

# Made-in-B.C.: Throne Speech Focuses On Economic Security In Face Of Trump Tariffs

British Columbia's recently re-elected NDP government laid out its priorities for 2025 amid a backdrop of looming U.S. trade tariffs and a record-high projected deficit.

Lt. Gov. Wendy Cocchia has delivered the speech from the throne outlining the B.C. government's plan to defend British Columbians from the economic impacts of the U.S. presidency and secure a stronger future for the province.

"In the face of an unprecedented and unjustified threat to our economy, British Columbians are joining with all Canadians to fight back. We've come together to support each other and stand up for our country. We are saying with one united voice: We will never be the 51st state. Not now or ever. Instead, we will take our destiny into our own hands – by building on our strengths," Lt. Gov. Cocchia said.

The throne speech focused on a tough and thoughtful response to any attack on Canada's economy and sovereignty, as part of a united Team Canada approach. With U.S. President Donald J. Trump's tariff threats looming over Canada and British Columbia, the throne speech outlined concrete steps the B.C. government will take



to grow a more self-reliant economy at home that delivers good-paying jobs. The speech also noted the crucial importance of creating wealth and reorienting the government to meet the challenges of a changing world.

The B.C. government expects to introduce two bold new laws to get energy and critical infrastructure built faster, and British Columbia's economy growing. The speech focused on creating good jobs in a growing economy by fast-tracking major private-sector resource projects and building on B.C.'s strengths in technology, life sciences and film.

"To unlock the incredible potential here in British Columbia, your government is expediting an initial 18 major projects.

# Police Release Picture Of South Asian Male Involved In Shooting Outside Surrey Pub

**S** urrey Police Service (SPS) and the RCMP Surrey Provincial Operations Support Unit (RCMP SPOSU) are appealing for the public's assistance to help identify a suspect in a December 29, 2024, shooting in Surrey that injured two people.

This has been an active and ongoing investigation led by the Serious Crime Unit of the SPOSU since it occurred on December 29, 2024. Frontline officers responded to multiple calls from people outside a pub in the 8500 block 132 Street who were reporting that a large fight involving several people had escalated and two men had been shot.

At the time of the incident, police released

who left in a dark-coloured sedan. The investigation has led officers to believe that there is one suspect, and police are now appealing to the public to help identify a suspect in the shooting.

The suspect is described as a South Asian male, possibly in his 20's, with black hair shaved on the sides, a moustache and beard, and wearing a black or dark-coloured jacket and shirt.

# South Asian Male Arrested And Charged In Stranger Assault On 64 And Scott Road

unprovoked stranger assaults that occurred on February 9, 2025 has been arrested by Surrey Police Service (SPS) and charged by BC Prosecution Service.

Shortly before 11:30 am on February 9, 2025, Surrey Police Service Frontline officers were called to a report of an assault in progress at a business in the 6400 block 120 Street. SPS officers arrived and found two men had been assaulted, one physically and the other with a weapon, and the suspect had left the scene.

The alleged suspect in two Both victims were at the business when the suspect began to physically assault one of them, a staff member at the business. When the other victim, a Good bystander Samaritan who intervened, was assaulted with a weapon, believed to be knife.


> The victim who was physically assaulted was treated on scene by BCEHS and the other victim was taken to hospital for treatment of non-life-threatening injuries. That victim has undergone surgery and is recovering in hospital.

The suspect was last seen leaving the scene eastbound on 64 Avenue towards 121 Street. The suspect was described as a South Asian man with a heavy build, approximately 30 years old and 6'1" tall, with black hair, and wearing a light-coloured, possibly light purple, hoodie, beige pants, and white shoes. He may be in possession of a knife. Officers searched the area for the suspect, who was not known to the victims, but were unable to locate him.

SPS) officers appealed for the public's assistance with identifying and locating the South Asian man involved the unprovoked stranger assault.

SPS's Serious Crime Team led the investigation and over the course of the past week detectives were able to identify and locate the alleged suspect. He was arrested in Delta on February 15, 2025, with the assistance of the Delta Police Department and the Lower Mainland Integrated Emergency Response Team.

The suspect has been remanded into custody and has been charged



with one count each of assault with a weapon and aggravated assault. Police are not releasing or confirming his identity at this time due to the investigation being ongoing.

# Liberal Candidate Viresh Bansal Apologizes After Coming Under Fire For Social Media Post On Nijjar Killing

Liberal Candidate from Oshawa, AOntario has apologized for his insensitive comments he wrote on social media regarding killing of Sikh leader Hardeep Singh Nijjar.

