

Who is Running for BC Election in Surrey? Meet your candidates

The 2024 BC election final Voting Day is October 19, 2024. You can vote if you are: a Canadian citizen, 18 or older on October 19, 2024, and a resident of B.C. since April 18, 2024.

Voters will elect 93 Members of the Legislative Assembly (MLAs). Each Member represents an electoral district (or riding) and has a seat in the provincial Legislature. The political party with the most seats in the Legislature will form B.C.'s next government.

For Surrey residents, the issues of healthcare, public transit, schools and crime prevention remain on top of the list. There are three major parties BC NDP led by David Eby, BC Conservative led by John Rustad and Green Party led by Sonia Furstenau running in this election with BC NDP still edging ahead over a few points from BC Conservative party. There are also independent candidates who are not affiliate to any major party and running to represent their ridings.

In Surrey, there are 10 electoral districts. In this issue, we bring to you list and profile of the candidates running from your riding to equip our readers with the tools to decide who is strongest and most eligible to represent you in the legislature in Victoria.







India Bids Farewell To Its Greatest Business Ratan (Jewel)

Ratan Tata, the former chairman of India's Tata Sons, passed away on Wednesday, aged 86.

Tata, who is credited with taking his business house global via several high-profile acquisitions, was reportedly in intensive care in a Mumbai hospital. Tata was the chairman of Tata Sons from 1991 until December 2012. The group's revenue soared past \$100 billion under his leadership, according to the company.

Tata was known as a wise and principled leader whose vision and dedication shaped the Tata Group into one of the most respected and admired companies in the world, known for its culture and values as much as its results.

He earned an architecture degree from Cornell University in 1962, joined the family enterprise the same year. He was

known for his philanthropy and was chairman of Tata Trusts, among India's largest charity organizations.

Known for his humble lifestyle and known as man with no enemies, Tata was a real jewel that everyone admired. He was cremated with full state honour. Well-wishers lined outside to bid him farewell and scatter flowers at the site of the cremation.

During his time as chairman the firm bought high-profile brands such as UK-based car maker Jaguar Land Rover and the world's second-largest tea company Tetley

In 2009, the company surprised the automobile industry by launching Tata Nano, a tiny vehicle with a rear engine costing about 100,000 rupees (then \$2,000 US). Publicized as a "People's Car," it could seat up



to five adults. Ratan Tata said at the time that it would provide a "safe, affordable, all-weather form of transport" for millions of middle- and lower-income Indian consumers.

Tributes from industry leaders, politicians and the public at large poured in from across the world. India's Prime Minister Narendra

Modi in a post on X called Tata "a visionary business leader, a compassionate soul and an extraordinary human being ... his contribution went far beyond the boardroom."

Google and Alphabet CEO Sundar Pichai recalled his meeting with Tata where they discussed Google's selfdriving car project. "He leaves an extraordinary business and philanthropic legacy and was instrumental in mentoring and developing the modern business leadership in India," Pichai wrote on X.

"Ratan Tata's passing away is a big loss, not just to the Tata Group, but to every Indian," said Mukesh Ambani, India's richest person and chairman of the oilto-retail conglomerate Reliance



BC NDP to partner with Simon Fraser University and community organizations to enhance Punjabi language and culture

BRachna Singh and Surrey-Fleetwood Jagrup Brar have announced that if reelected, the BC NDP will partner with Simon Fraser University (SFU) to create a role for a Punjabi language and Pedagogy professor.

"It's extremely important for our local universities to have ties with the community they're in," said Singh. "They need to reflect the students that they're teaching and set young people up for success. Especially since we'll be opening a new medical school here in Surrey bringing more soon-to-be doctors from far and wide."

Establishing a Professorship in Punjabi Language and Pedagogy will ensure that

Punjabi language learning becomes an integral part of SFU's curriculum, actively contributing to Punjabi language and cultural heritage preservation.

"SFU is about to grow, a lot like Surrey has been doing, and with that comes new challenges and opportunities," said Brar. "Right now, we have a chance to pass down our knowledge, culture and language to the younger generation - which is exactly what we plan to do. The BC NDP is giving students the tools they need to learn by creating a Punjabi language and Pedagogy professor."

"I'm thrilled to see that the BC NDP are moving forward with creating this role," said Kan Sandhu, Founding Member and Past President of ICBABC and coordinator for SFU'S Punjabi Language Program. "SFU has a diverse curriculum, and enhancing this curriculum will improve the student experience for students of all backgrounds. Dilpreet Singh charged in assault of **Calgary Red FM host**

One man has been identified and charged in relation to an assault outside Rio Banquet Hall in Calgary where Rishi Nagar, a longtime host with RED FM Calgary, was attacked.

