cent to \$978,800.





with the push of a button in 13 seconds. Power is courtesy of a 181 horsepower SKYACTIVE 2.0-liter four-cylinder engine developing 7,000 rpm and 151 pound-feet of torque at 4,000 rpm. 



International Scholars gather in...

discussed building an excellent university from scratch. Dr. Summerlee's address drew a sharp contrast between for-profit and non-profit institutes, who face entirely different challenges."

From research on environmentally friendly housing to Sikh scientists' contribution in the field of global field production, reconstructing Zafarnama, or discussing mental health of the Sikh population, the Sumit offered a unique platform to exchange ideas and foster collaboration amongst various age groups.

Dr Kulvinder Singh Gill from Washington State University who has published over 200 scientific papers, developed 4 wheat varieties developed rapid breeding methods and many more ground breaking research, talked about Sikh scientists' contribution to global wheat production. A key panel discussion focused on the challenges faced by international students, particularly those from India. Panelists addressed how for-profit universities often exploit these students, neglecting their mental health and overall well-being. The discussion made it clear that there is an urgent need for policies to support international students emotionally and psychologically. The summit organizers committed to conducting further research on the issues raised and submitting policy recommendations to the government.

Breaking the stigma surrounding mental

health in South Asian households was another vital topic, addressed by Dr. Nimrat Kaur Bahiya, a psychologist and faculty member at Coventry University in the UK. She highlighted how mental health issues are often ignored within Sikh families in the UK, stressing the importance of open conversations on the subject.

Dr. Harpreet Singh, a research scholar from Harvard University, presented his study on Guru Gobind Singh's Zafarnama, analyzing it in the context of various languages and grammatical structures.

Dr Sagarjeet Singh, a practicing physician and a research scholar from Pakistan brought attention to the plight of the Bagri Sikhs of Pakistan, revealing that 56% of Bagri Sikh children in Pakistan never receive formal education.

Well-known community members and scholars from Canada like Baljit Singh from Saskatchewan University, Wally Oppal, former Justice of BC's court of appeal, Rumneek Joah, Associate editor, Press Progress and Anupreet Sandhu Bhamra, UBC faculty member universities participated in a panel discussion on Canadian political landscape. Federal Minister Harjit Singh Sajjan, also participated in the Summit.

The summit not only emphasized academic achievements but also focused on highlighting the global impact and contributions of Sikhs. Gian Singh Sandhu said, "We have identified key areas to highlight, and every year we change the focus to keep the discussions fresh and relevant." The research presented at the summit will be published in the coming months, allowing people from around the world to benefit from the insights shared at this gathering.

Post clip Rustad has been asked multiple times about the video and his stance on the COVID-19 vaccination program during a news conference on Monday. repeatedly dodged the questions but said the previous inability of unvaccinated doctors and nurses to get their jobs back in B.C. was a "horrendous problem."

Dhillon also criticized BC Conservative party for supporting anti-democratic bizarre and dangerous views. NDP has claimed that some Conservative candidates have advanced antidemocratic conspiracy theories that the 2020 election was stolen from Trump and that the January 6 riots at the capitol are a hoax orchestrated by Democrats. BC NDP leader Eby also wrote to Rustad in an open letter, urging him to drop candidates who Eby said have "dangerous and extreme views."

Dhillon said, "A party that is openly racist, and believes in conspiracy theories —that's not who should lead us. David Eby, our Premier, even sent a letter urging Rustad to disown such candidates.

Dhillon expressed grave concerns, calling the risk of such leadership the "Rustad Risk." On his experience in law enforcement, Dhillon emphasized his party's dedication to combating organized crime and illicit wealth. "This is the party that has taken strong action against money laundering and organized crime.



He also highlighted the addition of 250 new RCMP officers and the creation of a new gang homicide team to address violent crime in the province.

When asked about his priorities for his riding, Dhillon who has been a resident of Surrey for 35 years beamed with pride, "I live in an amazing community with diverse voices excited for this election. They see a government that, in just six years, has done more than others did in over a decade. We're giving people a chance to return to normalcy." He acknowledged the challenges of inflation and interest rates but reassured voters that even during tough times, his party had supported them with what they needed to make it through.

Dhillon remains hopeful that his party will continue to bring progress, admitting that while there's more to be done, the BC NDP is committed to facing challenges head-on. "Families are struggling, some can't afford homes or groceries, but they know this government has a real plan, not just press releases," he said.

Regarding specific projects Serpentine, for Surrey Dhillon pointed out ongoing improvements in schools, and housing, healthcare, particularly a new hospital coming soon. He emphasized that while there's a lot left to do, much progress is already visible. He also spoke passionately about the importance of Surrey, noting that under previous governments, the city was neglected, but now, it's receiving the infrastructure support it desperately needs.

Richmond RCMP is warning the public scam targeting Richmond residents, part of following reports of a Bitcoin extortion a larger trend across the Lower Mainland. In all three reported cases, the fraudster contacted victims through social media platform, demanding approximately \$2000 in Bitcoin. The scammers threatened to release personal information—such as victims' full address, phone number, occupation, and compromising photos—if the ransom was not paid. In some cases, images of what appears to be victims' residences were also included in the extortion message.

These frauds are extremely distressing because they involve legitimate personal information that scammers have obtained, says Corporal Adriana O'Malley, Richmond RCMP Media Relations Officer. Thankfully, all of the victims recognized the scam and did not pay. However, with the sensitive nature of the information, it's easy to see how someone could fall prey to such tactics.

Richmond RCMP offers the following tips to help protect against online scams:



Familiarize yourself with social media privacy settings, and consider limiting who has access to your personal information (i.e. friends list, location);

Be skeptical of unexpected messages, especially those that attempt to pressure or scare you;

Don't comply with any threats;

Cease all communication with the individual if you suspect fraud;

Deactivate (but do not permanently delete) any accounts used to communication with the fraudster;

Report the incident to police.

Warning To Local Businesses Following Alleged Thefts Of Trailers Involving Stolen Semi-Trucks

Richmond RCMP warning local of similar factors that lead us to believe further thefts may occur which is why we trailers involving stolen semi-trucks.

Since September 20, 2024 Richmond RCMP have received three reports involving alleged thefts of trailers from local businesses. Through the subsequent investigations, it has been determined these thefts involved the use of four semi-trailers that were reported stolen out of Delta and Richmond. The two semitrucks from Delta have been recovered, however, the ones from Richmond are still outstanding.

"While we cannot conclusively link these thefts at this time, there are a number are warning our local businesses," says Sergeant Russel Yugai, Richmond RCMP Serious Crime Support Unit, "It is apparent the individuals involved in these thefts have knowledge around semi-trailers and commercial shipping operations which is why we are recommending that businesses put additional measures in place to protect their trailers and containers. This could include adding GPS trackers, having onsite security or hardening general security measures around your business."