This week a social media post surfaced from Viresh Bansal in which he said, "You can thank India for cleaning trash people," he wrote. "Ask your gay friend @JustinTrudeau to do the same."

The message was in response to a 2023 social media post by federal NDP Leader Jagmeet Singh about the killing of Sikh leader Hardeep Singh Nijjar, which Canada has said was linked to the Indian government.

Nijjar was a Canadian citizen, temple president and prominent leader of the Khalistan movement.

The World Sikh Organization of Canada called on the Ontario Liberal Party to immediately withdraw Viresh Bansal



as their candidate for Oshawa after the emergence of deeply offensive and hateful social media comments.

The WSO also noted that in another post in response to a post by Conservative Party Deputy Leader Tim Uppal expressing concern over the Indian government's crackdown against Sikh activists in Punjab in March 2023, Bansal posted "It's Indian internal matter. You better take care of your own. Dekhi kitten tere naal vi kutt khanni na hoje." Meaning 'watch out or you might get roughed up as well.".

"Bansal's post is a disgusting endorsement of an extrajudicial killing by India and a homophobic attack on Canada's Prime Minister. The fact that the Ontario Liberal campaign has not immediately and unequivocally condemned these remarks is unacceptable. There is no place in Canadian politics for candidates who celebrate state-sponsored killings and use hateful, homophobic rhetoric. Bansal has shown a pattern of anti-Sikh hate targeting Sikh politicians. Bansal's words are not just offensive-they are dangerous and legitimize violence against minorities in Canada. The WSO calls on Liberal Leader Bonnie Crombie to immediately withdraw Viresh Bansal's candidacy and send a clear message that hateful rhetoric and endorsement of violence have no place in their party or in Ontario politics. Anything less is a failure of leadership," said WSO President Danish Singh.

Bansal after the controversy issued an apology on social media saying, "I deeply regret the hurtful and thoughtless comments I posted on Twitter in the heat of the moment. I want to sincerely apologize especially to the Sikhs and LGBTQ2S+ communities. My words were offensive and wrong and I take full responsibility for the harm they caused."

He further added that Sikhs have long faced discrimination and violence. "And my comments only added to that pain. That kind of language should never be used, anywhere let alone in the context of a Canadian's murder."



Frank served as a Member of Parliament for Pierrefonds-Dollard from 2015 to 2019, where he championed equity and inclusion as a founding member of the Parliamentary Black Caucus. As Chair of the Canada-United Kingdom Inter-Parliamentary Association, he contributed to strengthening international relations between Canada and the United Kingdom. Born in Montreal in 1962 to Gloria and Richard Baylis, Frank draws deep inspiration from his mother's trailblazing journey. Gloria, a nurse and human rights pioneer, courageously fought against racial discrimination in Canada, setting a powerful example of resilience and justice. An electrical engineer and Executive Chairman of Baylis Medical Technologies, Frank has revolutionized healthcare through life-saving medical devices, culminating in the company's landmark \$1.75 billion sale to Boston Scientific in 2022. The dozens of patents he holds in medical devices that are used to improve the lives of people around the world are a testimony to his ingenuity.

In 2004, Frank launched For the Children with a mission to improve education for underprivileged youth. This initiative evolved into the Gloria Baylis Foundation, honouring his mother's legacy and commitment to equity. Ruby Dhalla

Ruby Dhalla Trailblazer, Politician, Hotelier and Philanthropist. Dhalla made history in 2004 when she became the first woman of Indian origin elected as a Member of Parliament in Canada and the western world.

21 years later she will once again look to make history as the first Woman of Indian origin elected as Canada's Prime Minister. Throughout her tenure in Parliament, Dr. Dhalla took on key roles in Health, Labour, Multiculturalism & International Trade. She also chaired the Canada-US Parliamentary Caucus Committee and was the founder of the Canada-India Parliamentary Caucus. Her focus on building robust economies also helped to advance and strengthen Canada's trade relationships with emerging economies like India and the UAE. Dhalla assumed the roles of CEO & President of the Dhalla Group of Companies, which operates in the healthcare, real estate, and hospitality sectors with Hotel Assets both throughout North America. Chrystia Freeland was raised on a farm in Peace River, Alberta. As a journalist, she evaded Russian spies, covered the collapse of the Soviet Union, and exposed oligarchs, billionaires, and the economic policies that hollowed out the middle class around the world.