Shame On Rustad For Not Dumping Conservative Candidate Brent **Chapman Despite His Racist Comments Against Muslims**

It is shameful that John Rustad is sticking with Brent Chapman, Conservative candidate in Surrey South despite his racist comments against Muslims.

The comments were posted on Facebook in 2015, before Chapman entered politics, and were shared on social media by CKNW Radio host Jas Johal on October 9, 2024.

In the post, Chapman responds to comments from someone criticizing how Muslims raise their children. In referring to Palestinians he wrote: "They are all little inbred walking, talking, breathing time bombs ... figuratively and quite literally." In a statement sent to the media a day after these comments became public, Chapman said the language he used was "completely unacceptable," adding that since that time he has built "meaningful relationships" with people in the Muslim community.

"They do not reflect who I am today or the respect and admiration I hold for the Palestinian and Muslim communities," he

"I want to offer my sincerest apologies to everyone hurt by my past words," said Chapman, who is also the husband of with these views has no place to be a leader South Surrey-White Rock Conservative MP Kerry-Lynne Findlay.

B.C. Conservative leader John Rustad told reporters that while he agreed Chapman should apologize for the comments, he would not ask him to step down as a candidate.

The National Council of Canadian Muslims says it is horrified by Chapman's comments. "We consider them to be deeply Islamophobic, disgusting and utterly unacceptable," the Council said in a media release.

The comments Mr. Chapman made are racist, Islamophobic and extremely offensive. Although he apologized after the comments became public, someone of any political party in British Columbia. Chapman's comments are part of a pattern from past and present Conservative candidates, who have displayed racist attitudes towards not only Muslims but also Indigenous and members of LGBTO communities.

Mr. Rustad should realize that if chooses to keep Chapman as a candidate of the Conservative Party of British Columbia, he is sending a message that it is OK to make racist comments toward Muslims.



In a real sense, not yesterday but our future started eight years back here in BC with a political party at the helm of affairs.

Our province is grappling with serious challenges—healthcare, housing, education, employment, crime, and the ever-rising cost of living. An atmosphere of despair and despondency is knocking at our doors. The youth is the prime victim because they have a long future before them. Progressive ideas floated in the air by political leaders seem like great arrows. But, to shoot the arrow, we need a bow. In fact, the first responsibility of a leader is to define reality. The last is to say thank you. In between, the leader is a public servant. Even being public servants, Members Legislative Assembly had the right to increase their salary in disproportion to the salaries of ordinary wage earners.



An increase in hourly wages by cents or even a dollar is like tying the working class in the knots. Effective April 1, 2024, an MLA draws \$119,533 annually. B.C. provincial politicians now enjoy a nearly \$5,000 increase to their salaries while federal politicians have a \$8,500 bump as of April 1. The Canadian Prime Minister earns more annually than the

President of the United States. An elected member of U.S. Congress earns \$174,000. Canadian MPs make over \$200,000 per year. PoliticalSalaries.com ranks Canada second behind the U.S. in terms of political salaries per capita GDP, among G7 countries.

Election time is a dance of democracy. All voters must vote. Voting is a right best exercised by people who have taken time to learn about the issues. "Young people need to vote. They need to get out there. Every vote counts. Educate yourself too. Don't just vote. Know whom and what you are voting for and stand by that."- Nikki Reed. As a social change, let us see what Kofi Annan, the former UN Secretary General said, "Young people should be at the forefront of global change and innovation. Empowered, they can be key agents for development and peace. If, however, they are left on society's margins, all of us will be impoverished. Let us ensure that all young

people have every opportunity to participate fully in the lives of their societies." In 2020 provincial elections the voters turn out was the lowest at 53.8% since 1996. It is not a good sign. In 2001 it was 70.9% and in 1996 - 71.5%. Voters must get out of slumber to elect the right candidates. If necessary, vote beyond party politics. Well educated and wellinformed legislators will speak sense to safeguard the public interest. They will not be mook spectators in the Assembly Hall. Blame game has no place in a good

democracy. Democracy is not just the right to vote or get elected. It is the right to live in dignity. He who blames others has a long way to go on his journey. He who blames himself is halfway there. He who blames no one has arrived.

Hospital Network Aplogizes for shaving Sikh man's beard without consent; WSO Urges Concrete Changes for Sikh Patients

William Osler Health System (Osler) issued a public apology for an incident in August where a Sikh man's beard was shaved without his or his family's consent while he was unconscious.