After watching Pierre Poilievre and Stephen Harper put those economic policies into action, she moved back to her adopted home of Toronto—three young kids in tow—and ran for public office in 2013.



When Trump imposed steel and aluminum tariffs on Canada in 2018, Chrystia fought back ----and she won again. In 2019, Chrystia was named Deputy Prime Minister, where she led Canada's pandemic response and protected Canadians and Canadian businesses from the largest recession since the Great Depression.


In 2020, she then became Finance Minister—the first woman in Canadian history to be entrusted with that role. # B.C.'s Minimum Wage Increases From \$17.40 to \$17.85

B.C.'s lowest-paid workers will see a 2.6% wage increase on June 1, 2025, keeping pace with inflation.

The general minimum wage increases from \$17.40 to \$17.85 per hour. This follows the changes made in spring 2024 to the Employment Standards Act, which mandated annual wage increases.

"Minimum wage earners are vulnerable to jumps in the price of groceries, rent and gas," said Jennifer Whiteside, Minister of Labour. "That's why we took action last year to ensure the minimum wage keeps up with the cost of living so workers

don't fall further behind." Minimum wage rates for residential caretakers, live-in home-support workers, camp leaders and app-based ridehailing and delivery services workers will receive the same 2.6% increase on June 1. On Dec. 31, 2025, the minimum piece rates for 15 hand-harvested crops will also increase by the same percentage.

"Making minimum wage, I know how important this increase is for workers," said Olivia Brand, who works at the Burquitlam Liquor Store in Coquitlam. "It's vital for government to continue to raise the minimum wage in



line with inflation because it helps workers like me cover everyday expenses more easily and it shows us our hard work is valued."

The minimum wage rates increase on June 1 of each

year, except for the minimum agricultural piece rates that increase on Dec. 31 of each year to ensure crop producers will not have to adjust wages in the middle of the harvesting season. The changes align with

government priorities to help lift more people out of poverty, make life more affordable, and build a strong and fair economy for B.C.

"Supporting workers is crucial for the success of my business. When my employees are paid a fair minimum wage, they feel appreciated and that translates into a more positive work environment. It also leads to higher efficiency and lower turnover, two things every business owner strives for," said Philip Aguirre, owner of Old Surrey Restaurant, and executive director of the Newton Business Improvement Association.

# Haida Nation And Canada Announce A First-Of-Its-Kind Agreement Recognizing Aboriginal Title On Haida Gwaii

The President of the Haida Nation, Gaagwiis Jason Alsop, the Prime Minister, Justin Trudeau, and the Minister of Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs and Minister responsible for the Canadian Northern Economic Development Agency, Gary Anandasangaree, announced the signing of the Chiixuujin / Chaaw Kaawgaa "Big Tide (Low Water)" Haida Title Lands Agreement. The Agreement includes Canada's recognition of Haida Aboriginal title to lands on Haida Gwaii and marks a significant milestone in the journey to reconciliation.

"I congratulate the Haida Nation for their leadership on this landmark agreement. As we mark a new chapter in the history of our nation-to-nation relationship, let us also recommit to walking the path of reconciliation. Because by working together, we're showing that meaningful progress is possible," said Justin Trudeau, Prime Minister of Canada.

Canada's recognition of Haida Aboriginal title on Haida Gwaii includes the foreshore and extends to the low-water mark. The Agreement does not affect private property interests or local and municipal governments on Haida Gwaii, and it confirms the continued delivery of federal public services. The Haida-Canada Archipelago Management Board will also continue to co-operatively manage Gwaii Haanas through a transition period, during which both governments will work to reconcile jurisdictions and laws.

The Haida Nation collectively holds inherent Haida title and rights as described in the Constitution of the Haida Nation. At a Special House of Assembly on November 24, 2024, Haida citizens voted 97 per cent in favour of the Chiixuujin / Chaaw Kaawgaa "Big Tide (Low Water)" Haida Title Lands Agreement. As a result, the Agreement was signed by the Haida Nation and Canada on December 4, 2024. "The recognition of Haida title to Haida

Gwaii by Canada acknowledges historic injustices and illustrates the transformative possibilities of working together for what is right. It takes leadership to recognize a wrong, begin the process of healing from a troubled history, and trust in the ability to forge a new relationship based on respect. This recognition of title by Canada which was initiated in 1913 by our past leaders - means that we can begin a new era of peaceful co-existence knowing that we can look after Haida Gwaii and ensure the well-being of all who call these shining islands home," said Gaagwiis Jason Alsop, President of the Haida Nation

Over an estimated five-year transition period, the Haida Nation and Canada will continue to work respectfully and cooperatively on matters relating to Haida Gwaii. Both governments have agreed that this transition will be implemented in an orderly and incremental way, providing ongoing stability for all island residents and other interest holders on Haida Gwaii.



This Agreement builds on previous reconciliation accomplishments, including the Nang K'uula / Nang K'úulaas Recognition Agreement signed by the Haida Nation, Canada, and British Columbia in 2023, as well as the Gaayhllxid / Gíihlagalgang "Rising Tide" Haida Title Lands Agreement signed by the Haida Nation and British Columbia in April 2024.

The Chiixuujin / Chaaw Kaawgaa "Big Tide (Low Water)" Haida Title Lands Agreement is a concrete demonstration of Canada's commitment to implementing and advancing the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples. Canada's recognition of Haida Aboriginal title results from Gud ad T'alang HlGang.gulxa Tll Yahda /


# Mark Carney holds significant favourability advantage over Freeland among Liberal and NDP voters

The Liberal leadership race is set, with I five individuals vying to be the next prime minister, before likely heading into a close-to-immediate federal election campaign. While two key debates loom for the contenders next week, many centre-left voters are already keen to back one candidate in particular.

New data from the non-profit Angus Reid Institute finds former Bank of Canada Governor Mark Carney surging as the hypothetical leader of the Liberals. With Carney at the head of the party, vote intention has tightened to a three-point gap between the Liberals and Conservatives, with 40 per cent supporting the latter and 37 per cent the former. This, seemingly at the cost of the New Democrats, who have lost half of their vote intention (21% to 10%) since late December. Under Carney, 42 per cent of 2021 NDP voters say they would support the Liberals, while 44 per cent would vote for the party again.

With Carney's biggest rival in the race, former Minister of Finance Chrystia Freeland as hypothetical leader, the NDP garners 16 per cent of vote intention instead of 10, and the Liberals drop from 37 per cent to 29 per cent.

This disparity is partially explained by several factors. Carney performs significantly better as Liberal leader when facing off against the other parties and leaders on top issues. He and CPC leader Pierre Poilievre are statistically tied as best to handle the economy, the cost of living, and the U.S. threat, when Canadians are asked to choose between the three major federal parties. With Freeland



in place, Poilievre leads on the economy and cost of living, while Freeland and Poilievre are tied on U.S. relations.

Further, on net favourability (favourable minus unfavourable views), Carney scores a +70 among 2021 Liberal voters, a +43 among past NDP voters, and a +42 among past BQ voters. Freeland receives positive scores among all three, but at far lower levels (+18 Liberal, +4 NDP, +28 BQ).

According to the survey, Poilievre has seen his unfavourable views rise to their highest level since taking over the party leadership. He is viewed unfavourably by 56 per cent of Canadians and favourably by 37 per cent.

NDP leader Jagmeet Singh fares worst among all federal party leaders and hopefuls in net favourability, facing

a -25 score. His favourability is positive only among young women.

The top issues facing Canadians are reported to be the cost of living (52%), health care (39%), and relations with the United States (34%).

# **Border service officers get authority** to cancel e visa or temporary resident visa if not satisfied

The Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) updated Immigration, Refugees and Canada's Immigration and Refugee Protection Regulations to strengthen authorities to cancel temporary resident documents.

These changes give immigration and border services officers explicit authority to cancel electronic travel authorizations (eTAs) and temporary resident visas (TRVs) on a case-by-case basis, including when

• A change in a person's status or circumstances makes them inadmissible or no longer eligible to hold the document (for example, the person provided false information, has a criminal history or is deceased)

• An officer is not satisfied that someone will leave Canada by the end of their authorized period of stay

• The document is lost, stolen, destroyed or abandoned

The changes also enable officers to cancel TRVs, eTAs, work permits and study permits issued to people when they become a permanent resident, they are deceased, or the document was issued based on an administrative error

The amended regulations came into force on January 31, 2025, and are published in the Canada Gazette II. These changes enhance the integrity of Canada's temporary residence programs and are expected to strengthen security at the border and within Canada.