"Recently, we failed to uphold religious and cultural care practices when a Sikh patient's beard was shaved without consent and without medical necessity. We take full responsibility for this incident and have extended our deepest apologies to the patient and his family. We also want to extend our apology to the Sikh community and the exceptional culturally diverse community that we serve. The distress this incident has caused the patient, the patient's family, and the wider Sikh community - including our own workforce - has profoundly affected us as an organization and beyond," the organization said.

Last month, the family of Joginder Singh Kaler approached the WSO for assistance after Mr. Kaler's beard was shaved without permission. Shaving or removal of hair



is a violation of the beliefs of practicing Sikhs. Since then, the WSO has worked closely with the family and Osler Health in investigating the incident.

The World Sikh Organization of Canada (WSO) acknowledged the public apology and appreciated that Osler has



accepted full responsibility for this serious breach and has committed to taking corrective measures to prevent such incidents in the future.

WSO President Danish Singh said, "The incident involving Mr. Kaler was both unacceptable and deeply shocking. While the error was irreversible, along with the pain caused to Mr. Kaler and his family, we are hopeful that this unfortunate event can lead to positive changes, ensuring

that the religious beliefs and practices of all patients are respected going forward. Brampton is home to one of the largest Sikh communities outside of Punjab, and it is crucial that the hospitals serving this community are fully aware of Sikh practices and respectful of them. The community must have confidence that their beliefs will be upheld in all aspects of care. The WSO is committed to continuing its work with Osler to safeguard the rights of Sikh patients. We welcome Osler's apology as an important first step, but we also recognize that there is much work ahead to ensure that such an incident never happens again. We look forward to ongoing dialogue and collaboration with Osler to create an environment where all patients receive care that respects their cultural and religious identities."

Singh added that the WSO will remain engaged with William Osler Health System and the broader community to ensure that meaningful changes are implemented and that healthcare providers across the country are equipped with the resources and education necessary to meet the needs of Sikh patients and others from diverse cultural and religious backgrounds.

Dilpreet Singh charged in assault of

one of the men allegedly began to physically assault the victim. Bystanders intervened and the men fled the area.

As a result, Dilpreet SINGH, 27, of Calgary, is charged with one count of assault.

SINGH will next appear in court on Friday, Nov. 15, 2024.

Nagar held a press conference in which he gave the details of the events that led to his attack. He believes he was attacked as a result of previous reporting he did connected to ongoing extortion. He said, "Many of you are aware I have spent a significant portion of my career reporting on the growing issues of extortions and criminal activities affecting the South Asian communities because the hardworking and the successful members of our community are living under constant fear and threat. It is important for the media to play its role and provide unbiased journalism."

Nagar informed CBC that the attackers told him they were upset with recent reporting his outlet did. He said the coverage in question revolved around two weapons-related arrests last Wednesday at the Dashmesh Culture Centre.

Nagar, who was bandaged across the left eye, said the attack left him with painful eye injuries and have left him at risk of "retinal detachment." But he said that he will not be silenced and continue to do unbiased reporting. "The physical injuries that I sustained including an injury to my eye the retina is under a risk of severe damage and these injuries are for sure painful but what wounds me more deeply is the intent behind this assault. It is a clear attack on journalism and on the free press. This was not a personal attack on me alone this was an assault on the very principles that bind us as a free and democratic Society."

He further added, "I will not be silenced these cowardly actions will not deter me or my colleagues from continuing our work nor will they dissuade the Press from reporting on matters of public interest. They can break my eye not the resolve. "

Surrey man charged following assault on taxi driver

An investigation led by the Surrey RCMP Major Crime Section results in charges approved against 31-year-old Richard Nelson for allegedly assaulting a taxi driver and causing damage to the cab.

On June 22, 2024 Surrey RCMP frontline officers responded to a report of a man who had allegedly robbed a taxi driver and then damaged the taxi prior to fleeing the scene. Nelson was located and arrested a short time later without incident. He was later released pending further investigation. Fortunately, taxi driver did not sustain

As this matter is now before the courts, no further information will be released.







2024 Ford Bronco Sport Freewheeling Edition: Even more Retro!

The venerable Ford Bronco is a revamped version of the much-loved original SUV. Chunkily styled, the new Bronco arrives in two or four -door formats with 4X4 capability. In terms of the looks, Ford have done a wonderful job when it comes to keeping the retro styling cues with a modern twist.