# **Measles Case Confirmed In The Lower Mainland**

new case of measles Linfection has been confirmed in the Lower Mainland. Fraser Health and Vancouver Coastal Health (VCH) have determined the infection was acquired by a Fraser Health resident who travelled abroad to Southeast Asia. Public Health officials from both health authorities are following up directly with individuals who are known to have been exposed to the virus. Members of the public may have been exposed to measles if they were on Air Canada Flight 66, arriving in Vancouver on February 11, 2025, or if they spent time in the international arrivals area of YVR, including customs or baggage claim, from 7:00 AM to 9:30 AM on Feb 11, 2025.

Measles is a highly infectious disease transmitted by airborne spread. Most people in Canada



will be immune to measles due to prior immunization or natural infection.

People who are at risk of getting measles are those who have never had measles disease and those who have not had two doses of a measles vaccine. For people who are not fully protected against measles and may have been exposed, Public Health officials are recommending the following:

If you were born in 1970 or later and have not had two doses of measles vaccine, you should get a booster dose of measles vaccine. It is most effective if received within three days of being exposed but still can be received after that. Measles vaccine is provided free of charge.

Certain people should not get the measles vaccine. These include babies less than six months of age, pregnant people, and people with certain immune conditions. If you, or your child, are in one of these groups, please call your local Public Health team as soon as possible and no later than six

days after being exposed. You may be advised that you, or your child, receive a medication that can prevent measles disease. This is also provided free of charge. For Fraser Health 0

residents please call the closest Public Health unit listed below.

VCH Communicable 0 Disease: 604-675-390 or 1-855-675-3900

Free measles vaccine is available to those exposed who are at risk of getting measles. A list of local pharmacies (call for weekend hours) or VCH Public Health Units (open weekdays) is available at www.vch.ca/en/ health-topics/measles.

Individuals exposed should monitor for any symptoms of measles that develop up to three weeks after being exposed. Symptoms of measles include fever, dry cough, runny nose, and red eyes; followed a few

days later by a rash that starts at the hairline and spreads rapidly down to the rest of the body.

If you develop symptoms of measles, please contact your health care provider before you visit them so they can take precautions to prevent spreading measles to others.

The measles vaccine is provided free at public health units and certain family doctors and walk-in clinics. Pharmacists can immunize adults and children over five years old. Please call ahead to ensure vaccine is available at your preferred location.







# 2025 Mercedes-Benz GLC 350e – Most EV range in a plug-in hybrid

One of the most popular models in the Mercedes-Benz lineup, the C300 Compact Crossover adds a plug-in hybrid powertrain for 2025 to boost its appeal. Not only does it offer a premium cabin, a range of advanced, high-tech features, the new 2025 Mercedes-Benz GLC 350e delivers the best all electric driving range of any PHEV. Major updates for 2025 include: a new MBUX infotainment system, Digital key

capability and a new 5G communications module. There is also a new AMG GLC 63 S E Performance variant.

Powering the GLC 350e is a turbocharged 2.0-liter four-cylinder engine that puts out 201 horsepower along with a 134-hp permanently excited synchronous electric motor. The hybrid power plant's total output is an impressive 313 horsepower with 406 pound-feet of torque. There is a 9-speed automatic that drives all four wheels through M-B's 4Matic all-wheel-drive system. It splits the power between the axles on a full-time basis ensuring all wheels maintain traction on adverse surfaces.

The electric motor receives power from a 23.3-kilowatt-hour (kWh) battery, which can be fully charged in approximately 3 hours on a home EV charger. Drivers can also plug into a DC fast charger, which reduces charging time to about 30 minutes. As standard equipment on the GLC

300 includes self-levelling suspension, wireless Apple CarPlay, and Android Auto, Keyless-Go and Keyless-Start, centre airbag between the front seats, and more. from the post on moral grounds with immediate effect," he said while addressing the media in Amritsar. Dhami said he had written to the Akal Takht Jathedar to relieve him from his position in the seven-member committee formed to supervise the new membership drive of the SAD.

# **2nd Us Flight Carrying 116 Deported Indians Lands In Punjab's Amritsar**

Aspecial flight from the United States carrying 116 illegal Indian immigrants, including 65 from Punjab, landed at Sri Guru Ram Dass Jee International Airport in Amritsar late on Saturday night, officials said.

This is the second such batch of Indians to be deported by the Donald Trump administration as part of its promised crackdown on illegal immigrants. Earlier, there were reports that the C-17 Globemaster aircraft of the US Air Force would carry 119 immigrants, but now as per an updated list of passengers, the number of deportees in the second batch was 116, they added.

Among the deportees, 65 are from Punjab, 33 from Haryana, eight from Gujarat, two each from Uttar Pradesh, Goa, Maharashtra and Rajasthan, and one each from Himachal Pradesh and Jammu and Kashmir. Most of the deportees are in the age group of 18 to 30, as per the sources.

The families of some of the deportees reached the airport to receive them.

Last week, 104 illegal Indian migrants were deported from the US. They were sent in a US military C-17 transport aircraft to Amritsar.

The deportations come in the immediate wake of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit to the United States, where he met President Donald Trump to discuss key bilateral issues, including immigration.

Earlier in the day, Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann questioned the move to land another plane at the Amritsar airport, as he accused the Centre

of trying to defame Punjab as part of a conspiracy.

"The BJP-led Centre always discriminates against Punjab. It does not let go of any chance of defaming the state," Mann said while addressing the media in Amritsar.

"As part of a conspiracy, they are trying to defame Punjab and Punjabis," he said.

"It gives pleasure to me to announce that movie "Chhava" based on the life & sacrifice of Chhatrapati Sambhaji Maharaj, will be Tax Free in Goa," Sawant said in the post.

"The Movie exploring the valor, courage of Chhatrapati Sambhaji Maharaj for Dev, Desh and Dharma played by Vicky Kaushal, is bringing the glorious history to the screen. The sacrifice of

Chhatrapati of the Hindavi Swarajya, who valiantly fought against Moghuls, the Portuguese is an inspiration for all of us," he added. About Chhaava

Notably, Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Mohan Yadav on Wednesday also announced that the film would be tax-free in his state. The announcement by both the states came on the 395th birth anniversary of Maratha empire founder Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj, father of Chhatrapati Sambhaji.

The movie, featuring Vicky Kaushal, Rashmika Mandanna and Akshaye Khanna, is directed by Laxman Utekar and produced by Dinesh Vijan of Maddock Films. The film is an adaptation of the Marathi novel Chhava by Shivaji Sawant and has received positive responses from both audiences and critics. It is on its way to becoming the first Bollywood film to cross the ₹200-crore mark in 2025. It is also the highest-grossing Hindi film of 2025 now, beating the ₹112 crore mark of Akshay Kumar and Veer Pahariya's Sky Force.

# Swara Bhasker Says People Are More Upset By 'Filmy Torture' In Chhaava Than By Mahakumbh Stampede

Swara Bhasker, best known for her performances in films like Nil Battey Sannata, the Tanu Weds Manu franchise, and Veere Di Wedding, recently compared the public's emotional reaction over Vicky Kaushal's historical film Chhaava with the relatively muted reaction to a tragic stampede. She criticised society for its selective outrage.

Swara slams society's selective outrage On Wednesday, Swara Bhasker took to X (formerly Twitter) and wrote, "A society that is more enraged at the heavily embellished, partly fictionalised, filmy torture of Hindus from 500 years ago than they are at the horrendous death by stampede & mismanagement + then alleged JCB bulldozer handling of corpses - is a brain & soul-dead society. #IYKYK."

Her statement came after videos and audience reactions to Chhaava went viral on the internet. While some users agreed with her take on selective outrage, others criticized her comments. One tweet read, "100% yes! People love good drama, not reality. It seems everyone is running away from reality only to submerge in dramatic dramas of celluloid..." Another user commented, "Selective outrage speaks volumes. True justice means standing against all tragedies, past and present. Priorities matter. #IYKYK."

Swara faces backlash

Criticizing Swara's remarks about Chhaava, an X user wrote, "Yes, Swara... Chhaava was fictionalized. Had the makers shown the original torture, the Censor Board would have objected to the film's release. Your husband's cult committed massive atrocities under Mughal rule. More movies will come... You just need to learn to cope harder." Another comment read, "Wow, you've actually lost the plot." Another user wrote, "The torture in history was so horrific that the filmmakers had to tone it down just to get the movie released. The Mughals were barbarians!"

About Chhaava and Mahakumbh stampede tragedy

Chhaava, based on the life of Chhatrapati Sambhaji Maharaj, played by Vicky Kaushal, has received an overwhelming response from audiences. Several videos showed viewers crying and getting



furious over how Mughal Emperor Aurangzeb tortured Chhatrapati Sambhaji Maharaj and eventually killed him. In another video, a young fan was seen crying and reciting slogans in the theatre after watching the film.