The Bronco Sport is front -engined with four-wheel drive and powered by a 2.0-litre EcoBoost engine with 245 horsepower and 275 lb-ft of torque. The other models - Base, Badlands, Big Bend and Outer Banks - have the 1.5-litre EcoBoost engine that produces 181 hp and 190 lb-ft of torque. Both engines are mated to an 8 -speed Select Shift automatic transmission with steering wheel mounted paddle shifters. The Bronco comes in number of special editions as mentioned plus the Wild track, Sport heritage and Black Appearance package version with different exterior, interior and equipment packages,

We tested the new Bronco Sport Free Wheeling edition based on the Bronco Sport's Big Bend trim level, The Free Wheeling's adds the iconic red, orange and yellow five-colour reflective graphic stripes on the

Ford Freewheeling series Bronco's from the 1970s and early 1980s. These bold accents are a breath of fresh air in an auto market that now favours usually drab monochrome color schemes. The funky colorful pop-art look is offset by 17-inch high-gloss black wheels with red accents; a silver-painted grille with two-tone Bronco badge; black roof, mirrors, and bumpers; orange accents on the dash; and the exterior and multicolor graphic hues in the seat inserts and contrast stitching.

The engine on this model is the turbocharged 1.5-liter 3-cylinder engine making 181 horsepower and 190 pound-feet of torque. Ford's High-Performance Off-Road Stability Suspension (H.O.S.S.) is also part of the spec. There is also the advanced 4x4 system with twin-clutch torque vectoring on the rear axle. They also come with the Bronco's G.O.A.T. ("goes over any type of terrain") modes, including Sport, Eco, Slippery, and Sand. The 2024 Ford Bronco Sport starts at \$38,995 to \$46,550, while the Free-Wheeling version starts at \$41,995 plus options, delivery, and taxes.

Interior wise there is a modern well integrated cabin with comfortable seats and good ergonomics. The exterior red orange and yellow stripes are carried

over to the seatbacks, where they add a great dash of contrast and color and certainly brighten

up the interior. I also like the hits of red trim accents around the dash display and the door panels as well as the Ochre stitching on the seats. Creature comforts abound with such features as heated seats and steering mounted climate controls directly under the eight-inch touchscreen. AM, FM, Sirius satellite radio, and navigation. Apple CarPlay and Android Auto compatibility is standard. The Ford Co-Pilot360 driver assist technologies are standard on all models, with collision avoidance.

BJP's Haryana Hat-Trick With Biggest Ever Win; National Conference and Congress to form government in Jammu and Kashmir



our months after losing its majority in parliament for the first time in a decade, Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi's Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) secured a record third term in the northern state of Haryana and scored its best ever performance in Indian-administered Kashmir, marking a dramatic turnaround. In Haryana, the Congress lost the election despite exit polls predicting it would win comfortably amid anger against the state's BJP government among sections of people, including farmers and champion wrestlers. The BJP won 48 seats in the latest state elections, an increase from the 40 seats it secured in 2019, while the Congress secured 36, up from 31. The majority mark is 46 in the 90-member assembly.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has expressed gratitude to the people of Haryana for bringing back the BJP with its biggest mandate ever. "They (Congress) provoked the youth against the army. Their anti-India politics won't work. Every family in Haryana voted with patriotic fervour. Some groups are trying to weaken

the institutions in India and are conspiring against the country with foreign agents. Deshbhakt Haryana ensured such plots are not successful," said PM Modi.

Among major losers are Haryana assembly speaker and BJP's Gian Chand Gupta, Haryana Lokhit Party Gopal Kanda and BJP leader O P Dhankar.

From Julana seat, Congress's Vinesh Phogat registered a victory defeating her nearest BJP rival Yogesh Kumar by a margin of 6,015 votes.

Congress said that the election results in Haryana are unexpected and shocking and the Congress cannot accept them.

"As you can imagine, this allows bad-faith actors to spin narratives that undermine the process. You can see examples of it already playing out on social media. Our fear is also that such narratives can then be used by these mala fide actors to influence processes where counting is still underway i.e. in most of the counting centres," senior Congress leader Jairam Ramesh wrote.

BJP secured 10 out of 11 seats in the

Finding the Light: A Journey of Resilience, Identity, and Advocacy

'm Alex Sangha, a gay South Asian man Living with a mental illness, and these intersections of identity have shaped my journey. Growing up in a culture where mental illness is often misunderstood and homosexuality is widely unaccepted presented significant challenges. Still, I found a path forward by embracing my unique experiences and focusing on my strengths. I now stand as a social worker, filmmaker, founder of Sher Vancouver, and co-founder of the Sundar Prize Film Festival, all while managing mental health conditions. This is my story of resilience and transformation, shared in honor of Mental Health Awareness Week in Canada, celebrated from October 6 to 12, 2024.

Leaving Home; Encountering the "Light"

As a closeted young man, I struggled deeply with my sexuality. The immense pressure within the South Asian community to marry and have children weighed heavily on me, and for much of my adolescence, I felt lost and despondent. Suicidal thoughts plagued my teens as I grappled with the idea of being different. At 13, I secretly sought the help of a psychiatrist, hoping that professional intervention could change my sexuality. Instead of trying to "cure" me, my psychiatrist provided support in navigating my emotions and coming out, ultimately helping me accept my identity as a gay man.

At 19, I left Canada for England, hoping to escape the weight of cultural expectations and embrace my identity. While living with my grandfather in Kent, I enrolled in college but soon found myself overwhelmed by loneliness and emotional instability. My thoughts spiraled, and I began to experience racing ideas, sleeplessness, and physical changes. Within weeks, I hardly recognized myself.

During a particularly intense period, I had an epiphany, a type of spiritual experience—a moment of seeing a remarkable divine light that profoundly impacted me. I was unsure what to make of it, but I felt it had significant meaning. Despite receiving treatment for my physical health, my mental state continued to fluctuate. This was the first break of mania I experienced, although I didn't recognize it as such at the time.

Coming Home: Struggling Through My

Returning to Canada was difficult. Though I had a renewed sense of purpose, driven by the desire to help others, I was still struggling with my mental health. I pursued a career in social work, feeling that my spiritual experience in England had directed me toward this path. However, my journey was far from linear. I lost my first year at the UBC School of Social Work as I went in and out of treatment, dealing with periods of mania and depression. It was during this time that I fully realized I had a mental illness, and accepting that I had a lifelong condition was a challenging but crucial step.

In my early 20s, I was still concealing my sexuality from my family. When my mother asked me if I was gay, I lied, telling her I was bisexual. The weight of keeping this secret was immense, but I found solace in volunteering with a gay and lesbian student group at UBC. Through this group, I was able to make friends and help educate others on homophobia and discrimination. It was empowering to create a space for others to feel safe in coming out, even when I was not entirely out myself.

Finding Peace and Purpose

My 30s brought a greater understanding of my mental illness and the need for long-term management. Continued on page 30

"Our members are deeply concerned that the Conservative Party of BC have not released a costed platform. They could be the next governing party of this province and have gone back and forth on whether they will attempt to introduce privatization that would dismantle the public health care system," said Ayendri Riddell, Director of Policy and Campaigns.

During the first radio debate, John Rustad repeated previous suggestions that we move towards other models of health care that have parallel private sectors. However, in other interviews he has said that he would only expand private for-profit delivery of services, a form of privatization that already exists within our health care system.

Both of Rustad's suggestions amount to privatization which negatively impact services. Contracting out publicly funded services to forprofit providers has increased in the last 20 years and although this form of privatization has largely contributed to the crisis that we are experiencing today, it is legal under Canada Health Act. Provinces with greatest for-profit activity are generally the worst performers in Canada with longest waits. However, introducing private-pay health care would be a direct attack of the Canada Health Act and the provisions that ensure that health care is provided based on need and not the ability to pay.

Finding the Light: A Journey of Resilience...

Over the years, I have been diagnosed with schizophrenia, schizoaffective disorder, and, currently, bipolar disorder, which I believe is my superpower because it makes me a creative visionary. Navigating these conditions has been a balancing act of finding the proper medications and coping strategies. Today, I work closely with my doctors to ensure I take the lowest effective dose of medication to manage my symptoms while minimizing side effects.

I have embraced a holistic approach to my mental health. Along with medication, I incorporate counseling, a nutritious diet, regular exercise, socializing, and participation in support groups into my routine. Swimming, in particular, has become a therapeutic practice for me, benefiting my body and mind. As I built this support structure around me, I developed organizations to support others. In 2008, I founded Sher Vancouver, a non-profit supporting LGBTQ+ South Asians and their allies. We offer peer support, counseling, social activities, and advocacy, helping others who may their sexual or gender identities. Sher myself and others.

Vancouver has become a lifeline for many, reducing the alienation and depression often associated with the coming out process.

In 2021, I co-founded the Sundar Prize Film Festival, a platform that celebrates impactful storytelling focused on social issues. It's a space where filmmakers from underrepresented communities, including those grappling with mental illness and LGBTQ+ identities, can share their stories with the world. Through this work, I aim to foster feel isolated or misunderstood due to empathy and understanding for


